Body Protectors BETA Level 3 2009 or 2018, must be worn for the cross country phase, and as a minimum shoulders must be covered when competing. Air jackets if worn for XC, must be over a body protector.

Age of the rider is taken on the 1st January 2020

Horses/ponies must be at least 5 years old. No horse/pony may compete more than once. No-one other than the competitor may ride the pony at the event.

Horses/Ponies must not be left unattended outside at any time.

Organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel classes.
