Class heights: the class height is the maximum height of fences in the first section; fences in the jump-off section may be increased by up to 5cm over the class height.

ENTRY FEES:

Show Jumping classes: £12 per combination per class; Entries on the day: £14 per combination per class

£3 First Aid per combination (one pony/one rider) First aid is payable in cash on the day at the secretary's box.

Rosettes: to sixth place in each class.

CLOSING DATE: Pre-entries close on the Saturday before the competition. Entries are available on the day. If classes are full before the closing date, then a waiting list will be held. Start Time: Class 1, will not start before 9.00am.

TIMES: Start lists with times will be in the documents section of Equo Events, and Tumpy Green Equestrian Centre's Facebook page; by the evening of Saturday before the competition.

PRIZEGIVING: class presentations will take place immediately after each class.

Double clears in qualifying classes

Blue Chip Festival of Equestrianism Championship:

Direct Qualification: Registered horse/rider combinations can gain direct qualification to the championships by obtaining a total of three 1st-3rd placed results in any one class to secure a place at the finals.

League Tables: Registered horse/rider combinations that are in the top 15% of the league table at the qualification process (21st June 2020) that have not gained a direct qualification to the championships will

secure their space. The league tables are also placed individually at the end of the year – separate to the championship class.

The Sunshine Tour

The Sunshine Tour Championships held at The All England Jumping Course, Hickstead. The Championships are for unaffiliated and amateur competitors in Dressage from Intro to Elementary, Show Jumping from Lead Rein to 1.05m; Showing for lead rein, in-hand, ridden, working hunter, veterans, plus many more, Eventers Challenge from 60cm through to 1m. Trailblazers Direct Qualifier

1st-8th placed competitors in qualifying classes, regardless of faults accumulated, qualify for championships.

Qualification Letters can be picked up from the Secretaries box on the day of the competition. The Competitor will then have the choice to take up the qualification or not. Should the Competitor decide to accept the qualification for the second rounds, then they will return the congratulatory letter (within 14 days) together with £12 and ONE stamped addressed envelope, to the Venue of Qualification. The envelope will be used to return a Qualification Card. Alternatively you can purchase the direct qualification card on the day at the Secretaries box.

The Qualification Card can be used to compete in any Trailblazers Championship class at the level qualified.

DISCLAIMERS

1. 2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

3. All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Tumpy Green Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover them.

RULES AND NOTICES

1. Substitutions allowed – please tell the Secretary (Entries before the day, Show on the day).

2. Pre-entries are essential as entries will be limited. If you miss the closing date please ring/ email the Entries Secretary for available spaces.

3. Closing date for entries – Thursday before the competition. Withdrawal refunds given on receipt of a relevant doctor/vet certificate received by the Entries Secretary within a week of the competition (please enclose an s.a.e.)

4. If the show is cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control, entry fees will be help in credit for a future event. Any refund will be subject to an administration fee.

5. TIMES WILL BE GIVEN – please see the documents section of Equo Events. Competitors may be asked to jump up to 15 minutes before their given time – please be ready.

6. Warm-up Arena – the number of competitors may be restricted; please obey the steward's instructions as to when you can use the warm-up.

7. Children must not jump in the warm-up arena without an accompanying adult.

8. Each horse/pony may only compete once in any given class. Stallions are allowed only with prior permission from the Entries Secretary and must wear stallion discs and ribbons. All horse/ponies must be at least 4 years old on day of competition.

9. Turnout for ALL riders and horses should be as in the Pony Club / Riding Club Rules for Show-jumping 2018. Please contact the Entries Secretary BEFORE the show day for any queries re dress/turnout.

10. Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found doing so will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.

11. Judges' decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Show Secretary in writing with a £20 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 15 minutes of the incident and BEFORE the prize-giving for that class.

12. INSURANCE; please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.

13. PHOTOGRAPHS: by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please tell the photographer on entering the arena, before you jump.

14. Participants attend at their own risk; neither the Committee nor Tumpy Green Competition Centre will be liable for any loss, damage or accident to horses, riders, property or other persons.

15. No horses/ponies should be left tied to the outside of trailers/lorries without supervision. Please clear any muck/rubbish and do not leave on the lorry park. Please be aware that there is no gate between the lorry park and the main road. All hay must be collected and removed from the lorry park.

16. The show will be run under The Pony Club Show jumping Rules 2019.
