Please note if you are coming out of Bristol on the M32 or from the M4 west bound we recommend you follow the directions below; it will help you avoid a narrow section of road and gives an easier ride for the horses. From Junction 16 on the M5, follow A38 for Filton/Bradley Stoke. At the Aztec Road roundabout turn left for Bradley Stoke. After 100 yards turn left at the traffic lights onto Woodlands Lane. At next roundabout go straight over. At next roundabout turn left onto Trench Lane. We are 1 mile further down Trench Lane on the right hand side.

"ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW" ("RIHS") QUALIFYING CLASSES. All Hunter Classes will be judged under the Society's Rules. Classes 1-3 are qualifying events for the current year RIHS. Only horses registered on the Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms and owners and riders must be members of the Society. The two highest placed horses in each class will qualify to enter at the RIHS.

SHB(GB) Competitors may compete on a day ticket and may have a maximum of two day tickets per season. Each day ticket (£36) is valid for one show and it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration/overstamp for that show. If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration/overstamp must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days.

This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (BSPS) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

The BSPS "Black Country Saddles" Area Best Rider Championship.

The Area 9B best rider from each class will be eligible to compete in the Area Best Rider Championship at the end of this show. To be eligible for qualification riders must be registered with the BSPS and must be members of the relevant Area to compete in their Area Championship. The winner qualifying for the BSPS "Black Country Saddles" Area Best Rider Championship at the BSPS Summer Championship Show.

The "Best of the Best" Area Supreme Championship.

The highest placed competitor from each class will qualify for the Area 9B Supreme Championship at the end of the show. To be eligible for qualification animals must be registered, owned and ridden with the BSPS and must be members of the relevant Area to compete in their Area Supreme Championship. The winner qualifying for the BSPS "Best of the Best" Area Supreme Championship at the BSPS Summer Championship Show.

This Show is a qualifier for the RIHS.

The highest placed pony, not already qualified, from the first three ponies, will qualify from the following classes, Anglo and part bred Arab not exc 148cm& exceeding 148cm, Lead Rein Hunter Type, Open 122cm, 133cm, 143cm, 153cmSHP,SP Lead Rein,& First Ridden, SP 128cms, 138cms, 148cms, Open Intermediate SR, SR (L), SH, mixed height Pretty Polly Show Pony, Pretty Polly 143/153cmSHP, Pretty Polly Intermediate SRT/SH,Pretty Polly Heritage Open Ridden Mixed Breeds, PrettyPolly Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden, Open Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden, Open Heritage Ridden classes.

This Show is a qualifier for the 2022 Blue Riband in lead rein, first ridden, show ponies, show hunter pony and intermediate show riding type and show hunter.

This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS "Classic Services Group". Animals will qualify by attending any B.S.P.S. affiliated show and have competed in the appropriate class. Ponies must not have qualified for the 2022 HOYS.

This Show is a qualifier for the "Binks Family Champion of Champions". 1st prize winners in BSPS open classes will qualify.

The Champion Pretty Polly will qualify for The "Donaldson Family" Supreme Pretty Polly Ridden £1,000Championship, the final being held at the North of England Summer Pony Show in June 2021www.northofenglandshows.co.uk waiting confirmation on this

Owners and riders must be BSPS members and the pony registered with the BSPS to compete in classes with qualification for the RIHS (Anglo and part bred Arabs must be registered with the Arab Horse Society).

Only tack that is permissible in the ring in BSPS classes is allowed on the showground while mounted.
