Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from **31<sup>st</sup> July – 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2020. The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.**

**Qualification cards** for the NPS/Black Country Saddles M&M Ridden, NPS/Supreme Products Young Rider and NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Finals have been amalgamated into a single card that riders will now carry in their pockets and ask the judge to sign as appropriate.

### Stallions

All In Hand Stallions are advised to wear a bridle disc when showing in NPS classes. As with ridden stallions, for which it remains compulsory, these may be from any UK society as long as they are easily identified or an NPS Stallion Disc may be purchased from the NPS Office. **Age of handler for Stallions or Colts** must have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> Birthday. **Riders riding Stallions** must have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> Birthday if riding a small breed (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh Section A & B); if riding a large breed (Connemara, New Forest, Highland, Fell, Dales, Welsh Section C or D) stallion riders must have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> Birthday. **Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members, but only ponies owned by adult Qualifying or Life NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition.** The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class to go forward to the final. If the first placed pony has qualified, the second placed pony owned by an NPS member will qualify, qualification can go no lower than third place (unless specified). Owner's membership cards must be shown in the ring.

### NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships:

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life** member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

### NPS/KILMANNAN STUD M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship

Membership cards must be presented in the ring to receive the medal and/or the qualification.

**NPS/STANDINGHAT STUD & SHOW TEAM M&M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship**

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an **NPS Qualifying or Life** member in the M&M Ridden section (excluding Leading Rein, First Ridden & WHP). Membership cards must be presented in the ring to receive the medal and/or the qualification.

**NPS/SARACENS HORSE FEEDS Show Pony In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship**

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an **NPS Qualifying or Life** member in the Show Pony In Hand section. Membership cards must be presented in the ring to receive the medal and/or the qualification.

**NPS/DOWHILLS STUD Show Hunter Pony In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship**

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an **NPS Qualifying or Life** member in the Show Hunter Pony In Hand section. Membership cards must be presented in the ring to receive the medal and/or the qualification.

**NPS/ROSETTES DIRECT Home Produced Ridden Championship**

Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

**PONIES ASSOCIATION (UK)**

**Classes 52 to 61**

- Classes 52 to 61 are to be judged according to the rules and regulations of Ponies Association (UK).
- Owners must be Adult/Life Members; Riders must be current Ponies UK Annual Members.
- Ponies must be currently registered with Ponies (UK) before time of entry in order to compete in these classes. Open to Mountain & Moorland Ridden Stallions (Intermediate classes only), Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books or Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells, Highlands, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C or D.
- The highest placed exhibit not already qualified within the first five will qualify for the Ponies (UK) RIHS Young Riders or Amateur classes at the Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead in July 2020.

**Ponies (UK) Amateur Rule**

(A) **Amateur Status** – a person is an Amateur for the purpose of classes run under Association Rules if he/she does not, during the current or previous season

- (i) Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity.
- (ii) Receive remuneration for employment in the connection with horses in racing, showing, livery stable or Riding school (instruction at Pony Club and Riding Club excepted). This does not include the suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets.
- (iii) Own/Part own an equestrian establishment including but not limited to riding schools, events centre, stud or livery yard in any capacity, or receive any form of remuneration for employment at an equestrian establishment. For the avoidance of doubt for the purpose of this rule, immediate family members of an owner or part owner of an equestrian establishment who work or are howsoever otherwise engaged or involved in any capacity, whether or not for remuneration at the equestrian establishment, will be treated as being an owner or part owner of that equestrian establishment.
- (iv) Show a Horse owned or sponsored by a company or a commercial firm, or act as a Brand Ambassador or Supported Person, in any showing classes, Ponies (UK) or otherwise, or a Horse for which his/her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate family concerned.

(B) **Amateur Owner/Rider**. Open to Horses owned and ridden by an Amateur, (the Rider need not be the Owner of the Horse). This ruling will also apply to Amateurs who wish to compete in the Annual Amateur Points Awards. No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.

(C) **Amateur Home Produced**. Open to Horses, which are either stabled at home or in a D. I. Y. yard and which since 1st January in the current year, have not been shown by a Professional during the current season or stabled in a Professional yard at any time in the current year. To be ridden by an Amateur. This does not exclude Amateur Owner Home Produced riders having lessons at any time with an instructor, providing the Horse remains stabled at home. No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse
