Enter as soon as you get your Ticket with your £12.00 Class Fee, Note the The Main Class splits will be -

Horses (for non m & m) Exceeding 14.2hh

Ponies (non m & m unless plaited) NOT Exceeding 14.2hh

M & M for M & M's, with the exception of Lead Rein/First Riddens which are Mixed type Classes.

Pony is to use Pony Classes and be under 14.2hh, Horse to use Horse Classes and Exceed 14.2hh and M & M to Use M & M classes.

The equine may only qualify for one class per section (ie a M & M CANNOT go in pony and a LR/FR cannot go in a non LR/ FR classes and Vice Versa).

No Change of Rider for Finale in the event of a pony being sold for example.

If a rider qualifies a Pony and an M & M for the Section championship, they may only bring 1 forward for that championship. In Hand if more than one pony qualified, you may designate a extra handler as its the pony being judged.

Yellow Back Numbers are Issued for Finale Classes Only and a time table will be issued prior to September, with the class timings for the golden ring as it is ran alongside a NORMAL Schedule Show.

The Outdoor Shows @Longmoor Lane do Not Require you to bring Vaccination Certificates we ask you to refer to our Good Show Protocol Policies Listed Below

Our Judges will never over touch your horses.

Never Share items at shows with persons from other yards ie buckets, bits, haynets and brushes.

If your horse seems "off Colour" do not take them to ANY events.

Do not make a fuss of strange horses or allow your horses to "make friends" with strange horses.

Bring enough forage / Water and do not allow horses to graze on show grounds and communal areas.

Keep space between yourselves prior to classes and in working in areas, rather than standing in a group.

Passports, with Vaccination records, should be carried at all times during transportation anyway, in the case of inspection.

It's just basic common sense, but all of the above are often seen at events, when the threat of infection doesn't seem as high risk, so do your bit to protect you and yours.

Please Read carefully the whole schedule and the description on the classes. Classes are run as per Notts Derby Rules which may differ from other shows – You Must read the schedule fully and abide by our rules and are deemed to have done this upon entering our show and classes. This WILL have altered since Last Year - Rules & Regulations may seem excessive but they are there to help the show and the competitor so are in place ultimately for your benefit, so take a few minutes to read this section, as by entering you are deemed to have read and agree to abide by these.

Entries- Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of their own entries. Competitors are asked to be accurate and clear when completing their entry forms, no responsibility for errors can be accepted.

M & M Classes are for Breeds Welsh ABCD or Shetland Fell, Dales, Connemara, Highlands, New Forest ,Dartmoor & Exmoor. Please Note we have classes for Part Bred ponies.

Amalgamation or Cancellation - We reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate classes with few entries, also to split large classes as deemed necessary on the day. If the Show HAS to be cancelled, due to circumstances beyond our control, any pre paid entries will be transferred to the rearranged show. Our Ground is VERY well draining – We will carry on come rain or shine, though may choose to walk/ trot only classes, and cancel or lower the jump heights any working hunter classes.

Objections/ Errors on Results – These must be made in writing to the secretary within 10 min of incident with a £50deposit for each protest. If the Protest is deemed honest, after enquiry, deposit will be returned Although The Judges decision is FINAL in all cases and anyone entering into any conflict with a judge or show official will be asked to leave show ground, where needed, escorted off by the police. Where a error is found on results after the class has been dismissed, the show reserves the right to strip any competitor of the award where necessary, where this is a class thatmarks awarded, the placing will be altered, in all other non marked classes, where a exhibit is found for whatever reason to have been illegible for the class or championship, the award and title will be stripped from them but it will NOT be re awarded to any other competitor. Results will only be published if time constraints allow.

Judges - We reserve the right to vary the panel of judges as deems necessary, Exhibitors are reminded not to show under a judge or any judge if the judge has had an interest in the exhibit, in the event of a judge change, as much notification will be given as possible. In the event of a conflict of interest in an exhibit, i.e. the animals has been owned, bred or produced by a judge or his/her member of their family, in the past or present. The competitor must withdraw from that class in this instance.

