- 9. Best Condition Open to any height

- **11. Walk & Trot** Open to any novice horse or pony aged 4 years or over, any height or type. Walk and trot only. Exhibitors will be required to give a short individual show in walk and trot. This class is designed to give confidence to a novice horse or rider in a ridden showing class without cantering.
- 12. Ridden Novice Horse & Pony and Rider Combination must not have won 1st in any showing classes
- 13. Ridden Coloured Any height shown Hogged, traditional or plaited
- 14. Ridden ROR TB's only
- 15. Ridden Mare Open to any height/breed
- 16. Ridden Cob Inc Traditional / hogged & Maxi
- 17. Ridden Veteran Open to Horses and Ponies 15 years +
- 18. Ridden Foreign Breed Spanish, Fresian, Heavy breeds, Spotted, Cremello etc
- 19. Riding Horse open to 14.3hh and above any riding horse type
- 20. Ridden Gelding/Stallion will judge separate open to any height/breed

No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers or their property, helpers or horses in connection with or arising out of this show. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising therefrom.

Exhibitors must agree to comply with such provisions of the Health and Safety Act at Work Act 1974 and subordinate legislation as may apply to the show. All injuries must be reported to the secretary. All competitors enter entirely at their own risk. The organisers of this show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers, Officials and Stewards.

The organisers retain the right to refuse entry and to amend the details of the schedule if the instances of the programme requires, and to cancel any class with insufficient entries.

The decision of the judge will be final – any objection should be made to the Secretary, together with a deposit of £20 which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld by the Committee.

Prizes must be collected on the day of the show, otherwise they will be forfeited

Stallions are welcome BUT must have liability insurance also MUST be handled/ridden by a responsible adult at all times & correctly bitted.

Please keep all dogs on a lead and clean up after them

Children must be supervised at all times. Please keep young children away from the close proximity of horses.

All entries booked and not taken must be paid for – no refunds will be given unless the class is cancelled.

Hats to current minimum standard must be worn at all times when mounted on the showground and correct riding dress must be worn.

Cruelty and anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated, the organisers reserve the right to ask said persons to leave the premises.

Please place litter in bins provided and keep the lorry park as free from hay and droppings as possible.
