### **National Pony Society Dressage Championships**

Qualifying rounds are open to competitors from the UK and elsewhere. All qualifiers will receive a qualification card, The Final will run in accordance with the 2019/2020 NPS Dressage Rules which will be available to all NPS Members.

The two highest placed ponies in each section at each qualifying show will qualify for the 2020 Final and also be eligible to be chosen to represent their Breed, NPS Area or other team in the Team Challenge which will be incorporated into the 2021 Championship Final.

Horse/ponies must be ridden at the Final by the qualifying rider. You must be fully paid up Dressage, Qualifying or Life members of the NPS for 2021 to compete at the Final.

The 6 sections are listed below. The horse/rider combination can only compete in one section at the final.

- 1 Registered Mountain & Moorland breeds not exceeding 138cm
- 2 Registered Mountain & Moorland breeds exceeding 138cm
- 3 Registered British Riding Ponies
- 4 Part Bred Horses/Ponies registered with their appropriate Native Breed Part Bred Stud Book including

Part Bred Arab ponies over stamped in the British Riding Pony Stud book and ponies registered with the

British Sports Pony Stud Book. Please note Part Bred Native ponies and Sports ponies over stamped within

the British Riding Pony & Stud Book may only compete in one section per season.

- 5 Highest placed Mini rider aged under 12 years on 1st January 2019
- 6 Highest placed Junior rider under 18 years on 1st January 2019

## SHOWING CLASSES – OUTDOOR LARGE ARENA

### IN HAND (9.00am start) these classes will be limited to 8 per class

- 1. YOUNGSTOCK IN HAND 3year old and under any type
- 2. SMALL BREED M&M IN HAND Registered and un-registered- Shetlands, Welsh sec a & b, Dartmoor and Exmoor.
- 3. LARGE BREED M&M IN HAND Registered and un-registered- Dales, Fell, New forest, Connemara, Welsh sec c & d
- 4. COLOURED IN HAND Open to all coloured and odd Coloured Horses and Ponies
- 5. VETERANS IN HAND open to all horses and ponies who are aged 15yrs and above
- 6. 148CM AND UNDER PLAITED IN HAND- Must be shown plaited and trimmed
- 7. OVER 148CM PLAITED IN HAND- Must be shown plaited and trimmed
- 8. YOUNG/JUNIOR HANDLER- Young- to have attained their 4<sup>th</sup> but not there 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before the 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Junior- to have attained there 12<sup>th</sup> but not there 17<sup>th</sup> birthday before the 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. (this will be split if sufficient entries for both) Please state handlers age on entry form.

### IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP 1<sup>ST</sup> AND 2<sup>ND</sup> FROM CLASSES 1-8

# **RIDDEN** (Will start at 1.00pm) these classes will be limited to 8 per class

- 9. LEAD REIN PONY- All lead rein riders to have attained their 4<sup>th</sup> but not there 10<sup>th</sup> birthday on the 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Must be led directly from the noseband and pony must be in a snaffle bridle. Ponies not to exceed 128cm
- **10. FIRST RIDDEN PONY-** All first ridden riders to have attained their 4<sup>th</sup> but not there 12<sup>th</sup> birthday on the 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Ponies must be in a snaffle bridle and not to exceed 128cm.
- 11. SMALL BREED M&M RIDDEN Registered and un-registered Shetlands, Welsh sec a & b, Dartmoor and Exmoor
- 12. LARGE BREED M&M RIDDEN Registered and un-registered Dales, Fell, New forest, Connemara, Welsh sec c & d
- 13. RIDDEN COLOURED- Native, Cob, Traditional, odd coloured and Plaited type horse and ponies
- 14. RIDDEN COB All Cob and Cob types
- 15. RIDDEN VETERAN -15yrs and over any type
- 16. RIDING CLUB PONY Rider any age pony to be 148cm and under
- 17. RIDING CLUB HORSE -Rider any age horse to be Over 148cm.
- 18. PART BRED RIDDEN- Open to any part bred

### **Rules and Conditions**

- All horses **must be vaccinated annually in accordance with BRC rules prior to January 2020** and that no injection to be within 6 days prior to the event, horses can compete if they have the first two injections as long as no injection was given in the 6 days prior to the event. Spot checks may be made, and the rules may change if circumstances change.
- For all test requirements please see the British Riding Clubs website at www.bhs.org.uk or British Dressage at www.britishdressage.co.uk
- British Riding Club Rules 2020 will apply
- Any protest against a decision of the judges should be made in accordance with riding club rule G14 of 2018 rule book.
- Hard hat with fixed straps (Riding Club Rules 2020) to be worn at all times when mounted.
- No horse under the age of four may compete in Dressage and Ridden Showing classes.
- STALLIONS and COLTS must be shown in a suitable bit and bridle with a STALLION DISC. Stallions and colts must not be led by juniors under the age of 18.
- No horses allowed who are not competing
- It shall be deemed a condition of entry that the organisers and landowner and their agents shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage to competitors, spectators, their property, servants or horses & ponies, howsoever caused on the showground
- A First Aider will be present at the show. Medical facilities will be limited to standard NHS accident and emergency call out. There will be a £2.00 fee per exhibitor.
- Please take all rubbish home with you and pick up droppings and hay from the car park
- The organisers reserve the right to retain a proportion of the entry fee for administration purposes in the event of cancellation of the competition.
- All Competitors and/or owners must have their own insurance which includes suitable public liability.
- The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers Officials and Stewards.
- Entry fees will not be returned unless a vet or doctors' certificate is provided.

#### Guidelines for the current COVID-19 situation.

- Entries are limited to allow extra time for social distancing.
- You will be required to provide your details and anyone attending with you for the government requirements regarding track and trace. This will be a separate form. I will email all entrants with the form to return to the secretary at <a href="https://www.hrrc.jess@gmail.com">https://www.hrrc.jess@gmail.com</a>
- A one-way system will be in place for going to warm up, going to the test arena and rings and leaving the arena and returning to the lorry park.
- There will only be a **maximum** of 6 horses in the warmup at one time. This will be stewarded.
- Please can there be no gathering of pedestrians in the entrances to warm up and test arena.
- Vaccinations We kindly ask you that your horses' vaccinations are up to date.
- Catering There will be no catering at this event so please bring your own refreshments
- **Results and sheets** –Rosettes and sheets for the dressage will be left outside the secretary on a table for collection. Results will be displayed by the table. If you would like them sent to you please bring a self-stamped and addressed envelope. All Results will be added to My riding life and the HRRC website (www.hrrc.club either that evening or the next day.
- Spectators We ask that you only bring 1 or 2 people with you so we can keep the numbers down at the venue to minimise overcrowded areas such as the arenas, parking, and secretary. Whilst on site competitors and visitors are asked to maintain the 2metre rule.
- Managing hygiene • Frequent cleaning with disinfectant, playing close attention to common touchpoints like door handles, gates, counters etc. and any shared equipment, such as pens, clipboards etc. • Hand washing facilities with soap and hand sanitiser available at all times whenever possible for visitors/participants. Visitors and competitors are asked to be mindful not to touch unnecessary things.
- These rules are in line with any government changes.
