Rules of Entry

When entering a pony / horse it is a condition of entry that these rules are abided by.

1. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure they are present in the ring at the start of the class.
2. Refunds of class fees will not be given if exhibitors miss their class.
3. The Judge's decision is final.
4. The judge may withhold any prize where there is an evident want of merit.
5. Riders of stallions must be aged 12 years + for small breeds and 14 years + for large breeds.
6. Objections – Any objections to be made in writing to the Secretary with a deposit of £30.00 cash, which will be returned if the objection is upheld. All objections must be made within 30 minutes of the class taking place.
7. The NRC accept no responsibility for loss, injury or damage to any person or their property whilst on the site, car parks or approaches. All entries are subject to these conditions.
8. Exhibitors alone are solely responsible for the accuracy and eligibility of their entries. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied with the correct fee. In the event of an entry proving incorrect, (whether by mistake or otherwise), the entry fee will not be returned.
9. An Exhibitor may not exhibit a pony / horse bred, sold, leased or produced by the Judge, their immediate family or their employer.
10. The show reserves the right to expel from the class or Showground any animal not considered to be under control, especially where a danger to the public could be created.
11. The show reserves the right to cancel, amalgamate or divide any class should entries so warrant.
12. No substitute or nomination entries will be allowed.
13. In the event of the Show being cancelled by events beyond our control, a 50% administration fee will be deducted from each Exhibitor.
14. All persons entering the Showground must have personal third party insurance.
15. This Show operates under the NRC Child and Vulnerable Persons Protection Policy.
16. Show canes and whips must not be more than 30 inches long.
17. Ponies / horses must leave the ring at walk.
18. Correctly secured skull caps/riding hats must be worn at all times whilst mounted and to be to current BSI Standard.
19. Foals must accompany mares in the ring and be at least three weeks old on the day of the Show.
20. All Stallions and Colts must be licenced as stipulated by their relevant breed society and must be handled by a person over 14 years of age and be adequately bitted and under control.
21. No litter to be left on the Showground. **CLEANING OUT HORSEBOXES & TRAILERS IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN.**
22. All Exhibitors must be wearing the allocated number for the Exhibit when entering the ring;
23. Dogs must be on a lead and supervised at all times.
24. Handlers and Grooms must be appropriately dressed.
25. Anyone found to be mistreating a horse or pony may be asked to leave the show ground, and reported to the appropriate body.
26. All horses and ponies must have a valid passport which should accompany the animal on show days.
27. Handlers in In-Hand class's ages 14 years and under, must wear a correctly secured current British Standard skull cap or riding hat.
28. Rosettes to 6th place in all classes
29. All horses tied to a lorry or trailer **MUST** be supervised at all times. Any horses left unattended should be safely secured in the lorry.

