SCHEDULE: 9am start

Class 1a: 50cm - Qualifier for the 2021 Pony Club Mini Championships but open to all (only Pony Club teams and individuals are eligible for qualification).

Class 1b: 50cm – 12 years and under – Led/Assisted

Class 2: 60cm - Qualifier for the **2021 Pony Club Mini Championships** but open to all (only Pony Club teams and individuals are eligible for qualification).

Class 3: 70cm

Class 4: 80cm- incorporating Prelim round for PC Debut Class at Spring Festival (please check eligibility on pcuk.org)

Class 5: 90cm - incorporating Prelim round for PC Challenge Class at Spring Festival (please check eligibility on pcuk.org)

Class 6: 100cm

Teams of 3 or 4 with best 3 scores to count. Single phase, second half will be timed.

Rules

- 1. Ages as at 1st January 2020.
- 2. Warm up and start times will be issued for each rider in each class.
- 3. This competition will be run under Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2020. The judge's decision will be final. Fall of rider will result in elimination.
- 4. Classes will be SINGLE PHASE jumping, the second half will be timed. All competitors may jump the second half unless they have been eliminated.
- 5. No rider may ride more than one horse/pony in any one team. No horse/pony can be ridden in more than two classes.
- 6. Correct protective helmets must be worn to comply with the 2020 Pony Club rules which can be found at www.pcuk.org/index.php/dcs health safety/dress and tack/.
- 7. The wearing of body protectors is recommended.
- 8. The warm up arena will be stewarded no other persons allowed in except for Class 1.
- 9. The jumps in the warm up arena will not exceed the height of the jumps in the main ring.
- 10. The organisers reserve the right to alter/cancel classes at their discretion.
- 11. Late changes/additions to entries will be accepted at the organiser's discretion.
- 12. Please bring your own equipment to clear up after your horse/pony, do not leave muck or hay in the lorry park.
- 13. Dogs must be kept under control and on the lead at all time, and please clear up after them.
- 14. A copy of the Pony Club Show jumping 2020 Rules & Pony Club Spring Festival Show Jumping Rules 2021 will be with the secretary
- 15. In the event of cancellation notification will be posted on the Quantock PC website. Monies will be refunded less £5 per entry administration fee.
