

# In the Spotlight Corporation Horse Show

## Ridden & In-hand Shows

**Sun 2<sup>nd</sup> Feb, Sun 1<sup>st</sup> Mar, Sun 5<sup>th</sup> Apr & Sun 26<sup>th</sup> Apr 2020**

Held at Milton Equestrian Centre, Carlton Forest, Blyth Road, Worksop, Notts, S81 0TP

Membership £10 per rider/handler & horse combination

Members £8 per class, Non-members £10 per class

All of our shows are affiliated to STARS Southern to be held at Addington Manor on 14<sup>th</sup>/15<sup>th</sup> November 2020. We will send the points winners of each qualifying/relevant class (if eligible as per STARS rules) to represent us at the championships. If the winners cannot attend this will be offered to 2<sup>nd</sup> place, if they can't attend it will be offered to 3<sup>rd</sup> but no lower. Points will only start being accrued once membership is paid. Points are accrued per rider/handler & horse combination, no substitutes are allowed for the purpose of points. Points winners will be notified by 31<sup>st</sup> May 2020 and the final points list will be published. Please keep a record of your placings as reference should any issues/queries arise.

Points will be allocated as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> = 5, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 4, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 3, 4<sup>th</sup> = 2 and 1 point will be issued for any unplaced members. In the event we have a tie on points, the person who has been placed 1<sup>st</sup> more times will be the winner.

Qualifier for TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals

**SR NAF Five Star Showing Finals** - This show is a qualifier for the 2020 TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

**TSR NAF Five Star Riders Finals** - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification flyer in the ring.

**TSR NAF Five Star In Hand Finals** - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand sheet will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their sheet signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>

## **In hand 9am start – (Indoor)**

1. **Youngstock** – 3yrs old & under (will split into age groups if sufficient entries)
2. **In-hand Hogged / Native / Traditional / Gypsy Cob**
3. **In-hand Foreign / Rare Breeds** – including heavy horses
4. **Best Condition** – Any age & type
5. **In-hand M&M and Welsh** – will split small & large if sufficient entries.
6. **In-hand Coloured** – including unusual coloured (will be split if sufficient entries)
7. **In-hand Pony** – Any age & type
8. **In-hand Pure & Part Bred** – Open to any pure & part bred
9. **In-hand Rescue Horse / Pony** – Any age & type
10. **In-hand Horse** – Any age & type
11. **In-hand Veteran** – 15yrs and over
12. **Young Handler** – will split 10yrs & under, 11-18yrs
13. **Most Promising New Combination** – Any age & type. To be in their 1<sup>st</sup> show season together.

### **Supreme In-Hand Championship for all 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 1-13**

## **Ridden Classes not before 12.30pm – Indoor Arena**

These classes will not start before 12.30pm but may start later depending how busy the morning classes are.

14. **Best Turned Out** – Any age, type. Will not be required to do a go round, will just be lined up.
15. **Pre-Novice Walk & Trot** – 4yrs old & over (will split into horses & ponies if sufficient entries) Animals not to have won a 1<sup>st</sup> before 01.01.20 in any open ridden class. Snaffle Bridles Only.
16. **Ridden Novice** – 4yrs old & over (will split into Horses & Ponies if sufficient entries) Animals not to have won a 1<sup>st</sup> before 01.01.20 in any open ridden class. Any Suitable Bridle. Walk & trot on the go-round, canter required in individual show.

### **Novice Championship for all 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 15 & 16**

17. **Lead Rein Pony** – 4yrs old & over. Riders not to have attained their 10<sup>th</sup> birthday before the 01.01.20. Ponies not exceeding 128cms.
18. **First Ridden Pony** – 4yrs old & over. Riders not to have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before the 01.01.20. Ponies not exceeding 128cms.