A1 TRAVELLING SOUTH BOUND

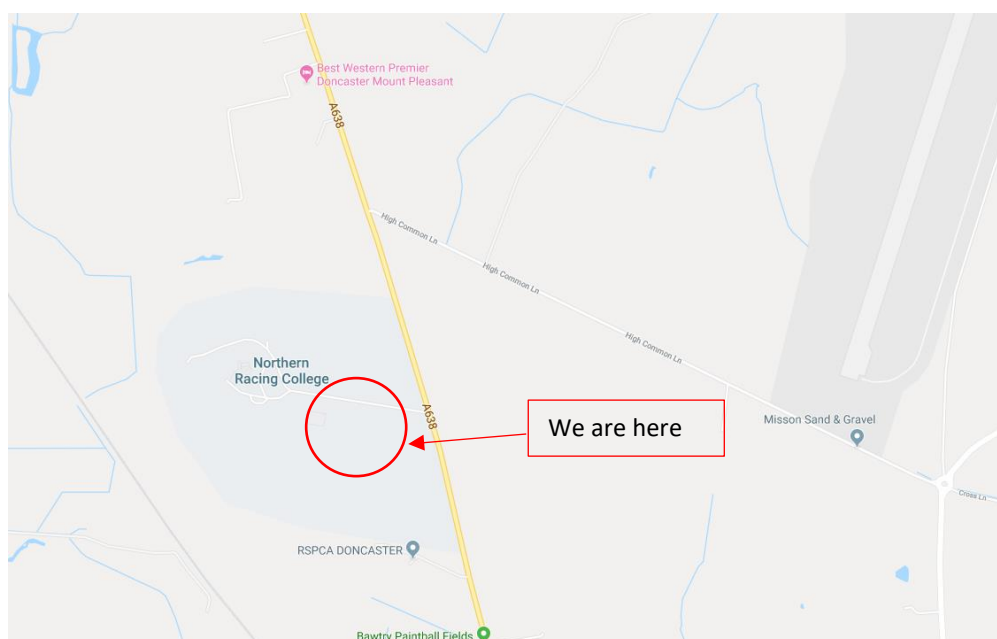
1. Leave A1 at junction 35, then join the M18 motorway signposted "The North". 2. Leave the M18 at junction 3, the A6182 exit to Doncaster 3. At the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the "Great Yorkshire Way" / A6182 4. At the roundabout take the 1st exit to stay on "Geat Yorkshire Way". 5. At the roundabout take the second exit to stay on the "Great Yorkshire Way". 6. At the next set of traffic lights take your right lane and keep straight following the A638/Great North Road 7. Continue passed the Mount Pleasant hotel on your right. 8. Continue passed the next left turning signposted Austerfield 9. The Northern Racing College is on the right hand side after this.

A1 TRAVELLING NORTH BOUND

1. Leave the A1 at junction 34. On the 1st roundabout take the 4th exit, then at the 2nd roundabout take the first exit onto the A614, signposted Bawtry. 2. At the roundabout take the first exit onto the A638 signposted Bawtry. 3. Entering Bawtry continue straight on, A638 (Great North Road) signposted Doncaster 4. Keep on the A638 and you will pass a caravan centre on your right, followed by a water tower on your left, and then the paintball fields and RSPCA Centre- also on your left. Approximately 50 yards further on you will see the NRC gallops on the left hand side 5. The entrance to the NRC is signposted about 100 yards further on your left.

