## RULES

1. The Committee, its Officers, Servants or Agents shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may happen from any cause whatsoever, to exhibitors or any other member of the public, or any animal or property or vehicle brought onto the showground, or whilst entering or leaving the same, or anything attributable to the show.
2. Any exhibitor wishing to lodge a protest should do so in writing, to the secretary, with a £10.00 deposit, to be forfeited should the protest not be sustained.
3. The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate/divide certain classes, if deemed, appropriate and also to amend the Judges' panel if necessary.
4. **All entries in Welsh classes must be eligible for entry in the Welsh Stud Book or Appendices of the Stud Book and all entries in the Mountain and Moorland classes must be eligible for entry in their respective Breed Society Stud Books.**
5. All Stallions exhibited must be in possession of a current Ministry of Agriculture, National Pony Society or Breed Society License.
6. All exhibits shall be the bona fide property of the owner/exhibitor, or officially leased.
7. Exhibitors are not permitted to enter any animal when that animal will be judged by a person who has owned, bred, produced or had any financial interest in the said animal whatsoever.
8. No Manes or Tails to be plaited in Welsh or Mountain and Moorland classes.
9. In Ridden classes, all animals must be 4 years old and over and Hard Hats to BSEN 1384 or PAS 015 standard must be worn by Riders AT ALL TIMES when mounted.
10. No Spurs allowed in Ridden Welsh Classes.
11. No Whip or Cane to exceed 30 inches.
12. No Cantering will be allowed outside the Rings, except in "warm up" areas.
13. Riders MUST have attained their 3rd birthday by January 1st in the current year.
14. Exhibitors should ensure that they are adequately covered by Third Party Insurance:
15. All trophies remain the property of the Avon and Border Counties Association of the Welsh Pony and Cob Society. Must be signed for and returned at least ONE MONTH before the following Summer Show.
16. Competitors in ridden classes must abide by the rules governing the class they are competing in.