### **Mini Championship for all 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 17 & 18**

19. **Equitation** – Will be split into Junior (not to have attained their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday before 01.01.20) and Senior (to have attained their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday before 01.01.20). Snaffle Bridles Only, No Spurs.
20. **Riding Club Horse / Pony** – 4yrs old & over. Will include a small jump. (will split if sufficient entries)
21. **Ridden Hunter Horse/Pony** – 4yrs old & over
22. **Ridden Hogged Cob / Native / Traditional / Gypsy Cob** – 4yrs old & over
23. **Ridden Veteran** – 15yrs old & over
24. **Ridden Pure & Part Bred** – 4yrs old & over
25. **Ridden M&M** – 4yrs old & over (will split into Small & Large breeds if sufficient entries)
26. **Ridden Open Showing** – 4yrs old & over, any type
27. **Ridden Coloured** – 4yrs old & over

### **Supreme Ridden Championship for all Champions & Reserves from Mini, Novice & Ridden Championships**

## RULES

1. The Judge's decision is final
2. Any objection must be lodged within 10 minutes of class closing together with a £20 fee which will be returned if the objection is upheld. Where an objection is lodged towards the height of a horse or pony, if a valid height certificate cannot be produced on the day then the objection will stand and the animal will be disqualified from the class and the prize (if awarded one) will be taken off them and handed to the next eligible competitor. Where the objection relates to an age of a competitor, a valid form of ID will be required to prove their age. If this cannot be produced on the day then the objection will stand and the rider will be disqualified from the class and the prize (if awarded one) will be taken off them and handed to the next eligible competitor.
3. All ages for both horse & rider are taken from the 1st of January in the current year. All riders/handlers must have attained their 3rd birthday on the date of the show. All ridden horse/ponies must be at least 4yrs old to compete in a ridden class.
4. The Organisation reserve the right to alter, amalgamate or cancel classes if sufficient/insufficient entries.
5. Hard Hats to current BSI standards with a chin strap to be worn in all ridden classes, and in-hand classes by handlers 16 years and under unless a Non-Standard Hat Disclaimer is signed. Non-Standard Hat Disclaimer cards must be carried by competitors at all times and produced to the ring steward upon entering the ring. Top Hats may be worn in Championships & Supreme Championship.
6. Whips are not to exceed 30".
7. No refund of entries will be allowed under any circumstances.
8. The organisers accept no responsibility or liability for any loss, incident or accident(s) to persons, equines or property. The Landowners of this show will not be held responsible in any way for any loss, damage or injury in any way. All competitors should hold a minimum of third party liability insurance.
9. No Mucking out of horseboxes on the showground.
10. The Organisers reserve the right to ask any one demonstrating cruelty or anti-social behaviour to leave the showground and will be banned from any future events.
11. IF YOU ARE NOT PRESENT WHEN YOUR CLASS IS DUE TO START THEN YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED INTO THE RING ONCE THE CLASS HAS STARTED. IT IS UP TO THE COMPETITOR TO ENSURE THEY DO NOT MISS THEIR CLASS. YOU WILL NOT BE REFUNDED IF YOU MISS A CLASS.
12. WALK & TROT and NOVICE CLASSES – Any horse or pony that has been placed 1st in any Open Ridden class before the 1st Jan 2020 is not eligible for these classes. Please enter this class in the spirit that it is intended.
13. No spurs are allowed to be worn by any competitor under the age of 16yrs in any class. Any competitor over the age of 16yrs may wear spurs if riding a horse exceeding 148cms and if the class allows it.
14. **No form of bullying or harassment, whether in person or on social media will be tolerated and any person found to be doing so will be banned from all events and removed from the showground immediately. Any online bullying will be reported to police and appropriate action will be taken.**
15. Foals must be at least 30 days old on the show day. No mare with a foal at foot may compete in ridden classes.
16. No horse/pony to be left tied to a trailer/lorry unattended.
17. All animals attending the show must be competently handled/ridden, any unruly animals, mare, gelding, filly, stallion or colt, will be asked to leave the showground as a matter of safety. All stallions and colts 2 years+ must be bitted. Age of handlers for stallions or colts, or riders of stallions as follows: Stallions/Colts not exc 13.2hh- minimum age of handler/rider 14yrs. Stallions/Colts 13.2hh and over – minimum age of handler/rider 16yrs. Lead rein handlers must be at least 17yrs of age and fully competent.
18. By entering any class you agree to abide by the Rules above.