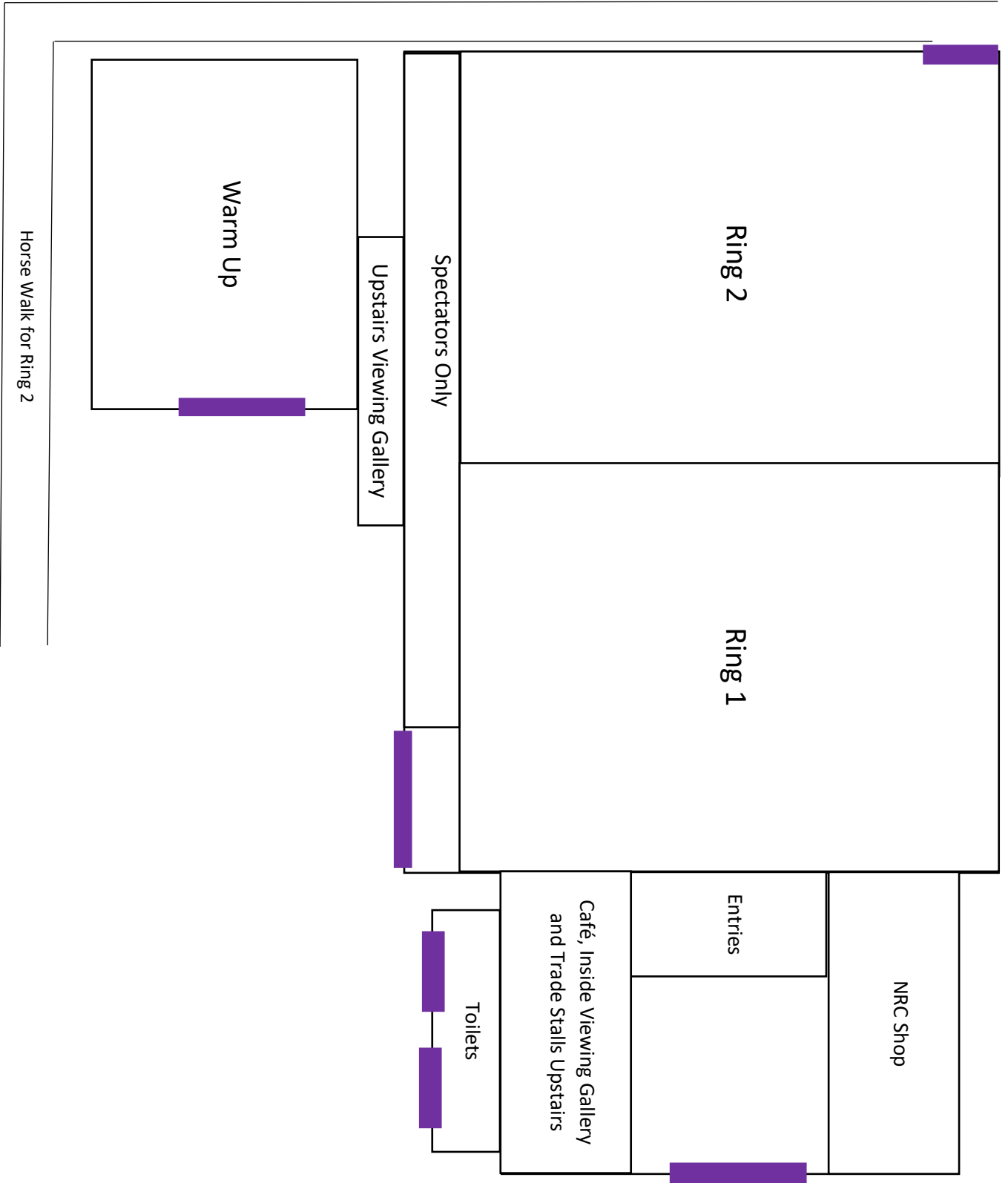
M1/M18

1. Leave M1 at junction 32, then join the M18 motorway signposted "The North". 2. Leave the M18 at junction 3, the A6182 exit to Doncaster 3. At the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the "Great Yorkshire Way" / A6182 4. At the roundabout take the 1st exit to stay on great Yorkshire way 5. At the parrots corner traffic lights keep in the middle lane going straight. 6. At the roundabout take the second exit to stay on the "Great Yorkshire Way". 7. At the next set of traffic lights take your right lane and keep straight following the A638/Great North Road 8. Continue passed the Mount Pleasant hotel on your right. 8. Continue passed the next left turning signposted Austerfield 9. The Northern Racing College is on the right hand side after this.

IN-HAND CLASSES

START 09:30 PROMPT

Ring 1 In-Hand

Judge:

Class 1 Open Youngstock *For any breed or type aged 3 years or younger. Any Foals must be aged 3 weeks or older and be accompanied by their dam. If entries are sufficient the class will be split by age*

Class 2 Mountain and Moorland *Open to all ponies of any age of M&M Type, ponies must be shown in their natural state. If entries are sufficient small and large breeds will be split*

Class 3 According to Type *Open to all correct horses / ponies of any age and height that are according to type e.g. Hunter, Cob, Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony, Hack. If entries are sufficient horses and ponies will be split*

Not Before 10am

Class 4 Coloured Horse or Pony *Open to Native, Traditional and Plaited coloured or alternative horses or ponies of any age and height*

