

TRRC RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 All events will be run in accordance with the current British Riding Clubs Rule Book, and specific class rules as stated in the schedule, where appropriate.
- 2 A copy of the BRC Rule Book will be available on the day at the Secretary's office.
- 3 The Judge's decision shall be final.
- 4 All objections shall be lodged in writing within 15 minutes of the alleged incident. A deposit of £10 required, which will be refunded if the objection is sustained.
- 5 Neither the organisers nor the Deadman Estate, accept liability for any claims in respect of injury or damage to any person, animal or property, however caused.
- 6 The organisers reserve the right to change Judges or appoint substitutes and to amend the schedule as necessary.
- 7 The organisers reserve the right to reject or cancel any entry made by any person or to cancel or combine any class they see fit, (~~refunding any fees paid less £2 per competitor to cover administrative expenses~~).
- 8 All entry fees must accompany entry forms. No entries will be refunded without a Vet or Doctor's Certificate.
- 9 Children **must** be kept under control and supervised at all times.
- 10 **Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.**
- 11 Everyone mounted, whether a competitor or not, must wear a hard hat at least to BSEN 1384 or preferably PAS 015 (~~Excluding the side saddle concours d'elegance class~~). Either type of headgear must have a chin strap which has a non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination. Hat checks may be made.
- 12 All competitors must wear the correct riding clothes whilst competing and exercising at competitions. ~~Back protectors must be worn when XC jumps are included.~~
- 13 Misuse of whips or spurs will incur elimination. Blatant use of bad language or aggressive behaviour from a competitor or spectator will result in them being asked to leave immediately. They may also be banned from future TRRC events.
- 14 Car Park Steward and Competition Stewards' instructions must be followed at all times.
- 15 Entry fees (less £2 per competitor to cover administration costs) will be refunded if the event is cancelled.

Class 1 Novice Ridden horse or pony (incl lead reins)

Class 2 Ridden Pony (incl lead reins)

Class 3 Youngstock (foal-3 years) IN HAND

Class 4 Mountain and Moorland and World Breeds (any pure bred)

Class 5 RC horse or pony (2x small jump)

Class 6 Coloured (incl duns palominos spots)

Class 7 Veterans (15years and over)

Class 8 Ridden cob and cob type (show, maxi, traditional)

Class 9- Ridden \hunter/Riding Horse/TB (any weight, height)

COVID-19 rules and variations

- **TIMINGS:** We will be issuing timings for the collecting/ working in rings and the show ring by email on Saturday evening 26/9 .
- Only 5 riders in an area at any one time. See site layout plan .
- Max 15 entries per class (judged in 3 sections)
- A one way system will be in operation for competitors.
- Classes will be judged on mark sheet in groups of 5.
- **PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND/ ENTER IF YOU OR ANY OF YOUR FAMILY OR SOCIAL BUBBLE SHOW ANY POSSIBLE SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19 OR IF YOU ARE QUARANTINING**
- By entering on line, you agreed to abide by the event rules including any measures in place to make the activity COVID secure. You contact details will be held for 6 months for NHS 'track and trace' purposes.
- Only 1 helper per horse , plus rider and 1 driver per vehicle permitted.
- Please bring your own number as advised on class times email.
- No ride judge.
- In classes >5entries, rosettes to be collected from the prize collection area once results are available and texted to competitors. (For classes <=5 entries, prized will be awarded in the cool down area.
- We have one toilet, any queuing to be socially distanced
- Hand sanitiser stations will be set up around the showground, but please do not touch any fixtures or fittings unless absolutely necessary and only after hand sanitising.
- Only horses who will complete are allowed on the show ground.
- Please maintain social distancing.
- Vehicles to be parked-10m apart if tying up of horses on both sides or 5m apart if allowing tying up of horses on one side Please obey the parking steward and avoid mixing with other 'bubbles'.
- Face coverings are optional but must not affect the fit of a safety hat.
- Anyone not following the COVID rules or abusing helpers/ stewards will be disqualified and asked to leave the show ground immediately
- TRRC reserve the right to cancel the event , should stricter COVID_19 restrictions be imposed. Refunds will exclude booking handling fees.
