Points League

To qualify for end of season awards, you must compete in the **same class** a **minimum of THREE times** with the **same rider and horse/pony combination**.

 $1^{st} = 6pt$ $2^{nd} = 5pt$ $3^{rd} = 4pt$ $4^{th} = 3pt$ $5^{th} = 2pt$ $6^{th} = 1pt$ Elimination= 0 pt

Classes that are shown as a group, ie Ridden Showing, In-Hand etc - Competitors may be split into two groups to keep in line with the latest government guidance. This will be announced leading up to the show, and is subject to change.

If this happens, membership numbers will be chosen at random and placed into two groups. The first group 'A' will enter the ring, and the judge will choose their TOP TWO. All competitors will leave the ring, and this will be repeated for 'B'. The top two from 'A' and 'B' will then re-enter and go back in to the ring to be placed 1st- 4th in that class. All competitors after 4th will receive 1 point if places cant be determined due to class size.

- Unfortunately due to Covid restrictions, it is unlikely we can run our Presention Evening as normal, hence why we have reduced membership prices considerably.
- We will be looking at doing Awards for all classes from our 16th August show onwards.

2020 Club Show Rules

- All horses / ponies MUST of had an annual FLU vaccination within 12 months, or received both their 1st and 2nd Flu vaccine as a re-start. PASSPORTS WILL BE CHECKED.
- All horses/riders must have adequate third party liability insurance.
- All persons attending Springwood Riding Club do so at their own risk. The organisers / landowner cannot accept responsibility for any person, animal or property.
- **ZERO TOLERANCE TO ABUSIVE AND/OR THREATENING BEHAVIOUR** to judges, officials, spectators or their animals on the show ground. Anyone found doing so will be asked to leave the ground and may be banned.
- The judges' decision is FINAL in all respects.
- All competitors must have attained their third birthday.
- A maximum of 8 classes may be entered per horse/pony at any one show. Maximum of 4 jumping classes SJ OR W/H combined classes per horse/pony.
- Any horse/pony may have more than one rider providing they do not compete in the same class with the exception of Handy Pony and Dressage. The name of the horse/pony must stay the same for both riders.
- All ages as of 1st January 2020.
- Snaffle bridles include wilkies and hanging cheek bits.
- Correct riding attire, Current British standard/PAS approved hard hat and suitable footwear MUST be worn whilst mounted. No trainers whilst mounted. Over 18's can wear a beagle/bowler/top hat at your own risk, but we strongly advise against this.
- No horse/pony under 4 years of age are permitted in any ridden class.
- No stallions with the exception of yearling colts allowed at club shows. All colts to be suitably bitted.
- Competitors will be given a two minute call to present themselves to the ring, unless the judge is otherwise informed. It is the competitors responsibility to arrive at a class on time.
- The organisers cannot be held responsible for any classes which clash.
- Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- In line with the current DEFRA guidelines, all horses/ponies are to have a current passport available for inspection at any time.
- Where the height of a horse/pony is in dispute, a height certificate should be produced.
- Regardless of age, the rider must be a suitable height/weight for the horse/pony, including lead rein.
- ALL HORSES/PONIES KNOWN TO KICK MUST WEAR A RED RIBBON AT THE TOP OF THEIR TAIL
- Three consecutive strikes with the whip or excessive use of aids will result in disqualification.
- In the interest of safety: Competitors must warm up in the practice ring provided. Trotting, cantering or lungeing is NOT permitted in the walkways or car park. Any offenders will be asked to leave the showground.
- No spurs to be worn by competitors under 16 years of age. Spurs are not permitted in Handy Pony, Games or any Beginners Class.
- Dogs MUST be kept on leads at all times and all mess cleared up and disposed of in the bins provided.
- Members must compete in the same class THREE times to be awarded points for the Presentation Awards
- Competitors are encouraged to wear body protectors in classes and will not be deducted points in any class including showing classes.
- Lead Rein: Handlers to be aged 14 years and over. All lead reins must be attached to noseband. Rider not to have attained 10th birthday on 1st Jan in the current year. Pony must not exc 128cms for showing classes. Riders on lead rein can compete non-competitively off lead rein in the same section ie, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, but points will only be allocated for one class in that section (the competitive entry).
- Colt handlers must be aged 16 years or over.
- You must provide a specific breed passport if queried in relating to a breed specific class.
- Maximum length of whips must not exceed 30", except Dressage.
- Show Jumping Faults: Refusal = 4 faults. Knock Down = 4 faults. Third Refusal, Fall of Horse or Rider or Dismount = Elimination. Working Hunter: fall of horse or rider = Elimination.
- All earrings and body studs should be removed before competing.
- Bit less entries are welcomed in any class.
- Lame, unwell or unfit horses will be asked to retire from any class.
- Any complaints must be handed to the club in writing of the day of the event, with a deposit of £20.00 which will

be forfeited if the complaint is overruled following discussion at the next planned committee meeting. The committee's decision is FINAL.

