Due to Covid-19 we ask that everyone pre-books and pays by Saturday 18th July.

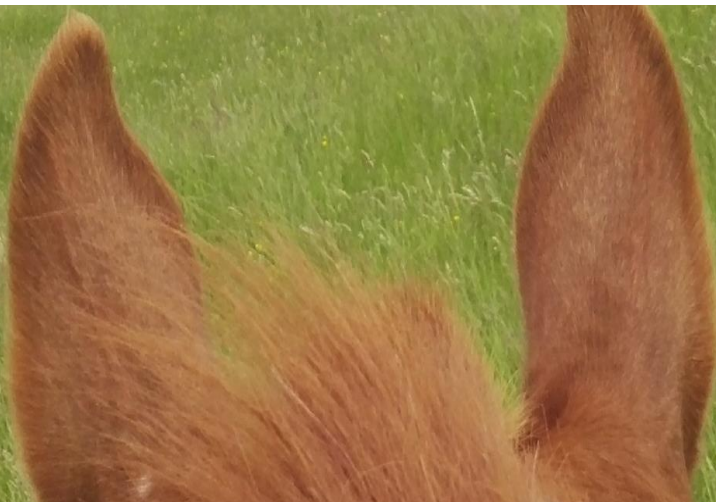

at Great Ridge, Chicklade SP3 5ST

All Covid-19 precautions will be observed during the event.
No groups of more than 6 riders.

Start between 09.00 and 12.00

Starting north of Seymour Farm, Chicklade there will be two
routes of approximately 6 miles and 12 miles.

The ride will take place over a mixture of private land and
public rights of way, enjoying panoramic views.

Entries: Adults £20 - Under 16 years old £15

Due to Covid-19 unfortunately we are unable to accept any entries on
the day: **all registration and payment must be made online**,
therefore no cash or cheques accepted.

Entries close at 6pm on Saturday 18th July 2020

Please report to the secretary on arrival where you will be allocated
an approximate start time and your number. Riders will be started at
regular intervals to ensure an even flow of riders on the routes
throughout the day.

Cancellation: should it be necessary to cancel the event at short
notice you will be notified by email. Please see conditions below.

First aid: there will be no paramedic at the event, but first aiders will be present.

Everyone who completes the course will receive a **rosette** – kindly sponsored by Bellevue Veterinary Clinic, Trudoxhill, Frome <https://www.bellevue-vets.co.uk/>

A **photographer** will be on the course, photos can be purchased after the event.

Directions: the entrance to the ride is directly off the A303 in Chicklade, near Fonthill Bishop. The postcode (to Seymour Farm on the entrance track) is SP3 5ST.

From the East (from Wylke): you approach Chicklade down a long hill on a dual carriageway that becomes single track road in the valley bottom, once into Chicklade look out for “SWW RIDE” signs signalling the approach and you turn right-handed up the track to Seymour Farm, opposite the turn off the A303 to Hindon.

From the West (from Mere): you approach Chicklade down a short, steep hill. Look out for the “SWW RIDE” signs signalling the left-hand turn to Seymour Farm, opposite the turn off the A303 to Hindon.

RULES AND CONDITIONS:

1. Hard hats conforming to current safety standards must be worn by **all** riders when mounted.
2. The minimum age for horses and ponies is 4 years.
3. Riders must not deviate from the marked course and every effort should be made to respect slower or faster riders to avoid upsetting horses.
4. Although your dogs are welcome, they **must** be on a lead at **all** times whilst in the lorry park and no dogs are to be taken on the ride by horse riders.
5. All riders must report to the Secretary and no rider may start until money has been received.
6. Instructions from course stewards **must** be obeyed.
7. Riders are required to have public liability insurance.
8. The S&WW Hunt, organisers and landowners involved in this ride accept no liability for any loss, injury or damage to any equine, person or their property and equipment, however caused.
9. All cars, lorries and horseboxes are parked at the owner's risk. No responsibility is accepted for damage or loss from the above parked on the ground.
10. In the Event of Cancellation or Postponement, riders must contact the Secretary to claim any refund within 14 days of the original event date (19th July 2020).
11. No refunds (less £2 admin fee) will be given without receipt of Doctors or Vet Certificate.
12. All those entering this event will be deemed to have accepted the above conditions.
