- No misuse of the whip, equipment or practice fences will be allowed.
- All dogs must be kept on leads.
- All competitors are required to wear headgear that complies with the highest current safety standard.
- Horses and Ponies MUST NOT be tied to the side of horseboxes or trailers and left unattended – please clear up any mess left by you or your horses in the bins and muck trailers provided

Stallion owners/riders are also asked to note and comply with rule 102.11.
- Junior members competing on horses are only able to do so from the beginning of the calendar year in which the age of 12 is reached.
- In order to keep the competition centre clean and tidy, please DO NOT muck out your lorries and trailers in the car park. Please use facilities provided.
- In the event of insufficient starters lower prizes may be withheld in accordance with Rule 76.6.