Liability - The Organisers **DO NOT HOLD THEMSELVES RESPONSIBLE** for loss or damage or injury (whether fatal or otherwise) to competitors, on lookers or spectators or their property or horse/pony in connection with any event, it shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to INDEMNIFY the promoters against any Legal action arising for any accident, incident or disagreement whatsoever. Exhibitors must hold their own third party insurance for animals attending the show and must be asked to produce a copy, where requested, This is Covered in MOST basic policies or BHS Gold cover is acceptable and very reasonable.

Spectators - are reminded that Horse and Ponies can be unpredictable and to take care of themselves and their children at all times. People behaving inappropriately will be advised, and if not taken notice of, will be asked to leave the venue. If you have "non horsey" persons attending the show to watch you, please ensure they are aware of potential hazards.

Appropriate Behaviour / Social Networking & Media / Bullying/ Harassment- Any Exhibitor or member of the public who conducts themselves inappropriately to Judges, Officials, Spectators, Other competitors or to their animals will be requested to leave the show ground or venue immediately, Under Police escort if required. We Reserve the right to request any person to leave if their behaviour is not appropriate. Inappropriate behaviour at the show, or about the show, prior too or after events, will result in a permanent ban for all concerned and their immediate family, from competing at ALL Notts Derby Horse Show and associated events in the future. The Judges decision is FINAL. We will not tolerate bullying or harassment of any type from the show, In Person, or on any social networking sites, if you cannot be polite and nice, we ask you not to come.

Riding Hats – All Handlers under 16 years MUST wear Current standard riding hat in ALL In Hand Classes, ALL riders are to wear Current standard Hats. Those over 18 Years that choose to wear a Beagler / Bowler/ Stetson or Top Hat in FLAT classes or Concours, may do so but must have obtained aDisclaimer Pass (only needed once per year), Understanding that we have advised them we would prefer them to wear a strapped hat, but as a adult accept they risks to themselves by not wearing one. Judges are instructed to disregard headwear type anyhow in any judge decision on placings in classes.

Body Protectors / Air Jackets May Be worn IN ANY CLASS without being penalised.

Rubbish & Waste - Please take your rubbish home with you and do not muck out horse transport onto the field/venue, The more rubbish you take home, the less our waste disposal costs are.

Spurs & Whips & Rider Size - No persons under 18 yrs to wear spurs. Spurs may not be worn in Pony, M & M or Veteran Classes. Note Overuse or Misuse of Whips or canes will result in removal from classes. We will if we feel an animals welfare is jeopardised, step in and ask you to leave. Please ensure you are a suitable size for the pony you are riding, Non M & M Children's ponies should not be ridden by adults, Excessive working, Tying in of Horses and will not be tolerated, and will be monitored.

SPURS MAY NOT BE WORN IN NOVICE RIDDEN CLASSES.

Bridle / First Ridden/ Novice Bitting Arrangements/Bitless - Lead Rein competitors/ ponies must have a snaffle bit (including wilkie types) & lead be attached to noseband at all times & Not be Exceeding 12.2hh, REINS MUST NOT BE KNOTTED SHORT, Neck Straps or Saddle Straps are Permitted, First Ridden Ponies can be ridden **in any suitable bit/ bridle**, we place no restrictions on any other classes **EXCEPT Novice where snaffles are to be worn**, as to the type of bridle that may be used though Judges will be instructed to take note of the bridle/ bits effectiveness. You will not be penalised for wearing a snaffle in an open class. – Please note these are our show rules and not those of other shows, so do check eligibility to wear any bridle at any events that you may qualify for – Ponies welfare will be taken into consideration, and any misuse of a bit, will result in elimination from that class. **Bitless Exhibits** will be allowed in all classes. As with all bridles, attention will be paid to the effectiveness.

Stallions & Colts Welcome under adequate control of a knowledgeable handler age 14 years and over. Safety is a priority and if the animal constitutes a danger to the handler or itself it will be asked to leave the class/ area. Stallion & Colts Handlers / Riders Must be over the age of 14 except ridden small breeds, which must have attained 12th Birthday

Payments / Refunds All classes to be paid for prior to entry & No Refunds or Credit Given, this includes clashing or missed classes or classes entered in error, we will if possible swap you to another suitable class or offer a voucher for the following show at the secretaries discretion. Cash / pay pal or credit / debit card payments only . Cheques for pre entries by post only, RETURNED Cheques for pre entries incur an administration charge of £10. We will refund fees if we cancel the classes. We do reserve the right to refund you at our discretion, if a genuine problem arises (Lost Shoe and no farrier on site/ available)

Clashing / Missed Classes - We will try and run classes on time but cannot be held responsible for clashing or missed classes. We Advise competitors to watch for classes and we will advise of any delays & ring Changes over the speaker system, but will not necessarily call for individuals or each class, Please watch your rings and advise Stewards of any problem. Competitors are responsible for getting themselves to the correct rings on time. No Class will start before its sections allotted not before start time, though rings may vary. If you miss your class through not being ready ON TIME, then we will not swap your classes.

WE ARE UNABLE TO TELL YOU AS WE TAKE ON THE DAY ENTRIES HOW MANY ARE IN EACH CLASS, PLEASE DO NOT, COME AND ASK AT BUSY TIMES, AS THE STAFF WILL BE BUSY ENSURING THAT ALL ENTRIES ARE BOOKED IN CORRECTLY. Check the Board at the truck from Mid Morning

Horse Ages Horse/Ponies/ Foals are aged as of the 1st of January in the current year, a foal is born 2020, a yearling will be an animal born in 2019, 2 YO 2018, 3 year old 2017. Where an issue arises a passport or Vets certificate may be requested. 2019 Foals Must be at least 3 weeks of age and ONLY be shown with their Dams until the later in the year shows where they may be shown weaned in suitable classes. PLEASE ASK IF YOU ARE UNSURE ALL HORSES BIRTHDAYS ARE JANUARY 1ST REGARDLESS OF IF THEY WERE BORN ACTUALLY LATER IN THE YEAR.

Rider Ages & Lead Rein / FR Ponies Riders ages will be taken as they were on the 1st Jan of the current year, for all classes, if a child is now 10 but was 9 on 1st January 2020 they are for the purpose of this show and any classes, 9 years old. Lead Rein 9 Years & 12.2hh Max, FR 12 Years and 13.2hh – Please note These are NOT the Normal Ages for ALL Shows, so if you do qualify for any other shows you need to check the eligibility of the age limits

Dogs to be kept on leads and cleaned up after. Anyone found to let a dog foul and not clear it up will be banned from future events, Dog faeces is a hazard to children and highly unpleasant. Any bagged dog waste must be removed from the field (there is a designated poo bin across the road near the motorway bridge)

The Judges Decision is final in all cases! Remember it is one Judges Decision on one day, Rudeness of any type will not be tolerated. We aim to change our judges regularly, so don't be put off by a placing, as all judges have their own opinions. No equine under the age of 4 years to compete in any ridden class or be ridden at the venue (as of Jan 1st in current year) where an issue arises a passport or Vets certificate may be requested.

Handlers For Lead Rein exhibits- Must be 14 yrs or older.

will make the final decision.

Young Handlers (+ All entrants 16 & Under in All Classes) Must wear a British Current Standard Riding hat. NO STALLION or ANIMALS UNDER 4yrs In Young Handler Classes If ANY animal in a young handler class constitutes a danger to its handler or other competitors, it will be requested to leave the class.

Parking - Please Park where you are asked to by the attendants, Verbal Abuse or confrontation with any attendant, volunteer or member of NDHS Staff is taken very seriously and you will be banned from all future events.

Admittance to Classes - Once a Class is In Progress and the Gate is Closed, No Other Entrants will be let in without the Judges express permission. The judge may decline to admit late exhibits, AT NDHS you may leave to go to another class if clashing occurs, it is at the discretion of the Judges for you to come back in. You may need to prioritize which classes you enter in the event of clashing Entry Rejection & Any other issue – The Show Secretary reserves the absolute right to reject ANY entry and will not enter into any correspondence regarding the rejection. Where a problem occurs and is not covered in the rules please consult the show secretary who

Welfare & Transportation – Please Ensure Animals are Transported in Safe suitable vehicles, that are suitably partitioned and divided for the Amount Travelling

Have a Nice Day -please enter into the spirit of this by making it a pleasant nice day for all concerned. The organisers have taken a lot of time and effort to make this day a success so enjoy it, have a go at something new, Please note no unpleasantness of any description will be Tolerated

