Please note all attending equines must have flu vaccs within the last six months – checks will be made.

PLEASE NOTE: The venue will be completing equine passport checks upon arrival of all horses to site and if they are not presented then they will not be able to enter the site. They are also checking to ensure that all equine animals that come on to site have had a flu vaccination within the last 6 months so therefore the latest date that any horses will have been vaccinated to attend your event will have been 26<sup>th</sup> July 2019. Those horses that have later dates for the vaccination again will not be able to enter the site.

Classes for all, members and non-members everyone welcome. Very relaxed atmosphere especially for the lower classes and novice riders.

Dress code is any suitable clothing doesn't have to be shirt and jacket but can be if that's what you are comfortable with.

Class 1 – Cross poles – for the novice horse and rider

Class 2- 50cm

Class 3- 60cm

Clear round for those wanting to try some slightly bigger fences without the pressure of competition – will run for around half an hour.

Class 4 – 70cm - for this class there will be an optimum time worked out at 350 metres per minute. Winner will be nearest to the optimum time with the lowest amount of faults.

Class 5 – 80cm Not to start before 1pm

Class 6 - 90cm

Class 7 - 100cm
