Class 7 – In hand cob – traditional (to include solid/coloured)

Class 8 – In Hand hunter type open

Class 9 – In hand coloured (includes palominos, grey, piebald, skewbald, dun, buckskin)

In hand championships open to all first places when both rings have finished and will take place in Ring 2. No rosettes to be worn.
