Please only bring essential people with you to the show, ideally no more than 3 people per horse/pony but please be sensible.

Face masks are not mandatory and are a personal choice but you will need to supply your own should you wish to wear one.

Keep your distance, please do not congregate in walkways or entrances. If everyone keeps their distance and uses their common sense and is sensible whilst following the guidelines in place, we can all help make this an enjoyable days showing for everyone.

- 2. In-hand Hogged / Native / Traditional / Gypsy Cob
- 3 Junior Handler 17yrs & under
- 4. In-hand Pony Any age & type
- 5. In-hand Part Bred Open to any part bred
- 6. Best Condition Any age & type
- 7. In-Hand Most Promising New Combination Any age & type. To be in their 1st show season together.

- **12.** In-hand Pure Bred / Foreign / Rare Breeds including heavy horses. A British Appaloosa Society (BApS) Merit card will be awarded to the highest placed BApS member with a BApS registered horse in this class.

BApS membership cards must be shown in the ring to claim the merit card which must be signed by the Judge or show secretary.

- **15. Pre-Novice Walk & Trot Ponies** 4yrs old & over. Ponies not to exceed 148cms. Animals not to have won a 1st before 01.01.20 in any open ridden class. Snaffle Bridles Only. This class is aimed at newly broken ponies.
- **16. Ridden Novice Ponies** 4yrs old & over. Ponies not to exceed 148cms. Animals not to have won a 1st before 01.01.20 in any open ridden class. Any Suitable Bridle. Walk & trot on the go-round, canter required in individual show. (No Lead Reins)
- **17. Lead Rein Pony** 4yrs old & over. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 01.01.20. Ponies not exceeding 128cms.
- **18. First Ridden Pony** 4yrs old & over. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 01.01.20. Ponies not exceeding 128cms.
- **19. Novice Rider** Open to any novice or nervous rider aged 3yrs old and over. Lead reins welcome. Animals to be 4yrs old & over. Walk & trot only. Lead Reins welcome.
- 20. Ridden 4, 5 & 6yr old Open to any horse/pony aged 4, 5 & 6yrs old.
- **21. Ridden Most Promising New Combination Ponies** 4yrs old & over. Ponies not to exceed 148cm. Any type. To be in their 1st show season together.
- 22. Ridden Hunter Horse/Pony 4yrs old & over
- 23. Ridden Part Bred 4yrs old & over

- **24. Pre-Novice Walk & Trot Horses** 4yrs old & over. Horses exceeding 148cms. Animals not to have won a 1st before 01.01.20 in any open ridden class. Snaffle Bridles Only. This class is aimed at newly broken horses.
- **25. Ridden Novice Horses** 4yrs old & over. Horses exceeding 148cms. Animals not to have won a 1st before 01.01.20 in any open ridden class. Any Suitable Bridle. Walk & trot on the go-round, canter required in individual show.
- 26. Ridden Hogged Cob / Native / Traditional / Gypsy Cob 4yrs old & over
- 27. Ridden Coloured 4yrs old & over
- 28. Ridden Open Showing 4yrs old & over, any type
- 29. Ridden Veteran 15yrs old & over
- **30. Ridden Most Promising New Combination Horses** 4yrs old & over. Horses to exceed 148cm. Any type. To be in their 1st show season together.
- 31. Ridden M&M & Welsh- 4yrs old & over
- **32.** Ridden Pure Bred / Foreign / Rare Breeds 4yrs old & over. A British Appaloosa Society (BApS) Merit card will be awarded to the highest placed BApS member with a BApS registered horse in this class.

BApS membership cards must be shown in the ring to claim the merit card which must be signed by the Judge or show secretary

Ring 2 Ridden Championship – 1st places to compete once classes have finished.

