

## Condition of Entry

This event will be run under the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2020, which can be viewed or downloaded, complete with dressage tests

A valid passport including up to date flu vac record must be carried. This MUST be shown when collecting number. Please use the name of the horse on the passport on your entry

Horses/Ponies shall be at least 5 years old. No Horse/Pony may compete more than once.

All hats must be tagged to comply with the Pony Club Hat Rule 2020, with an Aquamarine hat tag – this can be BE, Riding Club or Pony Club.

Please bring your hat with you when collecting your number if you need it tagging.

Body Protectors BETA Level 3 2009 or 2018, must be worn for the cross country phase, and as a minimum shoulders must be covered when competing.

**Medical Arm-bands:** It is the competitor's responsibility to wear a PC/BE medical armband during the cross-country phase if they have a medical condition that may impact on their care in the case of an emergency.

**Stop watches are allowed to be worn at PC90, PC100 and PC110**

If the total penalty score for the three phases gives equality of marks for 2 or more competitors, the classification is decided in line with the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2020.

The organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel classes

Polite queries on scoring should be raised with the Secretary only on the day, Any protest should be lodged with a deposit of £10.00, refundable if the objection is upheld. The judge's decision is final.

**Competitors ELIMINATED for 3 refusals or INCURRING MORE THAN 24 JUMPING PENALTIES in the SJ phase WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO START THE CROSS COUNTRY as a safety measure.**

No-one other than the competitor may ride the horse/pony at the event.

**Horses/ponies that have trained over the course within two weeks of this event are not eligible to compete.**

**DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AND UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES**

Show jumping: Height max 85cm, 300mpm  
Cross Country: Height max 80cm, 435mpm

### Class 2: PC90

*Combination must not have been placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in any ODE at PC100/BE100 or above*  
Section A: Pony Club Members Section B: Non-Pony Club

Dressage: PC90 Eventing Test 2013  
Show jumping: Height max 95cm, 325mpm  
Cross Country: Height max 90cm, 450mpm

### Class 3: PC100

*Combination must not have been placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in any ODE at PC110/BE Novice or above*  
Section A: Pony Club Members Section B: Non-Pony Club

Dressage: PC100 Eventing Test 2015  
Show Jumps: Height max 1.05m, speed 325mpm  
Cross Country: Height max 1m, speed 475mpm

### Class 4: PC110

*This class will be divided into sections if there are sufficient entries*

Dressage: PC110 Eventing Test 2010  
Show Jumps: Height max 1.15m, speed 325mpm  
Cross Country: Height max 1.10 m, speed 520mpm
