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THE COURSE

The fences are approx 2'6" high, with 20 more challenging options at about 3'6". They are all well constructed and include rails, hedges, water, ditches, banks, impressive tree trunks and several combinations. All fences are optional and there is a short cut if you/your horse get tired.

The 12 mile course is in an area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, passing over grass, woodland, arable and tracks. It is mostly on private land with some exceptional views.

There is extensive field parking and if the weather is wet, we have tractors and drivers to help you move your vehicle. **Please park as directed. We will aim to park with 10m spacing.**

There is a photographer and caterer on site.

SCORING AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded as follows:

A **GOLD** rosette to all riders completing the distance of the SOSR, and jumping all the fences, with the Bonus options where available.

A **SILVER** rosette to all riders completing the distance of the SOSR, and jumping more than 20 fences, but not all.

A **BRONZE** rosette to all riders that complete the distance of the SOSR, and jump fewer than 20 fences.

Trophies will be awarded to the Junior and Senior riders raising the most sponsorship money.

ENTRY

Please read and complete the entry form at the back of the schedule.

The entry fee is £20 per rider, if the event has to be cancelled due to COVID, we will refund entry less admin charge.

It is a condition of entry that all riders abide by the rules and instructions contained within this schedule (see pages 5 & 6).

All individuals who continue to be advised by Public Health England to remain in lockdown at home are not to attend the Sponsored Ride. This includes all individuals who have symptoms of COVID-19 as well as those who live in a household with someone who has symptoms. No person should attend either as a rider or helper on foot, unless they have been symptom-free for the last 7 days, nor been in contact with a members of the their household who has those symptoms for the past 14 days (except in a professional capacity as a doctor, nurse or allied health professional). Please adhere to social distancing rules at all times.

The payment of the entry fee will be considered as acceptance of these terms. Postal entries close Friday 2nd September 2019 or earlier if the ride is full.

You can also enter on-line and pay by Pay Pal or credit/debit card at www.sosr.org.uk, closing Thursday 1st October 2020 or earlier if the ride is full.

SPONSORSHIP

The sponsorship form is on page 4 of the schedule. Each rider must either sponsor themselves or find sponsors to a minimum of £20. Trophies will be awarded to the Junior and Senior riders raising the most sponsorship money.

WHAT TO DO ON THE DAY

Please pay all sponsorship money (minimum £20 per rider) at the Secretary's tent, where you will be given a number. (Social distancing rules will apply).

No rider will be allowed on course without a number and medical card.

Stewards will be available at four checkpoints around the course. On completion please returned to the Secretary's tent where you will be awarded your rosette (see information on page 2).

DISCLAIMER

Horse riding over man made and other obstacles is an inherently dangerous activity and each rider must take all reasonable care and precautions to ensure that they, other riders, spectators, members of the public, horses or property are not injured or damaged.

The Committee confirm that the course and fences have been inspected.

Prior to making the course and fences available, the committee have exercised reasonable care in satisfying themselves that the fences are safe and secure. Except in respect of death or personal injury caused by the Committee's or the Land Owner's negligence no responsibility is accepted by the Committee for any damage to persons, horses or property howsoever caused which should arise from:

- a) Defects in the course or fences not notified to the Committee by the rider before participating.
- b) Defects in the course or fences which manifest themselves after the course or fences are made available for inspection.

During the course of an event it is possible that the fences or course may become less safe and secure. All riders shall be under a continuing duty to notify to the Committee any damage which they cause to, or notice in, any fence or the course during the event.

Any defects are to be reported to the Committee as it not possible for the Committee to inspect each fence and the course after every rider has completed the course or any part of it.

The Committee shall be under no liability in respect of any damage caused to any person, horse or property howsoever caused including any defect in the course or fences arising from fair wear and tear, wilful damage, negligence of any rider or others, or abnormal weather conditions, failure to follow the Committee's or any official's instructions (whether verbal or written) or the rulers.
