(class heights = height in first section/round)

CLASS ONE: 70cm **CLASS TWO:** 80cm

A. PC Winter SJ Series Debut preliminary round (formerly Dengie series)

B for all those **not** in section A

CLASS THREE: 90 cm

A. PC Winter SJ Series Winter League preliminary round (formerly Dengie series)

B for all those not in Section A

CLASS FOUR: 1m

CLASS FIVE*: 1.10m (height of the Area Winter Series Open competition)

All Classes are for Teams and Individuals (see Rule #3) and will be run single phase.

* Class 5 may be for Individuals only depending on entry numbers

Classes 2A and 3A qualify for the Area Winter Series Debut and WL competitions, respectively.

The numbers qualifying depend on entry numbers in the section. Riders do not have to be members of The Pony Club to gain an Area Qualifying card, but must become a member **before** entering the Area competition.

The Area 9 Area Winter Series competitions will be on March 22nd at Hartpury run by the Worcestershire Branch

ROSETTES: to at least sixth place for teams and individuals in each class, except as follows –

Classes Two & Three will run with one set of team placings, for each class, (team members may be in either section), and one set of individual placings for each class, covering both sections.

Winter Series qualifier cards only, will be awarded for Section A.

Classes will be run under 2020 Pony Club Show jumping Rules, apart from Classes 2A and 3A which will be run under 2019 PC SJ Rules and the 2019/2020 Winter Series Rules Book – all relevant rule books are available on the main PC website (www.pcuk.org).

Rule 26: The first fall of rider which means elimination (2020 Rules) will be enforced in all classes and sections.

ENTRY FEES: (to include a First Aid contribution)

Classes 1, 2B, 3B 4, and 5: £14 per combination per class

Classes 2A and 3A: £15 per combination which includes a £1 Pony Club levy (which is sent to PC HQ).

TEAM MANAGERS – Please ensure that all your riders are aware of the Rules and Notices.

PLEASE READ THE RULES & NOTICES AND DISCLAIMERS AT THE END OF THE SCHEDULE

Closing date for entries – Monday 24th February 2020:

Entries will close before 24th February if classes are full and a waiting list will be held.

If you miss the closing date please contact the Entries Secretary for any available spaces.

Entries will only be accepted with full payment; either a cheque with a paper entry form or a BACS payment with an email entry form. If you would like to pay by BACS please contact the Entries Secretary a.s.a.p. for the bank details, and you may then enter by scanning and emailing the entry form. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt/ payment.

DISCLAIMERS

- 1. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee, or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars/ lorries/trailers, their contents and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- 2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
- 3. All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Croome Hunt Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover them.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. PASSPORTS horses will not be allowed on the ground without their passport with valid flu vaccinations please scan (no photographs please) and email pages showing all vaccinations from (and including) the primary course and first page showing the horse's name to the Entries Secretary by 26th February for a quicker entry onto the ground. Please check Hartpury's conditions for flu vacs i.e. annual or six monthly. Passports will be checked for compliance at the Secretary when collecting your rider number; please do not unload before collecting your number. A horse with a non-compliant passport will NOT be allowed to compete and there will be no refund of entry. Please allow time for passport checking.
- 2. Teams to be made up of 3 or 4 combinations, with the best three scores to count.
- 3. Substitutions allowed please tell the Secretary (Entries before the day, Show on the day).
- 4. Individuals in all Classes will be put in to teams where possible.
- 5. **TEAM MANAGERS:** entries will be accepted in receipt order.

See times on Croome P.C. website for accepted entries (branches.pcuk.org/croome).

- 6. **Pre-entries are essential as entries will be limited.** If you miss the closing date please email/phone the Entries Secretary for available spaces. A waiting list will be held if necessary.
- 7. Closing date for entries Monday 24th February 2020.

Withdrawal refunds given only on the receipt of a relevant doctor/vet certificate received by the Entries Secretary by 7th March 2020. Refunds will be done by BACS only - please scan the certificate and email the Entries Secretary with your bank details (bank, sort code and account number).

8. If the show is cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control, entry fees will be refunded by BACS on receipt of an email request by 7th March 2020. Please email details as above.

Any refund may be subject to an administration fee.

9. TIMES / DRAWN ORDERS WILL BE GIVEN – please see the Croome P.C. website

(branches.pcuk.org./croome) by the evening of 28th February. Please wait until the evening to see your times – they will be up asap.

Competitors may be asked to jump up to 15 minutes before their estimated time – please be ready.

If you miss your turn, you may have to wait to the end of the class and will only be able to jump if time allows.

- 10. Competitor numbers MUST be visible at all times whilst mounted.
- 11. Indoor warm-up (adjacent to Arena) the number of competitors will be restricted; please obey the steward's instructions as to when you can use the Arena indoor warm-up.
- 12. Children (under 16) must not jump in either warm-up arena without an accompanying adult.
- 13. Each horse/pony may only compete once in each class and in a maximum of three classes.

All horse/ponies must be at least 5 years old on day of competition. Stallions are allowed with prior permission from the Entries Secretary and must have stallion discs and ribbons on; any stallion ridden by a Pony Club member **must** have written permission from their DC/Centre Proprietor which must be sent to the Entries Secretary with the entry form. 14. Turnout for ALL riders and horses should be as in the Pony Club Rules for Show-jumping 2020. Please contact the Entries Secretary BEFORE the show day for any queries re dress/turnout.

- 15. **SPURS**: ALL spurs worn anywhere on the showground, by **any** competitor, must comply with Pony Club rules. Misuse of spurs by any competitor will be recorded and reported and may result in disqualification from the competition 16. Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found doing so will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority. 17. Judges' decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Show Secretary in writing with a £30 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 15 minutes of the incident and BEFORE the prize-giving for that class.
- 18. **INSURANCE**; please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.
- 19. **PHOTOGRAPHS:** by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please tell the photographer on entering the arena, before you jump.
- 20. Participants attend at their own risk; neither the Committee nor Hartpury College will be liable for any loss, damage or accident to horses, riders, property or other persons.
- 21. No horses/ponies should be left tied to the outside of trailers/lorries without supervision (N.B. There is no gate between the lorry park and the main road). Please clear any muck/rubbish and do not leave on the lorry park.
- 22. The show will be run under The Pony Club Show jumping Rules 2020, apart from Classes 2A and 3A which will be run under 2019 PC SJ Rules (available online on the main PC website) and the 2019/2020 Winter Series Rules.
