All of our shows are open to non-members, including Club Shows. Being a member entitles you to cheaper class prices, practice sessions and clinics.

To qualify for end of season trophies, you must compete in the same class a minimum of FOUR times with the same rider and horse/pony combination at Club Shows only.

Points are awarded to sixth place.

1st = 6pt 2nd = 5pt 3rd = 4pt 4th = 3pt 5th = 2pt 6th = 1pt

2018 Show Rules

- **All horses/riders must have adequate third party liability insurance.**
- All persons attending Springwood Riding Club do so at their own risk. The organisers / landowner cannot accept responsibility for any person, animal or property.
- **ZERO TOLERANCE TO ABUSIVE AND/OR THREATENING BEHAVIOUR** to any animal or another person on the show ground. Anyone found doing so will be asked to leave the ground and banned from future events.
- The judges' decision is FINAL in all respects.
- All competitors must have attained their third birthday.
- A maximum of 8 classes may be entered per horse/pony at any one show. Maximum of 4 jumping classes per horse/pony (combined SJ and WH).
- All ages as of 1st January 2018.
- Snaffle bridles include wilkies and hanging cheek bits.
- Correct riding attire, Current British standard/PAS approved hart hat and suitable footwear **MUST** be worn whilst mounted. No trainers whilst mounted. Over 18's can wear a beagle/bowler/top hat at your own risk, but we strongly advise against this.
- No horse/pony under 4 years of age are permitted in any ridden class.
- No stallions with the exception of yearling colts allowed at club shows. All colts to be suitably bitted.
- Competitors will be given a two minute call to present themselves to the ring, unless the judge is otherwise informed. It is the competitors responsibility to arrive at a class on time. The organisers cannot be held responsible for any classes which clash.
- Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- The committee reserve the right to amalgamate or cancel a class if there are insufficient entries.
- In line with the current DEFRA guidelines, all horses/ponies are to have a current passport available for inspection at any time.
- Where the height of a horse/pony is in dispute, a height certificate should be produced.
- Regardless of age, the rider must be a suitable height/weight for the horse/pony, including lead rein.
- **ALL HORSES/PONIES KNOWN TO KICK MUST WEAR A RED RIBBON AT THE TOP OF THEIR TAIL**
- Three consecutive strikes with the whip or excessive use of aids will result in disqualification.
- Competitors must warm up in the practice ring provided. Trotting or cantering is not permitted in the walkways or car park.
- No spurs to be worn by competitors under 17 years of age. Spurs are not permitted in Handy Pony, Games or any Beginners Class.
- Dogs **MUST** be kept on leads at all times and all mess cleared up and disposed of in the bins provided.
- Members must compete in the same class **FOUR** times to be awarded points for the Presentation Awards
- Competitors are encouraged to wear body protectors in classes and will not be deducted points in any class including showing classes.
- Lead Rein handlers to be aged 14 years and over.
- Maximum length of whips must not exceed 30", except Dressage.
- Show Jumping Faults: Refusal = 4 faults. Knock Down = 4 faults. Third Refusal, Fall of Horse or Rider or Dismount = Elimination. Working Hunter: fall of horse or rider = Elimination.
- All earrings and body studs should be removed before competing.
- Bit less entries are welcomed in any class, with the exception of Dressage.
- Lamé or unfit horses will be asked to retire from any class.
- Any complaints must be handed to the club in writing of the day of the event, with a deposit of £ 20.00 which will be forfeited if the complaint is overruled following discussion at the next planned committee meeting.
- The committee's decision is final.

STYLE AND APPEARANCE

09.00 Start (Ring 1)

Lead Reins welcome in classes 1, 3 and 5-9, 11, 13 and 14. All horses must be 4 years or over.

1. **RIDDEN TACK AND TURNOUT** Open to all.
2. **BEGINNERS SHOWING** Any height and breed. WALK AND TROT ONLY. This class is strictly designed for genuine beginners only, i.e. rider not ridden in showing classes before or young/novice horse. If this class is entered, you cannot compete in classes 3-14. Snaffles only and no spurs.
3. **LEAD REIN** Rider 9 years and under, pony not to exc. 12.2hh, snaffle bridles only. Lead rein attached to nose band.
4. **FIRST RIDDEN** Rider 10 years and under, pony not to exc.13.2hh, snaffle bridles only. Lead Reins are not eligible to enter this class.

NOT BEFORE 10.00:

5. **RIDDEN COLOURED** To include spotted, dun, cremello, palomino, piebald and skewbald and roan.
6. **RIDDEN LIGHTWEIGHT** TB, Arab, Riding Pony/Horse, Show pony and part-bred.
7. **RIDDEN HUNTER TYPE** Horse or pony.
8. **RIDDEN COB TYPE** Inclusive of those not eligible for M & M. Can be shown traditional, hogged and trimmed or Native.
9. **OPEN PONY** 14.2hh and under.
10. **OPEN HORSE** Exc. 14.2hh.

NOT BEFORE 11.30:

11. **RIDDEN M & M SMALL BREEDS** To include Shetlands.
12. **RIDDEN M & M LARGE BREEDS**
13. **RIDDEN VETERAN** Horse or pony 16 years and over.
14. **FAMILY HORSE OR PONY** Open to any height. Horse or pony must be able to be ridden by at least 2 family members. Snaffle bridles only.

RIDE-ABILITY

10.00 Start (Ring 2)

Group classes where competitors may be asked to individually ride their horse/pony incorporating movements at the judge's discretion.

15. **LEAD REIN** 9 Years and under.
16. **10 YEARS & UNDER** Off Lead Rein.
17. **11 – 15 YEARS**
18. **16 YEARS & OVER**

YOUNG HANDLER

To follow after Ride-ability (Ring 2)

19. **10 YRS & UNDER**

FUN SHOWING

To follow after Young Handler (Ring 2)

21. **MOST APPEALING** Open to any age/height.
 22. **NERVOUS AND NOVICE** – A class designed for those who have not got the experience or confidence to ride on their own. Rider can be led or just have assistance. WALK AND TROT ONLY. Appropriate footwear, jodhpurs and a hat must be worn. Show jacket optional. The rider must be a suitable height/weight for the horse. No plaiting needed. No Spurs. If entering this class, you will not be eligible to enter any other Style & Appearance class. Previous season's overall champions are not eligible to enter.

23. **CROSS POLES** Strict genuine Beginners Only – Max height **35cm**

(If you enter the above class, you may not enter classes 24-30, or equivalent Working Hunter classes. Not open to previous season's overall champions.)

24. **10 YEARS AND UNDER** Range of fences varying **35cm– 45cm**

25. **HORSE/PONY** – Max height **55cm** (The Under 12 rider with the most points in this class at the end of the season will also receive a special award)

26. **HORSE/PONY** – Max height **65cm**
