- 1. Young handler 16 years and under
- 2. ROR In Hand TB's only
- 3. Cob In Hand Hogged or traditional
- 4. BSPA / EQUIFEST IN HAND PIEBALD / SKEWBALD Open in Hand Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. the first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championships. Subject to their show rules & conditions Classes may be divided according to entries.
- 5. Handsome Gelding Open to any height
- 6. Prettiest Mare Open to any height
- 7. In Hand Hunter Exceeding 148cm

RING 2

- 8. Youngstock In Hand Foal to 3yrs, any type Horse & Pony passports will be checked to confirm ages.
- 9. Veteran In Hand 15 years + Horse & Pony passports will be checked to confirm ages.
- 10. SPILLERS / EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN HAND Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. This class may be divided as appropriate.
- 11. Best Condition Open to any height
- 12. Novice Horse/Pony Not to have won more than 3 INHAND 1st prizes in 2018
- **13. New Partners** Horse/Pony & Handler in their 1st INHAND season together **SPONSORED BY EH** EQUESTRIAN

- **14. Walk & Trot** Open to any novice horse or pony aged 4 years or over, any height or type. Walk and trot only. Exhibitors will be required to give a short individual show in walk and trot. This class is designed to give confidence to a novice horse or rider in a ridden showing class without cantering.
- 15. Ridden Novice Horse & Pony and Rider Combination must not have won 1st in any showing classes
- 16. BSPA / EQUIFEST RIDDEN PIEBALD / SKEWBALD-Open ridden Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championship. Subject to their show rules & conditions. Classes may be divided according to entries. SPONSORED BY EH EQUESTRIAN
- 17. Ridden ROR TB's only
- 18. Ridden Mare Open to any height/breed SPONSORED BY C K BECKETT
- **19. NUPAFEED / EQUIFEST RIDDEN COBS-** Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. Riders any age.

Classes MAY be divided as follows, dependant on entries:

Open Lightweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.

Open Heavyweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.

RING 2

- 20. Ridden Veteran Open to Horses and Ponies 15 years + Horse & Pony passports will be checked to confirm ages.
- 21. EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND- Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age. This class may be divided as appropriate.
- 22. BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES / EQUIFEST RIDDEN HUNTERS Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cms. Riders any age.

Classes MAY be divided as follows, dependant on entries:

- · Lightweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying up to 12.7 stone.
- Middleweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying 12.7 stone but not 14 stone.
- · Heavyweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over capable of carrying over 14 stone.
- 23. Ridden Gelding/Stallion will judge separate open to any height/breed
- 24. Riding Horse open to 14.3hh and above any riding horse type
- **25. EQUIFEST MAXI COBS -** Open Maxi Cobs, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 155cms to be judged as Cobs. Riders any age.

RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP

All 1st and 2nd Prizes winners from classes 14-25

This show is a qualifier for the 2020 TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR NAF Five Star Riders Finals - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification flyer in the ring. **TSR NAF Five Star In Hand Finals** - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand sheet will qualify in any In Hand class. Royal London Show

First, second and third placed horses/ponies in eligible classes not already qualified will qualify for the Champion of Britain Title classes to be held at the Royal London Show, 2020. Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring which will enable the owner to enter the Royal London Show, provided the owner and rider/handler are, or become registered with the International Showing Society within 21 days of the qualifying show. No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers or their property, helpers or horses in connection with or arising out of this show. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising therefrom.

Exhibitors must agree to comply with such provisions of the Health and Safety Act at Work Act 1974 and subordinate legislation as may apply to the show. All injuries must be reported to the secretary. All competitors enter entirely at their own risk. The organisers of this show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers, Officials and Stewards.

The organisers retain the right to refuse entry and to amend the details of the schedule if the instances of the programme requires, and to cancel any class with insufficient entries.

The decision of the judge will be final – any objection should be made to the Secretary, together with a deposit of £20 which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld by the Committee.

Prizes must be collected on the day of the show, otherwise they will be forfeited

Stallions are welcome BUT must have liability insurance also MUST be handled/ridden by a responsible adult at all times & correctly bitted.

Please keep all dogs on a lead and clean up after them

Children must be supervised at all times. Please keep young children away from the close proximity of horses.

All entries booked and not taken must be paid for - no refunds will be given unless the class is cancelled.

Hats to current minimum standard must be worn at all times when mounted on the showground and correct riding dress must be worn.

Cruelty and anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated, the organisers reserve the right to ask said persons to leave the premises.

Please place litter in bins provided and keep the lorry park as free from hay and droppings as possible.
