*"This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Affiliation No. 18206 Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid Qualifier card IN THE RING for signing by the judge. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card. The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 30th August-1st September 2018. Shows held on or after the Postal Entry closing date of Championship Show will count as 2019 qualifiers. The following classes are CHAPS (UK) Qualifiers 1 – 8. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook; or visit www.chapsuk.com for rulings. Only Skewbalds/Piebalds may compete these classes. All stallions, 4 years old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK). All stallions must wear Stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception
Open to members and non members*

1 CHAPS UK Open Youngstock Qualifier

1, 2 or 3 Year Olds no foal. Any type and height.

2 CHAPS (UK) Non-Native Open In-Hand Qualifier.

Open to Non-Native type exhibits, any height, any age (No foals). To be shown plaited and trimmed.

3 CHAPS (UK) Native/Cob/Traditional Open In-Hand Qualifier.

Open to Native, Cob, Show Cob, Traditional, and Vanner types, any height, any age (No foals). To be shown in natural state, or fully trimmed and hogged.

4 Novice Ridden Pony Qualifier

Horses & ponies not to have been placed 1st in an Open ridden class before 1st January 2018. Any suitable bridle.

5 Novice Ridden Horse Qualifier

Horses & ponies not to have been placed 1st in an Open ridden class before 1st January 2018. Any suitable bridle.

6 CHAPS (UK) Junior/ Intermediate Ridden Qualifier

4 years old and over. Open to any type of exhibit up to 158cms. Riders to be 14 - 25 years of age.

7 CHAPS (UK) Non-Native open Ridden Qualifier

Open to any height, 4 years old or over. Exhibits will be required to perform an individual show and will not be ridden by the Judge. Lead Rein exhibits are not eligible for this class. To be shown plaited and trimmed

8 CHAPS (UK) Native/Cob/Traditional Open Ridden Qualifier

Open to Native, Cob, Show Cob, Traditional type, 4 years old or over, any height. Exhibits will be required to perform an individual show and will not be ridden by the Judge. Lead Rein exhibits are not eligible for this class. To be shown in natural state or fully trimmed and hogged

9 Ridden Thoroughbred

Horse to be 4 years old and over- raced or unraced, will not be ridden by the judge

The two highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the relevant Equifest Championship to be held at the East of England Showground on the 8th – 12th August 2018.

10 EQUIFEST Open Ridden Mountain and Moorland

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age. This class may be divided as appropriate. Unregistered animals may compete but will not be able to take the Equifest qualification.

11 BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES EQUIFEST Ridden Hunters

Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cms. Rider any age. Classes may be divided as follows:

- Lightweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying up to 12.7 stone.
- Middleweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying 12.7 stone but not 14 stone.
- Heavyweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over capable of carrying over 14 stone.

12 NUPAFEED / EQUIFEST RIDDEN COBS

Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as follows:

- Open Lightweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.
- Open Heavyweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.
- Open Maxi Cobs, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 155cms – to be judged as Cobs. Riders any age.

13 BROADBANDPHONES.CO.UK EQUIFEST RIDDEN PART BREDS

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exhibits in this section must be registered in the Part Bred section of their respective Breed Society. Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form. Horses and ponies will not be ridden at the final. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as appropriate.

ALL RULES AS PER THE CURRENT BSPS RULE AND SHOW HANDBOOK EXCEPT FOR ANY NEW OR AMENDED RULES AS INCLUDED IN THIS SCHEDULE. B.S.P.S. Qualification The 3 highest placed ponies will qualify in all Novice classes. In mixed height novice classes the 4 highest placed ponies will qualify. In mixed height open/restricted classes the 4 highest placed restricted animals will qualify. Exhibitors in qualifying positions who have never been members are allowed 7 days to register.

BSPS MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE SHOW PONY

14 Mare or gelding 4yrs or over not exc.148cms. Riders must be the correct age for the height of pony they ride.

15 BSPS SHOW PONY

Mare or gelding 4yrs over not exc 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 13th birthday Before 1st Jan 2018.

16 BSPS SHOW PONY

Mare or gelding 4yrs or over exc. 128cms but not exc. 138cms. Riders not to have attained their 15th birthday before 1st Jan. 2018.

17 BSPS SHOW PONY

Mare or gelding 4yrs. or over exc. 138cms but not exc. 148cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st Jan. 2018.

****Show Pony Championship- 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 14-17 are eligible to compete****

18 BSPS LEADING REIN PONY

Mare or gelding 4yrs or over not exc. 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st Jan.2017.

19 BSPTS FIRST RIDDEN.

Mare or gelding, 4yrs or over not exc.122cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st Jan. 2017. No cantering except for individual performances. Ponies must leave the ring in walk or trot.

