BE level dressage judges and cross country timing by a BE experienced timing team, plus live

NB Entries taken on first come first served basis and in previous years have closed prior to the official closing date - booking early recommended.

80, 90 & 100 cm classes To be run over full length BE course minor variations

80 cm Open CLASS 1

All Horses/Ponies to be 4 years & over.

Open to horses/ponies that have not competed above BE80 (Intro)

Dressage: BE90 TEST 95 (2012)

Show Jumping: max 85cm/2'9", max 2 at full height rest max 80cm: but not timed

Cross Country: max 80 cm/2'6". Optimum speed - 435m/m

CLASS 2 90 cm Open

All Horses/Ponies to be 5 years & over.

Open to horses/ponies that have no British Eventing grading points (foundation points permitted)

Dressage: BE90 TEST 95 (2012)

Show Jumping: max 95cm/3'1" (max 2 upright/rising spread at full height rest max 90cm): but not timed

Cross Country: max 90cm/ 2'11". Optimum speed - 450m/m

CLASS 3

All Horses/Ponies to be 5 years & over.

Dressage: BE100 TEST 102 (2010)

Show Jumping: max 105cm/3'5" (max 2 upright/rising spread at full height rest max 100cm): but not timed

Cross Country: max 100cm/ 3'2". Optimum speed - 475m/m

HC entries will be accepted

The competition will be run under current British Eventing Rules (including XC time penalties) except SJ will not be timed.