Class Definitions & Useful Information

Ridden Showing

Judged on Conformation, Type, Way of going and Overall Presentation

Style & Appearance

Very similar to ridden showing but less emphasis of conformation and type, more on way of going and overall presentation

A Ridden Showing Piece

In Ridden Classes, Some Judges may set a show piece. This will not be pre announced and is at the Judges discretion. If a Normal freestyle showpiece is requested keep it short and simple. A Judge has a limited time to assess you - They need to see a walk away, a trot on both reins, and a canter & extension in suitable aged class, plus a clean halt. In hack classes extra moves can be added, but sometimes adding non required movements and they can going wrong can mess up a showpiece - save rein back, flying changes and & serpentines for Equitation Style classes.

Turnout for Type of Horse or Pony

Hunter Ponies/ Hunters -

Tweed Jackets, Cream, beige Jodhpurs, Long Boots/Gaiters, Tie, Short Boots for under 16s, Plain Tack, Snaffle/Pelham/Double Bridles, Plain Caverson Noseband, Plaited Mane, Pulled or Plaited Tail, Trimmed Up

Mountain + Moorlands

Turnout for Riders as per hunters, also for tack, but shown natural and only trimmed as per the breed standards allow, Please refer to Breed Society Handbook or NPS Handbook for more Details

Show Cobs

Turnout as for hunters but shown with trimmed legs and hogged manes

Traditional Cobs

Turnout for rider/tack as per hunters, but shown in full hair as per M+M

Show Ponies / Hacks & Pure Bred & Part Bred Arabians also

Tack as per hunters - more delicate/finer bridle with addition of a coloured brow band & buttonhole - navy jacket for under 16s, black may be worn over 16s, always with a Tie

Riding Horses/Ex Racehorses

Tack as per show ponies/hacks unless ex racehorse more of a chunkier hunter type - then refer to hunter turnout - tweed or navy Jackets.

Coloured/Spotted Horses or Ponies

Refer to the type, so if chunkier or traditional go for the tack and Attire of a hunter, same if a native coloured. If a finer type - refer to the show pony/hack category

Rare/Foreign/ Unusual Types

Refer to breed manuals, Spanish/American/Continental Draught Types may be shown in traditional attire.

In Hand Class Turnout

Refer to turnout of types section although in hand bridles may be used, also handler attire, trousers, suitable footwear and waistcoats may be worn

Young Handler

Must be a Mare/Gelding, over 4 years (unless a breed specific shows) Hard hats & Gloves and Suitable Footwear to be worn

In Hand Show Piece

You will be walked around clockwise, always present your pony or horse. You will then do a simple trot around the ring individually, don't forget to add a halt and a thank you to the judge. You will be lined up either randomly or in a preliminary order and assessed individually - present your equine standing level and attentive while the judge assesses. You will be asked to walk away, do a nice balanced turn and trot straight back towards your judge. It is vital you do this so the judge can see the movement of your horse, you will then return to the line and do a final walk before final placing and line up.

Equitation and Ridability

These are not judged on the horse or ponies conformation & turnout but soley on the riding ability for age and experience. The judge may request a serpentine or rein back. Attention will be paid to the riders hands/feet/position.

Fun Classes

These are just that and judged at a walk, ideal for all ages individual shows is not required, Must have Correct Hat & Footwear, Although other show attire is not required.

Concours D Elegance

A walk / Trot class with the sole criteria being the elegance and finish of the costume, Stocks may be worn in Concours classes.

Working Hunter

This class combines x2 phases, Jumping a course of rustic fences followed by a show piece, similar to that of a ridden show. Marks are awarded for various elements

- Jumping phase max marks 50 with deductions for faults 10 for knockdown / 15 1st refusal/ 20 2nd refusal/ elimination 3rd refusal
- A mark from 20 for style & manners from jumping, you may end up on a minus score and a clear round may not always beat a better ridden round with a fault. After all having jumped the ones with the highest marks from 70 from phase 1 will return for phase 2

On Occasion, if a busy show a judge may request a show piece after the jumping phase to enable smooth running Phase 2

- 15 marks max for manners & way of going
- 15 for conformation, type and freedom of movement, both scores are then added for final placings

Tack for working hunter classes is similar to that of standard hunter or M+M class, although martingales/breastplates and gag type bits are also allowed and boots of a plain colour for phase 1 jumping to be removed for phase 2, No Change of tack other than boot removal between phases.