RULES

- 1. The Judge's decision is final. Any complaints regarding the judges decision will not be accepted.
- 2. Any objection must be lodged in writing within 10 minutes of class closing together with a £20 fee which will be returned if the objection is upheld. Where an objection is lodged towards the height of a horse or pony, if a valid height certificate cannot not be produced on the day then the objection will stand and the animal will be disqualified from the class and the prize (if awarded one) will be taken off them and handed to the next eligible competitor. Where the objection relates to an age of a competitor, a valid form of ID will be required to prove their age. If this cannot be produced on the day then the objection will stand and the rider will be disqualified from the class and the prize (if awarded one) will be taken off them and handed to the next eligible competitor.
- 3. All ages for both horse & rider are taken from the 1st of January in the current year. All riders/handlers must have attained their 3rd birthday on the date of the show. All ridden horse/ponies must be atleast 4yrs old to compete in a ridden class.
- 4. The Organisation reserve the right to alter, amalgamate or cancel classes if sufficient/insufficient entries.
- 5. Hard Hats to current BSI standards with a chin strap to be worn in all ridden classes, and in-hand classes by handlers 16 years and under unless a Non-Standard Hat Disclaimer issigned. Non-Standard Hat Disclaimer cards must be carried by competitors at all times and produced to the ring steward upon entering the ring. Top Hats may be worn in Championships & Supreme Championship.
- 6. Whips are not to exceed 30".
- 7. No refund of entries will be allowed under any circumstances.
- 8. The organisers accept no responsibility or liability for any loss, incident or accident(s) to persons, equines or property. The Landowners of this show will not be held responsible in any way for any loss, damage or injury in any way. All competitors should hold a minimum of third party liability insurance.
- **9.** No Mucking out of horseboxes on the showground.
- **10.** The Organisers reserve the right to ask any one demonstrating cruelty or anti-social behaviour to leave the showground and will be banned from any future events.
- 11. IF YOU ARE NOT PRESENT WHEN YOUR CLASS IS DUE TO START THEN YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED INTO THE RING ONCE THE CLASS HAS STARTED. IT IS UP TO THE COMPETITOR TO ENSURE THEY DO NOT MISS THEIR CLASS. YOU WILL NOT BE REFUNDED IF YOU MISS A CLASS.
- **12.** WALK & TROT and NOVICE CLASSES Any horse or pony that has been placed 1st in any Open Ridden class before the 1st Jan 2020 is not eligible for these classes. Please enter this class in the spirit that it is intended.
- **13.** No spurs are allowed to be worn by any competitor under the age of 16yrs in any class. Any competitor over the age of 16yrs may wear spurs if riding a horse exceeding 148cms and if the class allows it.
- 14. No form of bullying, harassment or nasty comments, whether in person or on social media will not be tolerated and any person found to be doing so will be banned from all events and removed from the showground immediately. Any online bullying will be reported to police and appropriate action will be taken.
- **15.** Foals must be atleast 30 days old on the show day. No mare with a foal at foot may compete in ridden classes.
- **16.** No horse/pony to be left tied to a trailer/lorry unattended.
- 17. All animals attending the show must be competently handled/ridden, any unruly animals, mare, gelding, filly, stallion or colt, will be asked to leave the showground as a matter of safety. All stallions and colts 2 years+ must be bitted. Age of handlers for stallions or colts, or riders of stallions as follows: Stallions/Colts not exc 13.2hh- minimum age of handler/rider 14yrs. Stallions/Colts 13.2hh and over minimum age of handler/rider 16yrs. Lead rein handlers must be atleast 17yrs of age and fully competent.
- **18.** You must follow any Social Distancing measures and guidance in place at the show, failure to do so will result in you being asking to leave the showground.
- **19.** By entering any class you agree to abide by the Rules above.

Entering Instructions

Please follow these instructions when doing your entries, failure to do so will result in your entry not being accepted and returned.

All entries are pre-entry only and these will close at 7pm on Monday 21st September at 7pm.

Classes are limited to 10 per class

- 2) Once we have received your email with your entries on, we will then email you back with confirmation of acceptance and will give you your competitor number. If you have not received a reply within 24hours of sending your entries over please message us via the show page. It is up to the competitor to make their own back number to display on the show day.
- 3) Once you have received your confirmation email and competitor number, please then make your payment for your entries. This is to be done via bank transfer and the account details will be in the confirmation email. Please use your competitor number as the reference so we can match them up. Payment must be made within 24 hours of receiving your confirmation email as class numbers are limited and we cannot hold the spaces without payment.
- 4) There will be a document attached to your confirmation email called 'Show Day Protocol' and this will include important information that you will need for the show day. Please make sure you read it carefully as we need to ensure everyone follows the safety measures in place so that we can have an enjoyable days showing.
- 5) Once entries have closed, you will be emailed a timetable with approx. times on for each class as a guide. The classes will not go before these times.
