The competition will include a variety of show jumps which will be run as a single round competition with two phases. The first phase will be the show jumps and the second phase the cross country jumps which will be timed. The winner will be the person with the lowest overall score. Cross country attire must be worn including skull caps and body protectors.

Rosettes 1st - 6th in each class.

Prize money 1st £50, 2nd £30, 3rd £20, 4th - 6th £15 NVEC voucher (to be used towards arena hire/clear round etc)

Points awarded at each event as per the following: 1st - 10, 2nd - 9, 3rd - 8, 4th - 7, 5th - 6, 6th - 5, 7th - 4, 8th - 3, 9th - 2, 10th - 1

The combination with the highest number of points at the end of the series will be the overall winner of the class and win a training bursary worth £100.

Arena Eventing Rules

The competition will be one continuous round consisting of a mixture of Show jumps Cross-country fences. The time allowed is based on 325mpm.

On arrival please got to the secretary to collect your number, please take your hat and body protector for checking. A £5 start fee is payable on declaration.

The Individual with the lowest total score will win.

Rosettes will be awarded 1st – 6th in each class.
Points will be awarded throughout the series as follows;

1st – 10 points
2nd – 9 points
3rd – 8 points
4th – 7 points
5th – 6 points
6th – 5 points
7th - 4 points
8th - 3 points
9th - 2 points
10th - 1 point

The combination with the highest number of points at the end of the series will be the overall winner of the class and win a Training Bursary worth £100.

In the event of a tie;

- Clear rounds take precedence over jumping faults. I.e a rider with 4 time faults would be placed above a rider with 4 jumping faults.
- Nearest to optimum time

General Rules All Classes

Your horse must have up to date Influenza vaccinations in line with BRC Rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook.

Horses/ Ponies must be 4 years or older and cannot be entered in more than two classes on same day.

Hat Standards

All hats must comply to the current safety standards, PAS015 or SEI ASTM F1163 04a Onwards and SNELL E2001. Hats with a fixed peak are not permitted.

Body Protectors

A body protector is obligatory for this competition. A BETA level 3 (Purple label) which has been manufactured in the year 2009 or Blue label 2018 must be worn. If a rider chooses to wear an airbag style body protector it must be worn over a permitted body protector and if activated must be deflated or removed before continuing. Hybrid air jackets are permitted. Riders wearing Exo Body cage (2000) protectors must inform the secretary at all events.

The use of head cams is strictly prohibited. This includes use on the head, chest, bridle or any other part of the horse or rider.

NO STOP WATCHES ALLOWED. The competitors are not allowed to take mobile phones onto the course while competing.

Paper numbers will be used, so each rider will require a bib to display the number.

Tack and Dress Rules

Cross-Country attire to be worn.

Please make sure you adhere to tack and dress rules found in the current version of the BRC rules. The full 2019 version is available to download online.

Objections

Objections must be made in writing to the secretary within half an hour of the incident together with a £50 deposit. The deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained. After this the score cannot be changed.