Please only attend if you can follow all our Covid-19 Rules and Regulations:

- You must adhere by the Rules and Regulation set out by Springwood Riding Club, as found on our website and also available to view on the caravan on the day of shows.
- By entering our show ground, means you agree to our terms and conditions and also those set out by the government regarding Covid-19.
- All persons must keep the ring rope to their LEFT at all times, ensuring we have everyone walking on the same side.
- Horses to be tied on the LEFT of their horse box/trailer to ensure plenty of distance is left between vehicles and people.
- You must keep a <mark>2 metre distance</mark> with anyone not in your household at all times.
- Please follow the guidelines at the entrance to warm up areas for Max ring size numbers.
- Jumping warm up areas will be for the next few in line to jump, in order of your class time. No helpers allowed in warm up areas, committee members to alter jumps.
- Do not arrive before 30 minutes of your first class, and please leave promptly after your last class.
- Only one rider and one helper/groom per horse. One additional helper is allowed for children or the disabled. No additional Spectators allowed.
- Please refrain from bringing excess vehicles on to the show ground.
- No refunds will be given unless the Organiser has to cancel.
- Please DO NOT attend if you, or members of your household are showing any symptoms of Covid-19.
- Please return to your lorry/trailer in between classes, please do not wait around rings.
- Please bring your own hand sanitiser with you.
- Only park in marked bays as directed by a committee member of Springwood Riding Club.
- Pre-booked entries only via Horse monkey <u>http://www.horsemonkey.com/</u> no entries on the day.
- Class sizes will be limited, and on a first come first served basis.
- Show will be for members only, and all lead rein handlers MUST be a member.

Anyone found to be gathering in large groups or ignoring social distancing rules, including rules set out by Springwood Riding Club may be asked to leave the show ground immediately, without any refund.

1. **RIDDEN BEST TURNED OUT** Judged on appearance / turnout. No show piece *****STARS Best Turned Out Class 23.

2. **BEGINNERS SHOWING** WALK AND TROT ONLY. This class is strictly designed for genuine beginners only who are new to showing. If this class is entered, you cannot compete in classes 3-14. Snaffles only and no spurs

3. **RIDDEN COLOURED** To include spotted, dun, cremello, palomino, piebald and skewbald and roan ★ ★ STARS Ridden Plaited Coloured Class 33 + STARS Ridden Native, Cob, Traditional type Coloured Class 34

4. **RIDDEN PLAITED** To include: TB (Inc Ex Racehorses) Arab, Riding Pony/Horse, Show pony & Part-Bred ★★★ STARS Racehorse to Riding Horse Class 22 + STARS Show Pony plaited Not exc 148cm Class 29 + STARS Ridden Show Horse plaited Exc 148cm Class 30.

5. **RIDDEN HUNTER** Horse or pony $\star \star \star$ STARS Show Hunter Pony plaited Not exc 153cm Class 31 + STARS Ridden Hunter Horse plaited Exc 153cm Class 32.

6. **RIDDEN COB TYPE** Inclusive of those not eligible for M & M. Can be shown traditional, hogged and trimmed or Native \bigstar STARS Ridden Cob rider any age Class 28.

7. LEAD REIN Rider 3 - 9 years, pony not to exc. 128cm, snaffle bridles only. Lead rein attached to nose band \star STARS L/R Plaited 4 - 9 years Class 24 + M&M L/R 4 - 9 years Class 26.

8. FIRST RIDDEN Rider 11 years and under, pony not to exc. 137cm, snaffle bridles only. L/R may enter non-competitively off L/R. Canter optional \star STARS Plaited First Ridden Not exc 128cm Class 25 + M&M First Ridden Not exc 128cm Class 27.

Group classes where competitors may be asked to individually ride their horse/pony incorporating movements at the judge's discretion. Judged on ability and style of riding. **SNAFFLE BRIDLES ONLY.**

Membership numbers will be chosen at random and placed into two groups. The TOP TWO from both groups, will go back in to the ring to be placed 1st- 4th in that class.

Handler judged on ability, style and control. Horse/pony to be suitable size for handler.

SHOW JUMPING (TWO PHASE)

Class times to be announced via Horse Monkey on the Friday prior to show.

First round and Jump-off combined. Riders jump 'round one' and then go straight into the timed jump-off section against the clock without interruption or halting in between rounds.

Competitors (exc 10 year and under)entering classes up to Class 26 (55cm) may not enter classes 28-30 (75cm, 85/95cm and 1m)
