COMBINED TRAINING:

CLASS 1a – For Ponies 148cm and under: Prelim Dressage (Prelim 13 (2006) Rev. 2016) & 65cm Show Jumping. Trailblazers Qualifier.

CLASS 1b – For Horses over 148cm: Prelim Dressage (Prelim 13 (2006) Rev. 2016) with 65cm Show Jumping. Trailblazers Qualifier.

CLASS 2a – For Ponies 148cm and under: Novice Dressage (Novice 34 (2009) Rev 2016) with 75cm Show Jumping. Trailblazers Qualifier.

CLASS 2b – For Horses over 148cm: Novice Dressage (Novice 34 (2009) Rev 2016) with 75cm Show Jumping. Trailblazers Qualifier.

CLASS 3 – For Horses over 148cm: Elem Dressage (Elem 50 (2007) with 85cm Show Jumping. Trailblazers Qualifier.

* Please note that horses and ponies may be combined for placings if insufficient numbers. However, this will not affect qualification opportunities.

Class heights: the class height is the maximum height of fences in the first section; fences in the jump-off section may be increased by up to 5cm over the class height.

Please note we will be using a fastest time section over natural fences in the arena for the Eventers Challenge classes.

The Water is included in all classes, can be missed but will receive 10 penalty points.

Ditches - Please note there are no ditches in any classes.

ENTRY FEES:

Late entries may be accepted, if space, for the Combined Training or ODE classes at an additional cost of £5 per class.

CLOSING DATE: The Thursday before the competition. If classes are full before the closing date, then a waiting list will be held. Start Time: Class 1, will not start before 9.00am

TIMES: Start lists with times will be in the documents section of Equo Events, and Tumpy Green Equestrian Centre's Facebook page; by the evening of Friday before the competition.

PRIZEGIVING: Class presentations will take place immediately after each class. Rosettes: to sixth place in each class.

NUMBER BIBS: Number bib holders will be required to display the provided numbers. A small selection are available to hire at a cost of £5 hire plus £10 deposit per bib.

COMBINED TRAINING RULES:

Combined Training is a Dressage test and a Show Jumping round held separately, then the scores combined to decide placings.

Dressage: The dressage section of the competition will be run under Trailblazers Dressage Rules unless they are over-ridden by the Trailblazers Combined Training Rules.

Show Jumping: The show jumping section of the competition will be run under Trailblazers Show Jumping Rules unless they are over-ridden by the Trailblazers Combined Training Rules. The show jumping section will be run over one round (T1).

Overall Winner: The overall winner will be decided by deducting any show jumping penalties from the competitors' dressage score. In the event of equal marks, the time in the show jumping section will decide the higher placing.

Eligibility: Any age of rider will be allowed to ride any height of horse or pony as long as the partnership is compatible; however, should the Judge for the competition deem the partnership incompatible, the Judge has the right to exclude the Competitor from competing in the competition. The Judge's decision is final. In such an instance, the Show Organiser would not be liable for any refund of any fees to the excluded Competitor.

A rider may compete on more than one horse / pony in any competition. The same combination of horse / pony and rider must compete in both sections (dressage and show jumping) of the competition.

Competitor Dress Code/Tack and Equipment Rules for Combined Training Classes:

For the dressage section, the Trailblazers Dressage Rules will apply.

For the show jumping section, the Trailblazers Show Jumping Rules will apply.

EVENTERS CHALLENGE:

A 2 Phase competition which will take place in the show fields. The first section is over show jumps in the show jumping ring, you will then make your way to the cross country start box and then complete a course of natural fences in the hill field, this has a timed section. We will be using jump faults and a fastest time, in the timed section, to decide placings. Overall the winner and runners up will be those that achieve clear round in both phases with the fastest time over the cross-country fences.

ONE DAY EVENT RULES

ODE classes are run according to the Pony Club 2020 Eventing Rulebook.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING FOR DRESSAGE - BITS & WHIPS

Classes 1, 2,3, 4 & 5 - the Dressage test may be ridden in **any normal riding bit** (such as a snaffle, gag, or pelham type with a straight bar, single joint or french link), and **whips are allowed**.

Classes 6, 7 & 8 the Dressage test must be ridden in a snaffle type bit and no whips are allowed.

