### **Finals Day Schedule 24 June 2018**

**(For 2017/18)**

Finals will be held for the following riding sections from Club and Combined Training days:

- Equitation
- Working Hunter
- Open Show Jumping
- Dressage
- Showing

For full Qualification Rules please refer to the main Club Day and Combined Training schedule for 2018.

For 2017/8 only qualification will be from 6 shows for each of club day and combined training; the second two of each from 2017 and the first two of each from 2018.

The first four placed members who have not previously qualified will qualify for the final from each relevant class. Those who have qualified will be invited to attend and asked to confirm their attendance. And pay entry fees before the show.

Entry fee is £7.00 for each Entry

Champions will be awarded for equitation, working hunter and showing sections with the top two placed horses and riders going through to the Supreme Showing Champions final.

In Dressage a Supreme Champion will be awarded across the four sections Preliminary, Novice, Elementary and Medium.

Dressage times will be available on the website from the 21<sup>st</sup> June and approximate times for other classes will also be posted – please note times in the schedule are estimates only and may be subject to change nearer the day.

Riders are asked to report to the secretary's caravan on the day to declare and collect their number.

## **Dressage**

### **Class 1 – Prelim Final (approx start 9 am)**

All qualifiers from classes 2, 3, 4, junior and senior sections where relevant from the Combined Training Schedule. Test to be undertaken – Prelim 12 (2005 revised 2016)

### **Class 2 – Novice Final (approx start 9 am)**

All qualifiers from classes 5 and 6 junior and senior sections where relevant from the Combined Training Schedule. Test to be undertaken – Novice 37a (2017) **long arena**

### **Class 3 – Elementary Final (to follow on from Class 2)**

All qualifiers from class 7 from the Combined Training Schedule. Test to be undertaken – Elem 53 (2007)

### **Class 4 – Medium Final (to follow class 3)**

All qualifiers from class 8 from the Combined Training Schedule. Test to be undertaken – Medium 73 (2007)

The highest placed junior in each section will receive a complimentary rosette.

### **Class 5 – Dressage Champion 2017/8**

#### **Sponsored by:**

Supreme Champion will be calculated from the score of the original test as a percentage of the total of points on offer for that test. In case of a tie the count back / penalty rules will apply.

### **Class 6 – Intro Test (to follow on from Class 1)**

All qualifiers from Class 1 the Intro Test (combined training schedule). Test to be undertaken – **Introductory Test C**

### **Class 7 – Junior Prelim (to follow Class 6)**

All qualifiers from Class 9 the Junior Prelim (combined training schedule). Test to be undertaken – **Prelim 7 (2002 revised 2016)**

All prize winners will be invited to return to the Ring mounted for prize giving.



## **Working Hunter – Ring One (to start 9 am)**

**To be judged under Sport Horse Society rules.  
Judging will include riding and conformation.**

**Class 8** – Final Working Hunter Nursery Stakes – 15.0hh and under.  
Fences not to exceed 60 cm

**Class 9** – Final Novice Working Hunter Pony not exceeding 15.0 hh.  
Fences not to exceed 75cm

**Class 10** – Final Novice Working Hunter Horse exceeding 15.0 hh. Fences  
not to exceed 75cm

**Class 11** – Final Intermediate Working Hunter Pony not exceeding 15.0  
hh. Fences not to exceed 90cm

**Class 12** – Final Intermediate Working Hunter Horse exceeding 15.0 hh.  
Fences not to exceed 90cm

**Class 13** – Final Open Working Hunter Pony exceeding not exceeding  
15.0 hh. Fences not to exceed 100cm.

**Class 14** – Final Open Working Hunter Horse exceeding 15.0 hh. Fences  
not to exceed 100cm

**Class 15 – Working Hunter Champion 2017/8  
Sponsored by: Vale of Lune Hunt**

First and second placed rider and horse from classes 7 – 13 will be invited  
to take part in the Working Hunter Champion class.

**Please note: Fence heights are a guide only. Actual heights at the  
discretion of the judge on the day.**



## **Showing – Ring 2 (to start at 9 am)**

Tack will be at the discretion of the judge and steward, check before you go in. Double Bridles are not compulsory. In some classes the judge may want to ride the horse.

Handlers for In-hand classes must be adult and the horse must be shown in a bridle.

**Class 16** – Final In-hand Young Stock – up to three years of age

**Class 17** – Final In Hand Veteran aged 15 years and over

**Class 18** – Final In Hand Ex Racehorse

**Class 19** – Final In-HAND Open Showing.

**Class 20 – In-hand Champion 2017/8** – First and Second Placed Horses from Classes 15 – 18

**Class 21** – Final Ridden Mountain and Moorland

**Class 22** – Final Riding Horse Exceeding 148cms

**Class 23** – Final Ridden Cob

**Class 24** – Final Ridden Veteran (15 yrs and over)

**Class 25** – Final Ridden Ex Race Horse

**Class 26** – Final Ridden Coloured

**Class 27** – Final Show Hunter Horse. Over 15.0 hh

**Class 28** – Final Show Hunter and Show Pony. Under 15.0 hh

**Class 29** – Final Riding Club Horse. Over 15.0 hh. You may be expected to jump a small fence, max 2'6". NO SPURS PERMITTED IN THIS CLASS.

**Class 30** – Final Riding Club Pony. Up to and including 15.0 hh. You may be expected to jump a small fence, max 2'6". NO SPURS PERMITTED IN THIS CLASS.

**Class 31** – **Showing Champion 2017/8** - First and second placed rider and horse from classes 20 – 29 will be invited to take part in the Showing Champion class.

