Class 2: Best Condition

Open to all horses and ponies, plaited or unplaited

Class 3: YOUNGSTOCK

Open to 1, 2 & 3 year olds. Any breed.

Class 4: Novice Handler

For those starting out in showing.

Class 5: Cobs

Traditional, Hogged or Plaited

Class 6: Coloureds Inhand

Skewbald and piebald horses and ponies. Odd coloureds- Palominos, duns, appaloosa, roans, spots, paints and creams.

Class 7: Mountain and Moorland

- a) Small (Small Breeds—Welsh A&B, Shetland, Exmoor, Dartmoor)
- b) Large (Welsh C&D, Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara, New Forest)