20 BSPTS LEAD REIN PONY of HUNTER TYPE.

Mare or gelding 4yrs or over not exc. 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st Jan. 2017.

21 BSPTS OPEN FIRST PONY of SHOW HUNTER TYPE.

Mare or gelding 4yrs or over, not exc 122 exc122cms Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st Jan. 2017. Snaffle Bridles only. No cantering allowed except for individual performances, ponies must leave the ring at a walk or trot.

****Mini Championship- 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 18-21 are eligible to compete****

22 BSPTS MIXED HEIGHT INTERMEDIATE

Show Riding Type. Mare or gelding 4yrs or over exc. 146cms but not exc. 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st Jan. 2018.

23 BSPTS OPEN INTERMEDIATE SHOW HUNTER.

Mare or gelding 4yrs. or over exc. 148cms but not exc. 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st Jan. 2018.

24 BSPTS OPEN PONY of SHOW HUNTER TYPE.

Mare or gelding 4yrs. or over not exc. 122cms. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st Jan. 2018.

25 BSPTS OPEN PONY of SHOW HUNTER TYPE.

Mare or gelding 4yrs. or over exc.122cms but not exc.133cms. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st Jan. 2018.

26 BSPS OPEN PONY of SHOW HUNTER TYPE.

Mare or gelding 4yrs. or over exc. 133cms but not exc. 143cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st Jan. 2018.

27 BSPS OPEN PONY of SHOW HUNTER TYPE

Mare or gelding 4yrs. or over exc. 143cms but not exc. 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st Jan. 2018.

****Show Hunter Championship- 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 24-27 are eligible to compete****

28 BSPS HERITAGE M&M OPEN LEAD REIN

Registered pure bred mare or gelding 4yrs. or over not exc. 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st Jan. 2018.

29 BSPS HERITAGE M&M OPEN FIRST RIDDEN

Registered pure bred mare or gelding 4yrs. or over not exc. 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st Jan. 2018.

****Mini Championship- 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 28-29 are eligible to compete****

30 BSPS HERITAGE M&M NOVICE Ridden Mixed Breeds

Registered pure bred ponies 4yrs or over. Riders any age.

31 BSPS HERITAGE M&M OPEN RIDDEN MIXED BREEDS

Registered pure bred ponies 4yrs old or over. Riders any age.

****Heritage Championship- 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 28-31 are eligible to compete****

Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

VHS Regional Final qualification. *All competitors placed 1st to 4th in each Area Qualifier class will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must carry their card in the ring at all times and have their showing card signed by the judge as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership. It is the competitors responsibility to present their Showing card to the judge.*
Regional Finals are open to members only.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, date to be confirmed. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule. TGCA TOYS In hand and Ridden Classes

Pure Bred classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all pure bred traditional gypsy cobs.

Stallions – All stallions (pure or part bred, four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MUST have be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two, MUST be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead as per the current TGCA rulebook.

Existing TGCA members must present their qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non-members will receive a qualification card from the judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification. Mare or gelding 4yrs or over. No cantering except for individual performances- optional **(CHAPS qualifier)**

45 OPEN NOVICE RIDDEN- WALK AND TROT ONLY

Mare or gelding 4yrs or over. Riders to be genuine novices in spirit of the competition.

46 BEST COMBINATION RIDERS 11-16

Mare or gelding 4yrs or over. Riders will be asked to perform their own individual show

47 BEST COMBINATION RIDERS 17 YEARS AND OVER

Mare or gelding 4yrs or over. Riders will be asked to perform their own individual show

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland,

Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding This class may be divided as appropriate. Unregistered animals may compete but will not be able to take the Equifest qualification.

**** In Hand Championship- 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 48-52 are eligible to compete****

Rules

- * Please do not muck out horse boxes onto the show field, take your litter home with you or use bins provided.
- * All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times, owners responsible for removing any mess.
- * The judge's decision is final any objections must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the class with a £25 deposit (deposit will be refunded if the objection is upheld).
- * No refunds will be given on entries, entries may be transpired at the organisers discretion.
- * In the event of adverse weather – we will hold classes in the indoor school with a revised show, classes may be amalgamated at the show organisers discretion.
- * If the show is cancelled a new date will be rearranged and pre- entries transferred, refunds on entries will only be given when requests are made in writing prior to the new date and with a deduction for secretarial fees.
- * All first and second place competitors in each ring must be available for the Championship in that ring
- * Robinson's Equi Teach reserve the right to amend the schedule change/cut classes for future dates if there is lack of interest in any class
