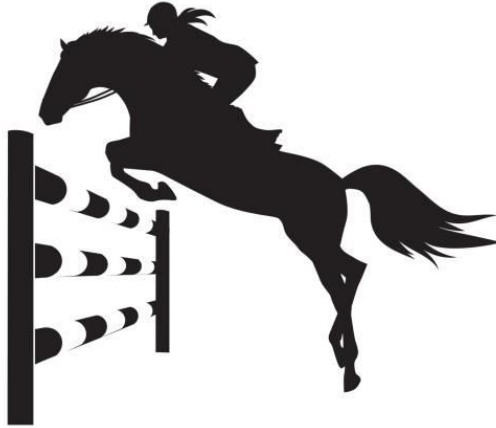

# Ring 1

START TIME 9.30 a.m.

*Classes 1-4 Pre-entry: £8, On the day entry: £11*

**Class 1 Introduction to Showjumping**  
Course: First 6 numbered fences are poles on the ground, fences numbered 7-12 (jump off) will be X-poles and straight poles not to exceed 20cms.  
Can be led/assisted  
The class will be split into RDA and non-RDA sections.

**Class 2 Mini Showjumping**  
Course: Fences to be 15-30cms, no fillers or spreads.  
Can be led/assisted (except if qualifying RDA Level 2)  
The class will be split into RDA, led/assisted and unassisted sections.

Classes 1 & 2 are also suitable for **RDA Levels 1 & 2 Showjumping**, class 2 being a *qualifier* for the *National Championships* in July 2021.

**Class 3 50cm Open** (Great Midlands Horse Show Qualifier)\*  
Course: Fences 1-6 not to exceed 50cms, fences 7-12 (jump off) not to exceed 60cms.  
The class will be split into *horse & pony sections*.

**Class 4 70cm Open** (Cricklands and Great Midlands Horse Show Qualifier)\*  
Course: Fences 1-6 not to exceed 70cms, fences 7-12 (jump off) not to exceed 80cms.  
The class will be split into *horse & pony sections*.

**Class 5 Horse and Hound**  
Course: Fences not to exceed 50cms, no fillers or spreads.  
Horse & rider jump fences 1-6, hand over baton to handler & dog, who jump fences 7-12.  
*Entire round is against the clock.*  
**Pre-entry fee:** £10, On the day: £14 (per team)

**Classes 1-4 will run two-phase and we will run a clear round for riders who do not wish to ride competitively in each class (£3 per round or 2 rounds for £5)**

## Ring 2

START TIME 9.30 a.m.

Class 6

### Handy Pony

A course will be running until 2 p.m. (rosettes for all participants, prizes for the winner of each age group).

Groups:

Children aged 5 and under

Children aged 9 and under

Children aged 10 and above

*£3 per round or 2 rounds for £5. All entries on the day.*

Class 7

### Fancy Dress

Can be led/assisted.

Mounted and unmounted both welcome.

*Pre-entry: £5, On the day entry: £8*

**Refreshments, food and a photographer will be available throughout the day.**

### *\*Qualifiers Information:*

1. All double clears in classes 3 & 4 qualify you for the *Great Midlands Horse Show* in August 2021.
2. All double clears in class 4 qualify you for the *Cricklands Jumping Winter League Finals* in April 2021.



# REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Organisers accept no responsibility for any damage or injury, that may occur to horse, rider, spectator or vehicle, howsoever caused.
2. The judges' decisions are final in all matters.
3. All people entering the Bank Farm Festival Horse Show are deemed to be governed by these Regulations & Conditions.
4. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse or refund any entry without giving a reason.
5. All riders must be properly attired. Hard hats must be worn at all times on the showground when mounted and must include permanently fitted, non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Footwear must have proper heels and no plimsolls or similar footwear are permitted.
6. No spurs may be worn in the Gymkhana and Handy Pony events.
7. All classes with horse & pony sections follow that ponies are not to exceed 148cms.
8. Assisted riders means that there may be a coach in the ring whilst the rider is completing the course.
9. All dogs **must** be kept on leads at all times. *It is the responsibility of anyone bringing a dog onto the showground to ensure that any fouling by his or her dog is removed and disposed of in a hygienic manner.*
10. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel and/or postpone any event at any time, notwithstanding that the event may have started.
11. Horses & ponies tied to lorry or trailers must not be left unattended.
12. All ponies must be 4 years old or over.
13. Any horse behaving in a way considered to be unsafe will be asked to leave the showground.
14. Unaccompanied competitors must provide emergency contact details to the show secretary.
15. **It is a legal requirement to carry your horse's passport with you when transporting. While we are not checking passports, there will be spot checks. If anyone does not have their passport, unfortunately, you will be asked to leave.**
