Each TREC session will have a maximum of 4 riders and will offer one hour of training to complete ten obstacles found in TREC competitions. At the end of the session, each rider will ride the course and be judged.

For the dressage training each rider will have an allocated time to ride a dressage test of their choosing from (Intro through to Novice). They will then be given advice and pointers by our guest trainer Mr. Mal Phillip's assisted with a writer, at the end of the session, each rider will ride the test under test conditions and will be judged again, roughly 25mins per person.

These dressage points plus the TREC points will be added together to find our overall winners for the day, 1st to 6th places plus prizes.

Rosettes will also be awarded 1st-6th place plus prizes, for the individual winners of the TREC and the dressage tests.

Equine Flu Requirements: TREC GB Equine Flu 2019. <u>These are mandatory</u>, <u>Please check the website</u> for up to date information.

Unfortunately, as widely publicized, there have been outbreaks of equine flu over the past few months, and as per the website, TREC GB has issued a protocol to be followed for any competitions/ training/events run under the TREC GB banner. Please be aware as a competitor that these are minimum requirements, and the actual event venue may have tighter rules (i.e. vaccinations at 6 monthly intervals).Please Check the venue's own Flu regulations.

The Board of TREC GB would like to promote, as best practice, the following:

Copies of passports with vaccinations (including the correct information PRIOR to 2014, i.e. the first 2 injections within the correct time, and all subsequent ones done on or within the 365-day timescale every year from 2014 to the present, OR a new course started from 2014, again with every booster on or within 365 days). This should be sent to the organizer/secretary as soon as possible, so checks can be made, and if necessary, a new course can be started. No horse/pony can attend a TREC GB event unless the 2 primary vaccinations have been done and this requires a minimum of 28 days to complete. All vaccinations should be given at least 6 days before the competition.

Please send a copy of your horse's vaccination certificate to the entries secretary along with your entry before the closing date. Copies can be sent by email or post to the event secretary. Bring the documents with you and present them to the organizers before unloading your horse. Checks will be carried out at the venue.
