TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals - This show is a qualifier for the 2020 TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR NAF Five Star Riders Finals - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification flyer in the ring.

TSR NAF Five Star In Hand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand sheet will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their

CHAPS Classes

his show is affiliated to the Coloured horse & pony Society (uk) Affiliation Number 20090 Both Owners and the riders / exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (uk) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (uk) to compete: However in order to qualify both owner and rider / exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid Qualification card IN THE RING for signing by the judge. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (uk) for appropriate qualification card. The CHAPS (uk) championship show will be held on 12th – 15th August 2020, shows to be held on or after 9th August 2020 of championship show counts as 2021 qualifiers. The following classes are CHAPS (uk) qualifiers for full ruling and information on competition/ qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) members hand book or visit www.chapsuk.com for rulings. Only "Coloured" horses and ponies (as defined in the current CHAPS UK members hand book) may compete these classes. All stallions, 4 years old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (uk) . All stallions must wear stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception.

Classes do not include spotted, roans and palominos.

Class 10:- CHAPS (UK) Open Youngstock Qualifier, 1, 2 or 3 year olds. No foals.

Class 11:- CHAPS (UK) Open In-Hand Riding Club Qualifier, any type.

Class 12:- CHAPS (UK) Open In-Hand Qualifier, any type.

Class 13:- CHAPS (UK) Novice Ridden Pony Qualifier, any type.

Class 14:- CHAPS (UK) Novice Ridden Horse Qualifier, any type.

Class 15:- CHAPS (UK) Open Ridden Riding Club Qualifier Finals, any type,

Riding Club Qualifiers

Open to all riding club members . Competitors must be paid-up riding club members at the time of competitionfor qualification to be valid. Competitors do not need to be a member of CHAPS (UK), nor the horse /pony registered with CHAPS (UK) at the time of qualification; however; in order to compete in the relevant final at the CHAPS Championships show ,both CHAPS UK membersip and registration MUST be in place prior tp making your entry for the final at the relevant years championship show. The final is only open to "coloured" horses and ponies (as defined in the current CHAPS UK members hand book); Qualification cards will be handed out in the ring by the judge. Any competing Stallion MUST be graded with CHAPS UK in order to take part in the qualifier and the final.