Blue Chip Festival of Equestrianism Championship:

Direct Qualification: Registered horse/rider combinations can gain direct qualification to the championships by obtaining a total of three 1st-3rd placed results in any one class to secure a place at the finals.

League Tables: Registered horse/rider combinations that are in the top 15% of the league table at the qualification process (21st June 2020) that have not gained a direct qualification to the championships will secure their space. The league tables are also placed individually at the end of the year – separate to the championship class.

The Sunshine Tour

The Sunshine Tour Championships held at The All England Jumping Course, Hickstead. The Championships are for unaffiliated and amateur competitors in Dressage from Intro to Elementary, Show Jumping from Lead Rein to 1.05m; Showing for lead rein, in-hand, ridden, working hunter, veterans, plus many more, Eventers Challenge from 60cm through to 1m. Qualification Today: 1st-6th in eventers challenges; or 1st-4th Show Jumping. Bring your Personal Qualification Form available from www.sunshinetour.co.uk or ask the Secretary for a 'Wild Card'.

Trailblazers Combined Training Direct Qualifier:

The 5 highest placed combinations, regardless of the number of starters in the qualifier, will qualify to compete at the Championship Finals.

Competitors that qualify may purchase a Qualification Card from the venue at which they have qualified. You can purchase qualification days on the day of the competition at the secretary's box. Or you can send a sae to Tumpy Green within 14 days of the competition. Each qualification card is £12. The competitors must then complete the Qualification Card and send it the Trailblazers Central Office to register their qualification. Once a competitor has qualified at a qualifying competition, purchased their Qualification Card and registered the Card, a Championship Final schedule will be sent to the competitor by the Trailblazers Central Office in early June in the Year of the Championship Final.

Trailblazers Direct Qualifier

1st-8th placed competitors in qualifying classes, regardless of faults accumulated, qualify for championships.

Qualification Letters can be picked up from the Secretaries box on the day of the competition. The Competitor will then have the choice to take up the qualification or not. Should the Competitor decide to accept the qualification for the second rounds, then they will return the congratulatory letter (within 14 days) together with £12 and ONE stamped addressed envelope, to the Venue of Qualification. The envelope will be used to return a Qualification Card. Alternatively you can purchase the direct qualification card on the day at the Secretaries box.

The Qualification Card can be used to compete in any Trailblazers Championship class at the level qualified.

DISCLAIMERS

1. 3. All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Tumpy Green Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover them.

RULES AND NOTICES

1. Substitutions allowed – please tell the Secretary (Entries before the day, Show on the day).

2. Pre-entries are essential as entries will be limited. If you miss the closing date please ring/ email the Entries Secretary for available spaces.

3. Closing date for entries – Thursday before the competition. Withdrawal refunds given on receipt of a relevant doctor/vet certificate received by the Entries Secretary within a week of the competition (please enclose an s.a.e.)

4. If the show is cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control, entry fees will be help in credit for a future event. Any refund will be subject to an administration fee.

5. TIMES WILL BE GIVEN – please see the documents section of Equo Events. Competitors may be asked to jump up to 15 minutes before their given time – please be ready.

6. Warm-up Arena – the number of competitors may be restricted; please obey the steward's instructions as to when you can use the warm-up.

7. Children must not jump in the warm-up arena without an accompanying adult.

8. Each horse/pony may only compete once in any given class. Stallions are allowed only with prior permission from the Entries Secretary and must wear stallion discs and ribbons. All horse/ponies must be at least 4 years old on day of competition.

9. Turnout for ALL riders and horses should be as in the Pony Club / Riding Club Rules for Show-jumping 2018. Please contact the Entries Secretary BEFORE the show day for any queries re dress/turnout.

10. Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found doing so will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.

11. Judges' decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Show Secretary in writing with a £20 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 15 minutes of the incident and BEFORE the prize-giving for that class.

12. INSURANCE; please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.

13. PHOTOGRAPHS: by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please tell the photographer on entering the arena, before you jump.

14. Participants attend at their own risk; neither the Committee nor Tumpy Green Competition Centre will be liable for any loss, damage or accident to horses, riders, property or other persons.

15. No horses/ponies should be left tied to the outside of trailers/lorries without supervision. Please clear any muck/rubbish and do not leave on the lorry park. Please be aware that there is no gate between the lorry park and the main road. All hay must be collected and removed from the lorry park.

16. The show will be run under The Pony Club Show jumping and Eventing Rules 2020.