## **EQUITATION – Ring three (to start at 10.30 am)**

Turn out will be taken into consideration.

**Class 32** - Final First Ridden 10 yrs and under on 01.01.16

**Class 33** - Final Riders aged 11 - 13 years on 01.01.16

**Class 34** - Final Riders aged 14 to 17 years on 01.01.16

**Class 35** - Final Novice Riders aged 18 years and over on 01.01.16.

**Class 36** - Final Open Riders aged 18 years and over on 01.01.16.

### **Class 37 – Equitation Champion 2017/8**

First and second placed rider and horse from classes 31 – 35 will be invited to take part in the Equitation Champion class.

### **Class 38 – Supreme Showing Champion (to be undertaken in Ring 2)**

**Sponsored by:**

Champions and Reserve champions from each of the Working Hunter, Showing (In-hand and Ridden) and Equitation Sections will be judged to award the overall Supreme Lakes Riding Showing Champion of 2017/8.

Please note that in 2017/8 a separate judge will judge the Supreme Champion



## **Open Jumping – Ring four (to start at 9.30 am)**

**Class 40** – **Final Senior Minimus** – Fences not to exceed 70 cm

**Class 41** – **Final W G Todd & Sons Novice Show Jumper of the Year (Horse)**. Horses 14.3hh and over and any age rider. Seniors riding ponies 14.2hh and under must compete in the horse section. Horse/pony who has won up to £75 under BSJA rules. Fences not to exceed 85cms in the first round.

**Class 42** – **Final Pre Open** - Horses 14.3hh and over and any age rider. Seniors riding ponies 14.2hh and under must compete in the horse section. Fences not to exceed 95cm in the first round.

**Class 43** – **Final Open Show Jumper of the Year (Horse)**. Horses 14.3hh and over and any age rider. Seniors riding ponies 14.2hh and under must compete in the horse section. Fences not to exceed 105cm in the first round.

**Class 44** – **Final Junior Minimus** – Fences not to exceed 60 cm

**Class 45** – **Final W G Todd & Sons Novice Show Jumper of the Year (Pony)**. Rider 17 years and under on 01.01.14 on a pony 14.2hh and under who has won up to £75 under BSJA rules. Fences not to exceed 75cm (2'6") in the first round

**Class 46** – **Final Junior Intermediate** - Pony 14.2 hh and under and riders 17 years and under on 1.01.16. Fences not to exceed 85cm

**Class 47** – **Final Open Show Jumper of the Year (Pony)** - Open Pony. Junior riders 17 years and under on 01.01.14 on ponies not exceeding 14.2hh. Fences not to exceed to 105cm (3'5") in first round

**All the above classes will be run over one round and a jump off as required.**





## Competition Rules

**“Riding can be a high risk sport. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers’ or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any Lakes Riding Club event nor any agent, employee or representative accepts any liability for any loss, damage to property, accident, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person, how so ever caused.”**

**Competitors please note:**

### Entries

- a) All entries must be paid for at the time of entry
- b) Clear Round Jumping will take place as described in the schedule and must be paid for at the ring side.
- c) Non-Competitive rounds will be allowed in all rings. Ponies may jump non-competitively at their appropriate, or lower, height limit. Horses **MAY NOT** jump non- competitively in pony classes. Having jumped non competitively in a ring, that horse/pony **MUST** remain non-competitive in that ring all day.
- d) A horse/pony may only be entered once in a particular class. A rider can ride more than one horse/pony per class.
- e) Once a rider has moved up a class in equitation, they cannot move back down the following season.

### Dress and Tack

- f) Spurs allowed for junior members for showjumping and dressage only after agreement of welfare officer.
- g) Hard hats and correct dress must be worn at all events. Hats to the correct BHS/BRC standard to be worn with chin-straps fastened at all times when mounted (for details of BRC hat standards see the website). (Body Protectors advised).
- h) Gaiters may be worn providing they are of identical leather to the boot and have no decoration of any sort. Half Chaps are not permitted.
- i) Snaffle bridles in equitation classes. No martingales, boots or bandages.
- j) Dressage tack rules – Snaffle bridles for Prelim and Novice classes. Double bridles may be used in Elementary or Medium classes. **NO** boots, bandages or martingales in any dressage class. See BD rule book for permitted snaffle bits. Please note – Wilkie Snaffles are **NOT** permitted bits. Bits may be changed for the jumping phase of Combined Training.
- k) Tack for Show classes will be at the discretion of the judge and steward.
- l) Only at the discretion of the committee can allowance be made regarding the removal of jackets in hot weather.

### General rules

- m) **NEW COMBINATIONS** – Riders, especially juniors who have purchased any horse/pony that is disqualified from our novice classes, due to its previous competition history, may for their first season as a combination, compete in the novice classes.
- n) No outside assistance in any class.
- o) BD rules apply in dressage and combined training. BSJ rules, except age-to-height limits, apply in show jumping classes.
- p) Only Affiliated Riding Club members (adults or children) are covered by BRC Insurance. Non-members are strongly advised that they are personally liable for any accident or injury suffered or caused by themselves, their horses or any of their associates.
- q) Riders and/or their associates are not permitted to alter fences in any ring without permission from a steward.
- r) No lungeing on the show field without permission from the event secretary.
- s) Horses should not be left unattended if tied to the side of trailers or vehicles in the lorry park.
- t) Juniors wishing to ride or handle stallions must seek individual permission from the committee.
- u) No refunds will be given for classes entered and not competed in.
- v) The committee reserve the right to alter these rules at any time.
- w) The committee reserve the right to disqualify any competitor who contravenes these rules.
