

Rules

1. The judge's decision is final
2. No entries will be accepted without the appropriate fee
3. Correctly fitted footwear and headgear that conform to the current safety standard must be worn at all times when mounted.
4. No galloping allowed on the showground
5. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times
6. In the event of cancellation, your entry fee will be carried over to the next Tumpy Green event. No Refunds given.
7. A vets or doctors certificate will be required if a withdrawal is made and request for a refund given due to the incapacity of horse or rider
8. No jewellery to be worn and long hair to be secured above collar height.
9. The Area 9 Championships are only for Pony Club members in Area 9 – riders do not have to be a member to be given a qualifying card but they must join an Area 9 Branch/Centre before sending off the card to the Championship entries Secretary.
10. No horse or pony under 4 years may compete in any ridden class.
11. Stallions and colts must be adequately bitted, and handled by an adult.

All competitors take part entirely at their own risk and the organisers do not hold themselves responsible for any incident or damage that may occur to horse, rider, property, vehicle or spectator.

Class 5 Best Leading Rein Pony Riders under 12 years on Jan 1st 2019. Ponies judged on manners and suitability

Class 6 Family Horse / Pony Suitable for any member of the family to ride.

Class 7 Veteran Horse / Pony Age to be displayed. 15 years and over. VHPRC & VHS qualifier.

Class 8 Coloured Horse/Pony To include piebald, skewbald, Appaloosa, palomino, spotted or dun. Trailblazers qualifier

Class 9 Mature Rider over 35 years No jumping required, judged on position, balance and effectiveness of aids rather than the horses confirmation and paces. VHPRC qualifier

Class 10 Mountain & Moorland small breeds Exmoors, Dartmoors, Shetlands, Welsh Sec A & B Trailblazers Qualifier

Class 11 & Moorland large breeds Highlands, Fells, Dales, New Forest, Connemara, Welsh Sec C & D Trailblazers Qualifier (Classes 10 & 11 Need not be registered, but must be true to type.)

Class 12 Cob Class To include cob types, registered and non-registered.

Class 13 Thoroughbred Open to horses bred to race, trained, have raced or retired racehorses.

Class 14 Ridden Hunter / Riding Horse Mare or gelding ex.148 cm.
