JUMPING CLASSES (class times for class 2-7 are approx.)

Class 1 (10 am) – **40cm**

Class 2 (10.45 am) – **50cm**

Class 3 (11.30 am) – **60cm**

Class 4 (12.30 pm) – **70cm**

Class 5 (1.30 pm) – **80cm**

Class 6 (2.30 pm) – **90cm**

Class 7 (3.15pm) – **1m**

All classes will be run as a single-phase competition, a course in two parts with the second part timed. All will jump against the clock immediately after their first round, even with faults, unless eliminated. **CLEAR ROUND** will run at each level between classes if time permits at £5 per round

SHOWING SHOW:

Ring 1: In-hand showing – starts at 10 am (all classes will follow on – please allow 30 minutes for each class)

Class 8: In-hand Mountain and Moorland

Class 9: In-hand horse or pony - horse not to have been placed 1st in any in-hand or ridden class previously

Class 10: In-hand Veteran (15+)

Class 11: In-hand Coloured

Class 12: In-hand Cob/Cob Type

Class 13: In-hand championship (to follow)

- Ring 2:** Ridden Showing Classes – starts at 11 am (all classes will follow on – please allow minimum of 30 minutes for each class)
- Class 14: Ridden Mountain & Moorland (open to any M&M breed, pure or part-bred)
- Class 15: Have a go ridden showing
- Competitors to conduct a short show at walk and trot and do not need to demonstrate a canter. Lead rein welcome but class will be judged as a whole. Combination not to have been placed first in **any** ridden showing class.*
- Class 16: Ridden Veterans (15+) (there will be a small break after this class of 15 minutes)
- Class 17: Ridden Coloured
- Class 18: Ridden Cob/CobType
- Class 19: Ridden Horse (over 14.2 hh Hunter, Hack, Riding horse, TB, Cobs, M&M. – judged on type, manners and way of going. Judge will not ride.)
- Class 20: Riding club horse/pony – to be ridden in a snaffle – may be required to jump a small fence.
- Class 21: Ridden championship (to follow)

All competition is on grass arenas by kind permission of Will Elliott and Lisa Fahy at Whipleby Manor. Please make all entries via My Riding Life. Links can also be found on the West Surrey Riding club website and face book page. Competitors are reminded that horse passports and flu vaccinations should be presented on the day and all horses should be vaccinated within the last 12 months.

Directions to the show ground: Please travel along the A281 from Guildford or Horsham until you reach Whipleby Manor horse feeds – turn into the driveway and drive past the horse feeds stores (on your right) following the driveway towards Whipleby Manor Farm. You will pass over some speed bumps in the road, please use the lay bys for passing traffic and do not drive on the grass verges. You will travel down the drive way until you reach a bend in the road – parking will be signposted on the left.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ALL WSRC EVENTS.

- 1. All events will be run in accordance with the current BHS Riding Clubs Rules Book. Callers in the dressage phase are allowed.**
- 2. A copy of the relevant Rules Book will be available at the Show Secretary's Office on the day of the show.**
- 3. The decisions of the judges are final. Objections must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a deposit of £10, which will be returned if the objection is upheld.**
- 4. Neither the organisers nor the owners of the venue accept liability for any claims in respect of injury or damage to any person, animal or property, how-so-ever caused. You are required to ensure you have adequate insurance and liability cover for competing at this level. Qualified club first aiders will be present on the day but competitors are reminded that take part at their own risk and that any competitor suffering an injury or fall should report to the secretary.**
- 5. The organisers reserve the right to change judges or appoint substitutes and to amend the schedule as necessary.**
- 6. The organisers reserve the right to reject or cancel any entry made by any persons or cancel any class (refunding all fees paid).**
- 7. Entry fees must be paid at time of entry. No entries will be refunded without a Veterinary Surgeon's or Doctors certificate.**
- 8. DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEADS AT ALL TIMES.**
- 9. A riding or skull cap complying with at least PAS 015 or higher must be worn at all times when mounted with chin-strap fastened.**
- 10. Misuse of spurs or whips will incur elimination. Use of bad language by a competitor will result in them being asked to leave the showground.**
- 11. All competitors must act in a safe and responsible manner at all times.**
- 12. In the event of the show being cancelled, entry fees will be returned (less £2 per competitor to cover administration expenses). We will endeavour, in the first instance to re arrange the date and re run before making any refunds.**
- 13. All horses and ponies ridden in classes must be 4 yrs of age or over.**
- 15. PLEASE ABIDE BY THE VENUE RULES 1. Ensure you pick up your horse's droppings from the car park and warm up arenas. 2. No hay to be fed outside lorries. 3. Horses and ponies must not be left alone when tied outside horseboxes or trailers.**
