THE RIDE will start and finish at Stockbridge Farm (opp. Tilford Church) in an 18 acre site with 20' access gates, ample parking, a large marquee, toilets and refreshment facilities. Location map at www.ridingdiary.co.uk.

A refreshment caravan will be situated about two thirds of the way along the route where riders may like to take a short break and meet up with friends.

CATERING will be on site for all your refreshment needs.

THE COURSE

This all weather course is over 10 miles of well drained sandy heathland with beautiful scenery. It offers a minimum of 40 optional cross country jumps 2'6/2'9. Other optional more challenging jumps have been introduced for the bolder horse and rider. The course is well marked with direction arrows and each jump flagged, red on right, white on left. Stewards are at each jump to provide assistance if necessary. All have radio communication with the base station.

TROPHIES AND SPECIAL ROSETTE AWARDED FOR THE MOST SPONSORED RIDER IN EACH CLASS.

JUNIOR (15YRS & under) SENIOR (16/30YRS) VETERAN (40+)

TEAM (4 riders any age combination) DOG & HANDLER CHILD 'IN HAND' and RIDE WITH CONFIDENCE.

All trophy winners will be presented with an embroidered saddle cloth to commemorate the ride.

Raising over £100 qualifies for an engraved pendant.

All taking part will receive a rosette.

To be considered for a trophy, class must be specified when completing entry form. **SPONSORSHIP MUST BE PAID IN FULL ON THE DAY.**

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The organisers will not be responsible for any damage, loss, or any injury whatsoever, which is suffered by or to any entrant, their property or servants which may arise directly or indirectly out of or in connection with the cross country ride and other events. It is a condition of acceptance of any entry that every entrant shall indemnify the organisers and landowners against any claim or damage, loss or injury which results directly or indirectly from any action or negligence on their part.

1. Children must be accompanied by an adult throughout the ride.
2. The organising committee reserve the right to refuse entry to any horse/pony which is in their opinion, unsound or in an unfit condition
3. Horse/pony must be aged four years or over to take part.
4. The decision of the Organising Committee on any matter shall be final.
5. Entry donation and event fee with a self SAE must be sent to Mrs C Cook, 8 Sandy Lane Cottages, Sandy Lane, Rushmoor, Farnham Surrey GU10 2ET.
- 6. Full sponsorship must be paid on the day.**
7. Each rider must find their own sponsors (any number) to at least £17.00 in order to take part.
8. Any rider seen to be riding irresponsibly will be asked to leave the course.
9. All riders are strongly advised to wear back protectors and appropriate hard hats for their own safety.
10. Dogs to be kept under control at all times.
11. All vehicles will be directed to park in designated areas. For everyone's benefit please follow direction of the marshals
12. The ride has access to privately owned land for this event for one day only. No access is permitted any other time.

From Farnham:

WARNING! HGV/ LARGE LORRIES: BOTH BRIDGES from FARNHAM over RIVER WEY AT TILFORD ARE NARROW AND HAVE 7.5T WEIGHT LIMITS.

Lorries - Farnham→ Hindhead A287 pass Frensham pond on right.
Next left into Jumps Road→ to T junction at Pride of the Valley - turn left
approx 2.2 miles - entrance on right.

Private cars: Over railway crossing out of Farnham - bear right on Tilford Road.
