Showing : Stars - Senior Showing & Dressage – Equifest - The Showing Register - Sunshine Tour at Hickstead

Jumping : Sunshine Tour at Hickstead, Cricklands

RULES

1. Under no circumstances must horses/ponies be left unattended unless securely boxed and must NOT be left tethered in the vicinity of the show ring or tethered to the outside of vehicles
2. Horses, ponies and riders age as at 1st January in current year.
3. The Judge's decision is final. Any confrontation with a judge is strictly forbidden.
4. No unauthorized person(s) are allowed in the ring at any time, although assistance is allowed with clear round jumping
5. Points will be awarded in each class to the competitor gaining most points over the same season with the same horse/pony/rider/handler combination. Points will only be awarded to those who attend a minimum of 3 shows per year. To this end competitors are asked to complete a membership form with their details so as contact can be made later and for the distribution of a newsletter
6. Competitors and spectators must conduct themselves in an orderly manner. Any use of bad language or behaviour which may bring the club into disrepute will result in disciplinary action. **Children MUST be kept under adult control.**
7. All lead rein competitors must be led by an adult (18 years and over)
8. All ridden horses & ponies competing must be 4 years old and over. All competitors must be of a suitable size and weight for the equine they are riding
9. All competitors must be correctly dressed whilst in the ring and British Standard hard hats must be worn. Chin straps and jackets must be fastened correctly. Arms must be covered. Correct footwear must be worn. Body protectors may be worn. (see disclaimer)
10. Annual points and trophies will be awarded, in each class, to the competitor gaining the most points over the season, with the same horse/ pony/rider/handler combination. (see rule5 above) A receipt **MUST** be signed and trophies **MUST** be returned on time.
11. All dogs must be on a lead and kept in control. Please clean up after them
12. No responsibility is accepted by the committee for any accident, injury, property howsoever caused.(see disclaimer)
13. The committee recommend that all competitors carry public liability insurance with a minimum of third party cover.
14. Complaints must be made in writing accompanied by a £20 deposit. These will be considered at the first available committee meeting and a decision will be notified to those concerned. The deposit will be forfeited if not upheld.
15. Ponies must be 148cm and under and horses must exceed 148cm.
16. Stallions must be handled by a person (14 Years and over for large breeds and 12 years and over for small breeds) and be correctly bitted. Riders of small breed Stallion must be 12 years old and over. Riders of large breed Stallions must be 14 years old and over. (as per BSPS rules)
17. Points will be deemed void should any trophies or monies be outstanding to the club.
18. Tickets for the awards presentation evening will be available on a pre-booked system, a deposit having been paid . Please book in plenty of time to ensure sufficient catering arrangements can be made.
18. **Anyone attending the shows is asked to place litter in the bins provided or take it home. PLEASE.....poo-pick, there are implements provided.**

CLASS 1 **ABSOLUTE BEGINNERS** - Sunshine Tour Qualifier : To include lead reins. Riders 16 years and under. Ponies not to exceed 148 cms. Fence height in first round approx. 40cms. Those who jump clear in the first round will jump again in the second round .

CLASS 2 **60cms** –Cricklands Qualifier and Sunshine tour Qualifier: Riders 16 years and under. Ponies not to exceed 148cms. Fence height approx. 60 cms.

CLASS 3 **70 cms** –Cricklands qualifier and Sunshine tour Qualifier: Riders 16 years and under. Ponies not to exceed 148cms. This class will run as a 1 round against the clock

CLASS 4 **75 cms**- Cricklands qualifier and Sunshine tour Qualifier: Riders 16 years and under. Ponies not to exceed 148 cms.

Class 5 will not commence before 11.30am

CLASS 5 **80 cms**- Cricklands Qualifier and Sunshine tour Qualifier : Riders 16 years and under. Ponies not to exceed 148cms

CLASS 6 **90 cms**– Cricklands Qualifier and Sunshine tour Qualifier: Riders 16 years and under. Ponies not to exceed 148cms

MILNER FAMILY/EQUIFEST, SHOW PONY LEAD REIN: Leading rein pony, mare, or gelding 4 yrs old and over not exceeding 128 cms. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. **Lead rein to be attached to the noseband. SS**

LANDSCAPES EQUIFEST SHOW HUNTER PONY- LEAD REIN. Show hunter pony-lead rein, mare or gelding, 4yrs and over, not exceeding 122cms. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 36 **BEST LEAD REIN RIDER – Sponsored by Katy Carter Show Team**

- Riders 9 years and under to be led by an adult. Ponies not to exceed 128 cms. Snaffle bridle **ONLY**. Lead rein must be attached to the noseband. Mares & geldings only.

CLASS 37 **BEGINNERS SHOWING (includes lead reins and first year, first ridden).**

Horses, ponies and riders any age.

Correct standard hat, boots and jodhpurs must be worn. Riding jackets not necessary but arms **MUST** be covered. To compete for one season only.

Class 37: NO CANTERING ON COLLECTIVE “GO ROUND” AND NOT NECESSARY IN THE INDIVIDUAL SHOW.

CLASS 38 **LEAD REIN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND – Sponsored by Mrs G Hill**

– Riders 9 years and under to be led by an adult. Ponies not to exceed 128 cms. Snaffle bridle **ONLY**. Lead rein must be attached to the noseband. Mares & geldings only.

CAVERNOMA ALLIANCE UK / EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LEAD REIN Open to

Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms.

Riders not to have attained their 9 January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a Snaffle Bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

CLASS 40 **FIRST RIDDEN PONY - MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND**

THE JUNGLE HUT/EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND FIRST RIDDEN: Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare, or gelding 4 yrs old and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

CLASS 41 **NOVICE HORSE/PONY**

– Horse/pony over 4 years old. Riders any age & ABILITY. They Must be of a suitable size and weight for the equine ridden

RING 3 - SHOWING CLASSES (Cont'd.)

CLASS 42 RIDING PONY/SHOW PONY

Riders 16 years and under. Ponies not to exceed 148 cms.

EQUIFEST RIDDEN SHOW PONIES: Open show pony, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148 cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Classes may be divided as follows:

Show pony, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128 cms. Riders not to have attained their 13th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Show pony, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 128 cms but not exceeding 138 cms. Riders not to have attained their 15th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Show pony, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 138 cms but not exceeding 148 cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Exhibits in this section must be registered in the Part Bred section of their respective Breed Society. Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form. Horses and ponies will not be ridden at the final. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as appropriate.

CLASS 48 RIDDEN COB (HOGGED OR HAIRY)

THE HOOD SHOW TEAM/EQUIFEST MAXI COBS QUALIFIER:

Open Maxi Cobs, mare, or gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 155 cms – to be judged as cobs. Riders any age.

NUPAFEEED RIDDEN COBS - mare, or gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155 cms. Riders any age, classes to be divided as follows:

Open lightweight ridden cob, mare or gelding exceeding 148 cms but not exceeding 155 cms.

Open heavyweight ridden cob, mare or gelding exceeding 148 cms but not exceeding 155 cms.

CLASS 49 RIDDEN HUNTER – Sponsored by Connect Travel

BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES /EQUIFEST RIDDEN HUNTERS: Open ridden hunter mare or gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 153 cms. Riders any age. Classes to be divided as follows:
