## RULES

We **STRONGLY ADVISE** that all animals are up to date with Flu Vaccinations

1. The Show reserves the right to amalgamate or sub divide any classes at the discretion of the Judge
2. Any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the class, accompanied by £20.00. Deposit returnable if the Objection is upheld.
4. The Committee will not be responsible for any accident or incident to animals, persons or property.
5. The decisions of the Judges and Committee are final.
6. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by full fees.
7. All horses and ponies should have 3rd party and public liability insurance
8. All 16 years and under must wear HARD HATS when showing In hand.
9. No animal under the age of 4 to be ridden anywhere on the showground
10. No dogs allowed on the showground/arenas.
11. Animals must not be left unattended whilst ties to boxes
12. Hard Hats/healed boots must be worn at all times whilst mounted
13. Mucking out of horseboxes/trailers in the lorry park is strictly forbidden.
14. Abusive / offensive behaviour towards Judges, show officials, competitors, Spectators will not be tolerated, Any such person will be Disqualified all entry fees will be forfeited and escorted from the show
15. No person shall ill-treat animals at any time.
16. ALL **STALLIONS must display a stallion ID Badge and be bitted at all times – in the interest of safety, stallions may only be ridden / handled by persons over the age of 16 years**
18. Arms & legs must be covered at all times whilst mounted
19. Trotting/ cantering is only permitted in the designated warm up area.
20. **ENTRY FEES will NOT be refunded** without a Doctor / Veterinary Certificate.
- 21 **Youngstock Championship** highest placed youngstock from classes 12-28 excluding veteran are eligible to stand forward for the youngstock championship. Any youngstock taking 1st or 2nd in classes 12- 28 excluding veteran will also be eligible for the open championship. **IF you are unsure please ask the show secretary.**

## ***Concours d'Elegance*** ***CES UK GUIDELINES***

When you and your horse step in to the ring, you are under the eye of the judge(s). The overall first impression of horse & rider upon entering (turn out of horse, costume, tack etc) is crucial - sit up proud, take a step back in time and ride into the ring as though you are parading your best dress around the estate!

The fit of the costume - SKIRTS should not be too long or drooping/slipping, this can cause an accident should the horse step on the skirt, and will result in a lower placing.

A good rule of thumb for skirt length is "below the dock and not the hock". Jackets should equally fit well, not too tight making the rider look uncomfortable. Information on how to weight a skirt can be found on the CES UK Facebook page.

CES UK judges love to see colour coordination. A hat band to match your costume will do you a big favour in the ring, and making sure your hair is neat and tidy is a good addition too. This does not mean your hair must be in a bun.

TOP HATS DO NOT AUTOMATICALLY RESULT IN A HIGHER PLACING. Please Note If your hat is NOT a riding hat within the BSS a disclaimer must be signed when placing your entry

ANY movement in the skirt will result in a lower placing, ALL riders whose skirt remain in place will be up the line.

End decision is purely the judge's PERSONAL choice, costume colour, design, horse etc.

Judges MUST (when handing out rosettes) explain the placings.

Stallions are required to wear a stallion disk, riders/ handlers of stallions must be 14 years & over equally, other competitors are requested to not overcrowd a stallion. In hand - stallions and colts MUST be bitted and kept under control.

Any horse found to be causing disruption to a class will be asked to leave.

**41. Open in hand** - can be costume or traditional attire.

**42. Novice nervous & first timers** - anyone wishing to give concours ago for the first time this is for you! Costume and traditional attire.

**43. Open Side saddle**- costume or traditional attire.

**44. Open costume** – costume ONLY any horse and rider pairing.

**45. Heavy breeds** – costume or traditional attire

**46. Open Colour** – to include unusual colours such as palomino, dun, cremello, appaloosa etc costume or traditional attire.

**47. Open traditional** - traditional attire Not breed of horse

**48. Best mare** - in hand, ridden and lead rein welcome costume or traditional attire.

**49. Best gelding** – in hand, ridden and lead rein costume or traditional attire.

**CES UK Championship** - 1st and 2nds in Concours d'Elegance.
