Ring 1 – Ridden Showing Classes (Approx. 9.00am start)

Class 1: Lead Rein – 133cm & under. Sunshine Tour, Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier. M&M and Show Pony Lead Rein ponies are eligible to qualify for Equifest.

Class 2: First Ridden – 133cm & Under. Sunshine Tour, Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier. M&M and Show Pony First Ridden ponies are eligible to qualify for Equifest.

Class 3: Novice Ridden Showing – any height, open to combinations who have had no more than 3 showing wins. Sunshine Tour, Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.

Class 4: Riding Club/Pony Club Horse or Pony. Judged on suitability for a variety of Riding Club and Pony Club activities. Sunshine Tour, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.

Class 5: Show Horse or Pony (Includes Hacks). Open to any Show Horse, Pony or Hack. Equifest, Sunshine Tour, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.

Class 6: Show Hunter. Open to any height Show Hunter type horse or pony. Includes Novice, Intermediate and Open sections (may be split if numbers permit). Equifest, Sunshine Tour, Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.

Class 7: Sports Horse or Pony. Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.

Class 8: Riding Horse or Pony. Equifest, Sunshine Tour, Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.

Class 9: Veteran Horse or Pony – 15 years or over. Sunshine Tour, Trailblazers, BHSA, TSR, Veteran Horse Society and VHPRC qualifier.

Class 10: Ridden Cob (Traditional or Non-Traditional). May be presented in Traditional, or Non-Traditional turnout. Equifest, Sunshine Tour, Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.

Class 11: Coloured Horse or Pony. May be presented in Traditional, or Non-Traditional turnout. Trailblazers, Sunshine Tour, BHSA and TSR Qualifier. Skewbald and Piebald horses and ponies are eligible for Equifest qualification.

Class 12: Spotted, Appaloosa, Palomino and Roan. Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.

Class 13: M & M (Large and Small Breeds). Large breeds: Highlands, Fells, Dales, New Forest, Connemara, Welsh Section C & D. Small breeds: Exmoors, Dartmoors, Shetlands, Welsh Section A & B. Class will be split if numbers permit. Equifest, Sunshine Tour, Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.

Class 14: Ridden Part-Bred: Open to any part-bred horse or pony. May be split into Part-Bred M&M and Part-Bred Foreign Breeds if numbers permit. BHSA and TSR Qualifier.

Class 15: Ridden Foreign Breeds: Open to any foreign breeds including Warmbloods and British-bred Foreign Breeds. BHSA and TSR Qualifier.

Class 16: Thoroughbred – Open to Wetherby's registered horses bred to race, whether they have raced or not. Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier. ROR registered horses will be eligible for ROR League Points.

Please note that classes may be combined for placings, however this will not affect qualification opportunities.

Best in Show Ridden (Champions and Reserve Champion) – For all horses / ponies who have won a ridden class 1-16.

In Hand Showing Classes (Approx. 9.00am start)

- **Class 17. 3 Years & Under Young Stock** Open to fillies, colts and geldings aged 3yrs & under. Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.
- **Class 18. Young Handler 12Yrs & Under** Open to any horse or pony with handler 12yrs or under. Sunshine Tour, Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.
- **Class 19. In-hand Show Horse or Pony (Includes Hacks)** Open to any Show Horse, Hack or Pony of any heigh . Sunshine Tour, Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.
- **Class 20. Best Conditioned Horse & Pony** -Open to any horse and pony of any height. Sunshine Tour, Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.
- **Class 21. Show Hunter Horse or Pony** Open to hunter type horses or ponies of any height. Sunshine Tour, Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.
- Class 22. Sports Horse or pony. Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.
- **Class 23. In-hand Riding Horse or Pony.** Sunshine Tour, BHSA and TSR Qualifier. Riding Ponies in hand are eligible for Equifest qualification.
- **Class 24. In-hand Cob** Open to cob horses and ponies. Sunshine Tour, Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.
- **Class 25. M&M (Small and Large Breeds)** Small Breeds: Exmoors, Shetlands, Dartmoors, Welsh Section A & B. Large Breeds: Connemara, Dales, Highland, Fells, New Forest, Welsh Section C & D. Part breeds not permitted. If numbers permit, the class will be split. Sunshine Tour, Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.
- Class 26: Part-Bred. Open to any Part-Bred horse and pony. If numbers permit, will be split into Part-Bred M&M and Part-Bred Foreign Breeds. BHSA and TSR Qualifier.
- Class 27. Veteran Horse & Pony 15yrs or Over Open to any horse and pony 15yrs or over. Sunshine Tour, Trailblazers, BHSA, TSR, Veteran Horse Society and VHRPC qualifier.
- **Class 28. Traditional and Non-Traditional Coloured** Traditional coloured horses and ponies must have feather and full mane and tail. Non-Traditional are to be plaited or hogged with no feather. If numbers permit, the class will be split. If not, the horse or pony will be judged to type. Sunshine Tour, Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier. Piebald and Skewbald horses and ponies are eligible for Equifest qualification.
- **Class 29. Spotted, Appaloosa, Palomino, Dun and Roan** Open to any spotted, appaloosa, palomino, dun & roan horses and ponies. Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.
- **Class 30. Best Foreign Breed** Open to any type of pure-bred foreign breed of horse and ponies, including Warmbloods and British-bred Foreign Breeds. Trailblazers, BHSA and TSR Qualifier.

Please note that classes may be combined for placings, however this will not affect qualification opportunities.

Best in Show (Champions and Reserve Champion) – For all horses / ponies who have won an in-hand class today class.

Working Hunter (Approx. 1pm Start)

All Classes are Sunshine Tour, TSR and Trailblazers Qualifiers

Class 31: Nursery Stakes – Ponies, 133cm & under, Rider age 12 & under. Max 50cm

Class 32: M & M Small – Exmoors, Shetlands, Dartmoors, Welsh A&B. Max 60cm

Class 33: Working Hunter 148cms & under Max 60cm

Class 34: Working Hunter Exceeding 148cms Max 70cm

Class 35: Working Cob Max 70cm

Class 36: M & M Large – Connemara, Dales, Highland, Fells, New Forest, Welsh C&D. Max. 75cm

Class 37: Working Hunter 148cms & under Max 75cm

Class 38: Working Hunter Exceeding 148cms Max 85cm

Best in Show Working Hunter (Champions and Reserve Champion) – For all horses / ponies who have won a class 31-38.

Trailblazers Championships 2020

Competitors placed 1st to 4th in any Trailblazers qualified class (as detailed above) will be eligible to receive a qualification invitation letter (ask for one at the Secretary's office). Once qualified, it is up to the competitor if they take up the invitation. If they wish to enter the Championships, the competitor must purchase a qualification card to enter the Championships. Once qualified, competitors are able to enter any Showing or Working Hunter class they are eligible for at the Championships.

The 2020 SEIB Trailblazers Championships are set to be held at Stoneleigh Park, Warwickshire. The Showing and Working Hunter Championships are to be held on 25-26th July 2020. More details can be found at http://www.trailblazerschampionships.com/.

The Showing Register (TSR) Showing Finals

This show is a qualifier for the 2020 TSR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website.

Equifest

This Show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the East of England Showground on the 19th – 23rd August 2020. The two highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

The Sunshine Tour

Competitors placed 1st to 4th in any of the advertised qualifying classes qualify for the 2020 Sunshine Tour Championships, held at The All England Jumping Course, Hickstead on 17th-20th September 2020. Each qualification allows you to enter two championship classes, as long as you are eligible for the other class. Please see www.sunshinetour.co.uk for more information.
