Eventers Challenge classes

A small additional booking fee will be payable to Equo Events.

Late entries will be an additional £2 per class

Rosettes: to sixth place, prize for 1st place.

TIMES: Approx. class start times will be published on our Facebook page, by the evening of the Friday before the competition.

PRIZEGIVING: class presentations will be un-mounted about 25 minutes after the end of the class by the Secretary area

DRESS: Cross country colours or show jackets. Back protectors are compulsory for cross country, and advisable for show jumping. Competitors must provide their own number bibs. Please see the hat and cross country guidance on the PC & BRC website to ensure your equipment is of the current safety standard.

Please be aware that if your hat and body protector do not meet the current PC / RC standards for cross country you will not be allowed to compete. You will not be eligible for a refund.

COURSE WALKING: The courses will be available to walk from 2pm – 6pm the day before the competition. There will also be a short break for walking the show jumping course between each show jumping height. The cross country element may be walked on the day, however from the first class access will be limited to avoid disruption to competitors.

DOGS: Dogs are allowed on the event grounds, however they must be kept on a lead, and are not allowed on the cross country course.

What is an Eventers Challenge?

A 2 Phase horse trial, the first section is over show jumps and the second is over natural obstacles, with a timed section. The show jump phase will be approx. 10 jumps, followed immediately by 12-14 cross country jumps on the main cross country course. The cross country for class 1 will take place over a shortened course.

After the show jumps competitors must enter the start box and wait for the bell or starter before beginning the 2nd phase over natural obstacles. There may be a short break between the phases, depending on the number of competitors on the course. A section of the cross country phase will be timed, and may include knock down fences, which will attract penalties (10 penalties). Overall the winner and runners up will be those that achieve clear round in both phases with the fastest time over the cross county timed phase. Start times will be allocated to all competitors.

NB. At this event, if you are eliminated SJ, we *may* allow you to continue onto XC *at the judges discretion*, but anyone eliminated XC will have to leave the course at a walk allowing others to continue safely.

DISCLAIMERS 1. - 3. All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Tumpy Green Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover them.

RULES AND NOTICES

• Substitutions allowed – please tell the Secretary (Entries before the day, Show on the day).

- Pre-entries are essential as entries will be limited. If you miss the closing date please ring/email the Entries Secretary for available spaces. A waiting list will be held if necessary.
- Any withdrawals before the closing date will receive a refund, minus a £5 admin fee. Withdrawals after the closing date will not be eligible for a refund.
- If the show is cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control, entry fees will be refunded on receipt of an s.a.e. Any refund will be subject to an administration fee.
- TIMES WILL BE GIVEN please see the documents section of Equo Events. Competitors may be asked to jump up to 15 minutes before their given time please be ready.
- Competitor numbers MUST be visible at all times whilst mounted.
- Warm-up Arena the number of competitors may be restricted; please obey the steward's instructions as to when you can use the warm-up.
- Children must not jump in the warm-up arena without an accompanying adult.
- Each horse/pony may only compete once in each class and in a maximum of three classes. Stallions are allowed only with prior permission from the Entries Secretary via the Rider's DC and must wear stallion discs and ribbons. All horse/ponies must be at least 5 years old on day of competition.
- SPURS: ALL spurs worn anywhere on the showground, by any competitor, must comply with Pony Club rules; Pony Club members may only wear spurs if they have a current membership card signed by their D.C./Centre Proprietor or have their B Test or above. (please ensure you wear your B Test felt if you have attained a higher test)
- Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found doing so will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.
- Judges' decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Show Secretary in writing with a £20 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 15 minutes of the incident and BEFORE the prize-giving for that class.
- INSURANCE; please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.
- PHOTOGRAPHS: by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please tell the photographer on entering the arena, before you jump.
- Participants attend at their own risk; neither the Committee nor Tumpy Green Competition Centre will be liable for any loss, damage or accident to horses, riders, property or other persons.
- No horses/ponies should be left tied to the outside of trailers/lorries without supervision. Please clear any muck/rubbish/hay and do not leave on the lorry park.
