Horse Classes

Entry fee £5 per class for all classes unless stated otherwise

One off ambulance contribution of £1 per rider

Trophy to all class winners and rosettes to fourth place

Every attempt will be made to accommodate competitors entered in multiple rings but this cannot be guaranteed.

Dressage – from 10am

Pay at horse entries and book a time at the ring

Rosettes to 6th place in each section

Novice 22 (2007)

Split into under 16 years and over 16 years on day of show

Showing

Ring one – In hand classes. Start 10am

Judge TBC

1. Native mare with foal at foot
2. Non-native mare with foal at foot
3. Native youngstock (yearling, two or three year old)
4. Non-native youngstock (yearling, two or three year old)
5. Small breed Mountain and Moorland mare, gelding or stallion (Shetland, Welsh section A and B, Dartmoor, Exmoor)
6. Large breed Mountain and Moorland mare, gelding or stallion (Fell, Dales, Welsh section C and D, Connemara, New Forest, Highland)
7. Coloured horse or pony of any breed
8. Young handler (under 16 years on show day)

Classes 5 and 6 to be merged if low entries

In hand championship – first prize winners in classes 1 – 8 to compete for Pilleth Show Rosebowl

Ring two – Ridden classes. Start 10am

Judge TBC

9. Best turned out horse or pony
10. Small breed Mountain and Moorland (Shetland, Welsh section A and B, Dartmoor, Exmoor)
11. Large breed Mountain and Moorland (Fell, Dales, Welsh section C and D, Connemara, New Forest, Highland)
12. Coloured horse or pony
13. Lead rein pony
14. Ridden pony (up to 14.2)
15. Ridden horse (over 14.2)
16. Best young rider (under 16 years on show day)
17. Trekking horse or pony

Classes 10 and 11 to be merged if low entries

Ridden championship – first prize winners in classes 9 – 17 to compete for TVH Evershed Powell Perpetual Cup

Supreme championship – In-hand, ridden and working hunter champion and reserve on completion of all qualifying classes to compete for TVH Presidents Bowl

Ring three – Showjumping. Start 9.30am

Courses built and classes run by Teme Valley Pony Club

Clear round show jumping 9.30am until classes start at 11am prompt (£3 per round, pay at ringside)

18. Beginners jumping (riders may be assisted) Fences not exceeding 1'9"
19. Very novice jumping. Fences not exceeding 2ft
20. Novice jumping. Fences not exceeding 2ft 3
21. Intermediate jumping. Fences not exceeding 2ft 6
22. Open jumping. Fences not exceeding 2ft 9
23. Chase me Charlie (if time allows)

Classes 21 to 23 to be run as two phase competition.

Ring four – Working Hunter. Start 9.30am

Judge TBC

Clear round working hunter 9.30am until classes start at 11am prompt (£3 per round, pay at ringside)

24. Lead rein working hunter pony (up to 14.2) Small crosses and trot poles only
25. Junior working hunter (rider under 16 years on show day) Fences not exceeding 2ft
26. Novice working hunter pony (up to 14.2) Fences not exceeding 2ft 3
27. Novice working hunter horse (over 14.2) Fences not exceeding 2ft 6
28. Open working hunter pony (up to 14.2) Fences not exceeding 2ft 9
29. Open working hunter horse (over 14.2) Fences not exceeding 3ft

Working hunter championship – first prize winners in classes 24 to 29 to compete for TVH SC Cup

30. Hunt team challenge. Teams of three to each jump a working hunter course against the clock and with style marks and complete a hunting related challenge. Individual entries taken to form teams on the day.

Classes 26 and 27 horse not to have won first prize in any Working Hunter class

Dog Show

Rosettes to third place

Entry fee £2 per class, enter at ringside

Ring one – Start 1pm

Breed classes

1. Any variety puppy (6-12 months)
2. Any sporting breed
3. And non-sporting breed
4. Any breed open

Championship – first prize winners in classes 1-4

Novelty classes

5. Best dog or bitch under 20"
6. Best dog or bitch over 20"
7. Best six legs
8. Dog or bitch in best condition
9. Best veteran (7 years and over)
10. Best handler under 14 years
11. Waggiest tail

Championship – first prize winners in classes 5–11

Ring two – Start 1pm

Terrier classes

12. Any variety puppy (6-12 months)
13. Any variety smooth coated bitch or dog
14. Any variety rough coated bitch or dog

Championship – first prize winners in classes 12-14

15. **Jetty Cup** – any variety Jack Russell Terrier living in Teme Valley Hunt country

Lurcher classes

16. Lurcher puppy (6-12 months)
17. Lurcher smooth coated bitch or dog
18. Lurcher rough coated bitch or dog

Championship – first prize winners in classes 16-18