Class 5 Foreign Breed/Pure Breed *Open to all Foreign/Pure Breeds of any age and height (excluding M&M breeds) e.g. Haflinger, Arab, Irish Draft, Thoroughbred*

Class 6 Part Bred *Open to Part Breds of any age, type and height*

Class 7 Veteran over 15 years *Open to all horses and ponies of any type that are aged 15 years old or over*

In Hand-Championship

Those placed 1st or 2nd in classes 1 – 7 will qualify for the In-Hand Championship which will take place in Ring 1 following class 7

Ring 2 Novice In-Hand

Judge:

Class 8 Best Turned Out *Open to any age and type. This class will be judged on the turnout of the Horse/Pony and handler*

Class 9 Best Conditioned *Open to any age and type. This class will be judged on the Condition of the horse or pony*

Class 10 Best Handler *Juniors and Seniors will all enter the ring together but will be placed separately. All Young Handlers (under 12) will receive a rosette.*

Not Before 10am

Class 11 New Combination *Open to any combination for whom this is their first season showing in hand together (class will be split by handler age if entries are sufficient)*

Class 12 Novice Horse or Pony *Open to any Combination who have not won more than three times this season (class will be split by handler age if entries are sufficient)*

Class 13 Bonny Pony/Bonny Horse *Open to all combinations, the winner to receive a Champion style rosette.*

Novice In-Hand Championship

Those placed 1st or 2nd in classes 8 – 13 will qualify for the In-Hand Championship which will take place in Ring 2 following class 14.

RIDDEN CLASSES

NOT BEFORE 13:00

All Horses and Ponies in ridden classes to be aged 4 years and over

Ring 1

Novice Ridden

Judge: Julie Coleman

Class 14 Lead Rein Best Mannered Pony *To be judged on the suitability of the pony as a Lead Rein pony. Pony to be less than 148cm*

Class 15 Walk and Trot *Rider not to have been placed 1st-3^d in Showing or Dressage. Juniors and Seniors will be placed separately. If sufficient numbers class may be split. Walk and trot only*

Class 16 Novice Best Ridden *Open to competitors that have not been placed 1st more than Twice in a Showing Class. Juniors and Seniors will be placed separately. If sufficient numbers class may be split.*

Class 17 Ridden Youngster *Open to horses aged 4-6yrs. This class will include a short group Canter*

Novice Ridden Championship

Those placed 1st or 2nd in classes 14 – 17 will qualify for the Novice Ridden Championship which will take place in Ring 1 following class 17.

Not Before 14:00

Class 18 Mountain and Moorland *Open to all ponies of M&M Type, ponies must be shown in their natural state*

Class 19 Open Pony *Open to all ponies, not exceeding 14.2hh of none M&M type, ponies must be shown hogged or plaited, depending on type*

Class 20 According to Type *Open to all horses / ponies any height that are according to type e.g. Hunter, Cob, Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony, Hack. If entries are sufficient horses and ponies will be split*

Class 21 Coloured Horse or Pony *Open to Native, Traditional and Plaited coloured and alternative coloured horses or ponies of any height including Lead Rein*

Class 22 Foreign Breed/Pure Breed *Open to all Foreign/Pure Breeds, any height (excluding M&M breeds). e.g. Haflinger, Arab, Irish Draft, Thoroughbred*

Class 23 Part Bred *Open to Part Breds of any type and height*

Class 24 Veteran over 15 years *Open to all horses and ponies of any type that are aged 15 years old or over*

Class 25 Junior / Senior Equitation *Judged on rider capability. Open to all horses and ponies. Juniors and Seniors will be placed separately. Class will be split if numbers are sufficient*

Class 26 Best Riding Club Horse *Open to all horses and ponies of any height and type. This class will include a small fence (if you aren't comfortable with the height, please make this known to the Judge or the Steward)*

Ridden Championship

Those placed 1st or 2nd in classes 18 – 26 will qualify for the Ridden Championship which will take place in Ring 1 following class 26.