Showing must haves

A Strapped current BS standard safety hat - unless 18 years + in which case a beagler, bowler, top hat maybe worn upon signature of a disclaimer form for FLAT Classes.

- -Gloves of a suitable colour
- -Cane/ Whip of a suitable length
- -Hair to be netted/Bunned/Plaited as required
- -Minimal makeup or enhancement to animals. Ensure M+Ms retain breed standards
- -Showing is always a tie, stocks are for actual hunting/ dressage only
- -Less is more, Plain tack for showing, discreet numnah if needed, brow tack is preferable but not essential and a well fitting saddle
- Martingales + other nosebands are not for use in flat classes, may be used in working hunter and other bitting and martingales

Common Phrases You May Hear

Affiliated/Affiliation

Certain classes are on certain dates are affiliated to a society, this could be a breed society or association. Where a class is affiliated, the rules & regulation for this society overrule NDHS rules.

Qualification

This means you may qualify for other events and finals. You will need to collect cards / print cards, read them, sign them and check the criteria with the society or group to ensure eligible rules/ heights etc may vary from NDHS rules etc.

Stripping & Ride Judge

This does not happen at the majority of NDHS events. We will advise if this will be requested if we are affiliated to a society or organisation. Ride judges at other shows will ride your horse instead of you providing a ridden show,, also in these classes you are "stripped" ie the saddle removed and the horse/pony trotted up in hand and re tacked up. You will require a groom if this happens

Championship

This is a separate class for which you qualify for by being 1st or 2nd in various classes, You wear your Rosettes.

Supreme Championship

Various section champion & reserves qualify for these, Note please come in without any sashes or Rosettes Previously won.

Subscriber Championship

This is a special championship for all gaining a highest placed subscriber vouchers on the day judged at a walk by guest judge(s)

Subscription

A Fee Paid for a NDHS points card- you attain points in various classes, see card for details. Basically a membership with minimal commitment from the competitor, points are awarded for end of season presentation - see card for minimum attendance details – You are responsible for having your card checked and stamped and handing it in per show, this goes for Pink Showing, Blue Performance and Green Winter.

The UK Riders Championships 2020 is a perfect opportunity for unaffiliated combinations of horse and rider to take part in a UK National Championship, professionally run, within an encouraging, fun and supportive environment.

The Challenge has a 2-tier structure. Firstly, local qualifiers are held around the country from the 1st September 2019 up to 9th August 2020. On attaining the relevant qualifying criteria and becoming a Member of UK Riders, competitors will then be eligible to take part in the UK Riders National Championship . Three disciplines are on offer this year, Dressage, Showjumping and Showing.

The Dressage Challenge offers tests from Intro to Elementary and the Showjumping Challenge offers heights start at 40cm up to and including 1m. Showing consists of both In Hand & Ridden classes with a wide-ranging selection of classes.

The Challenge is split into two sections, Pony, (14.2hh & under) and Horse, (above 14.2hh).

UK RIDERS CHAMPIONSHIPS

To compete in the Championships, you need to qualify and must become a member of UK Riders. Qualification is a three-phase process.

Phase 1: Take part in a local qualifier between 1st September of the preceding year and mid-August of the Championship Year. Click on the drop down list of Qualifying Centres on the menu above to find a qualifying centre near you.

Phase 2: On attaining the relevant qualifying criteria (see <u>Dressage Rules</u> and <u>Showjumping Rules</u>), you need to become a member of UK Riders. You are then eligible take part in in the UK Riders National Championship.

Phase 3: To enter, you need to find the UK Riders Championships on the Equo Events website.

Please see the relevant pages for rules regarding each individual discipline.



First, second and third placed horses/ponies not already qualified in eligible classes will qualify for the Champion of Britain Title classes to be held at Addington Manor, Buckingham on Sunday 13th September 2020. If a horse/pony has already qualified, cards may be handed down to 6th place at judge's discretion. Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring which will enable the owner to enter the Championship Show, provided the owner and rider/handler are, or become registered with the Concours d'Elegance Society within 21 days of the qualifying show.
