Class Information

Classes 1, 3, 5, 7 & 9 - Will run similar to **Show Cross** with the working hunter jumping following directly on from the show jumping. You will receive a **start time** for your show jumping phase only, as working hunter jumping follows on.

Classes 2, 4, 6, 8 & 10 - Will run similar to a **Mini One Day Event** starting with dressage followed by the show jumping approx. 30 mins. after completing your dressage test. Then the working hunter jumping will follow directly on from the show jumping similar to show cross. You will receive **start times** for both your dressage and show jumping/working hunter phases.

Times – All competitors will have their own start times for all phases of all classes so please make sure you remember to get your times before the day

Times will be on our website and Facebook page from Friday 24th April

Other Information

- A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to all events and be available for inspection. Horse must be vaccinated in accordance with BRC rules:

- None of the working hunter jumps will be fixed
- The ditch will be included but there will be an option to avoid this, you will however incur **5 penalties** if you chose the alternative option
- Penalties will be the same for both the show jumping and the working hunter jumping phases: 5 for a knockdown, 5 for 1st refusal, 10 for 2nd refusal and elimination for 3rd refusal. Fall of horse, rider or both will result in elimination and you must leave the ring dismounted
- The show jumping will be timed but there wont be time faults just a course time limit (announced on the day) and you will be eliminated if you exceed this
- The working hunter jumping will be timed and in the event of an overall tie on penalties then the rider nearest the optimum time will win
- Stopwatches can **not** be worn by competitors and the optimum time for each class wont be revealed until each class has finished
- If you are eliminated for 3 refusals you may have chance to jump a few more fences but as all the riders have a set time to start their show jumping phase you may not get to complete the full courses
- The courses can be walked from 8 a.m. on the Sunday morning or at anytime it is safe to do so on the day – **please ask the stewards permission before walking into any of the rings.** The courses wont change for any of the classes, the jumps will just increase in height. There will be an opportunity to walk the course after the jumps have been raised for the later classes
- Horses and ponies must be 4 years or over
- Back protectors are **recommended** but are not compulsory
- Show Jackets or cross country attire can be worn for the jumping phases but show jackets must be worn for the dressage
- Hats must be worn to at least this standard with harnesses properly adjusted and fastened:
British - PAS015: 1998 or 2011 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked, VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked. European - VG 01.040 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked, American - ASTM F1163: 2004a or 04a onwards provided they are SEI marked, SNELL E2001 or Snell E2016
Australian & New Zealand - AS/NZS 3838: 2006 onwards provided they are SAI global marked.
Skull cap hats must be worn with a silk
- Please ensure you have adequate insurance cover for your horse/pony
