- 1. This competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2020. Eligibility rules for Area Qualifiers do not apply.
- 2. The decision of the Judges, Organisers and Jury is final. They reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any part of the competition, or refuse entry without stating a reason.
- 3. In the event of cancellation, the entry fee less £15 to cover administration costs, will be refunded on receipt of a SAE by 1st August 2020.
- 4. Entry Fees will only be refunded up to the closing date, 14th June. After this date we will make a refund on receipt of a doctor or vet certificate if we can fill the place from a wait list.
- 5. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY** Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- 6. **HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY** Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
- 7. **HATS** meeting current Pony Club standards (as in the 2020 rule book) MUST be worn at all times when mounted. All hats must be correctly fitted and tagged. Hats and body protectors to be brought to the Secretary's tent when collecting numbers to be checked.
- 8. **BODY PROTECTORS**, which are up to the current Pony Club standard (as in the2020 Rule book) are recommended for Show Jumping and are compulsory for Cross Country. If a rider chooses to wear an air jacket, it must only be used in addition to a normal body protector and in the event of a fall it must be removed or deflated before continuing.
- 9. SPURS are not allowed in Class 1, 2 or 3
- 10. Any queries or complaints must be in writing and handed to the Organisers within 30 minutes of the incident together with a fee of £20 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 11. Ponies competing in Class 1A or 2A may also compete in Class 3 or 4, but may not compete twice in Class 1 or 2. No competitor may ride more than two horses/ponies This will be at the discretion of the organisers and in the event of oversubscription riders may only be allowed to ride one pony.

12. NO STALLIONS.

- 13. Competitors must present themselves to the steward for tack inspection at least 20 minutes before their dressage time.
- 14. Competitors who are eliminated in the Show Jumping phase may go Cross Country only with the permission of the Show Jumping Officials.
- 15. There will not be a farrier on site.

Helpful Hints for Beginners

- Ponies and riders should be neatly turned out, with beige jodphurs, a tweed jacket, tie and PC badge for dressage and show jumping and gloves for dressage. Riders may wear coloured shirts for cross country.
- A solid coloured numnah (contrast piping allowed) and girth for dressage and show jumping.
- For dressage you may carry a whip but your pony must not wear a martingale, grass reins (except Class 1 & 2), boots or bandages. You may use a neck strap.
- All long hair and all girls hair unless very short must be tied in a hair net.
- Prize giving must be attended in your dressage clothes and with your hat.
- Body Protectors are compulsory for XC and must comply with current PC rules.
