- 3. The Committee cannot be held responsible for any error in the Catalogue and reserve the right to cancel or amend in any way.
- 4. Any exhibitor lodging a protest must first deposit with the Organiser £20.00, which will be forfeited to the funds if the same is not sustained. All protests must be in writing and received within half an hour of the Classes.
- 5. No persons may deliberately enter and show a pony under a judge who is know to have bred, sold, or produced that pony.
- 6. All stallions and colts 4 years old and over must have a licence / vet certificate.
- 7. All Stallions in the four sections of stallion classes must be 4 years old and over.
- 8. The decision of the judges in all competitions, and that of the Objection Committee in cases of dispute, is final without further appeal.
- 9. All rules of Welsh Pony and Cob Society apply.
- 10. Information provided on the entry form will be produced in the show catalogue and results to be forwarded onto the WPCS.
- 11. Judging will commence at 9:15 am promptly and will run as stated in Schedule unless exceptional circumstances prevail.
- 12. No horses must be left unattended or ridden outside the Show Rings.
- 13. All handlers/owners are reminded that they need to have appropriate insurance cover in place.
- 14. Dogs must be always kept on leads whilst on the showground.
- 15. Young Handlers Classes
 - a. Handlers under the age of 14 must wear a British Standard Hard Hat, gloves and suitable footwear. Age as of 1st January.
 - b. No colts/stallions or mare with foals at foot may be shown in young handler classes.
 - c. Parents/guardians to be advised that the animal must be of suitable height and temperament for the handler and class.
