Rules of show:

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. The owner's valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

WPCS Your personal data

Exhibitor you will need to provide the WPCS with certain personal information relating to you. Your privacy is extremely important to WPCS, so we want you to know exactly how we will use that personal information. Due to Covid19 please do not attend if you have any symptoms, leave 1m distance between you and other competitors, pre entries only and all competitors must wear gloves if you cant wear gloves your rosettes will be placed on the floor for you. There will be sanitizing stations about please use them regularly, and those who have toilet facilities please do use your own.

All competitors take part at their OWN RISK and are expected to exercise due care at all times and obey all notices displayed. The show will not be responsible for any illness, damage or accident that may occur to any animal, person or article exhibited at the Show or to any spectator or handler. It is a condition of entry that the exhibitor shall hold the show harmless and innocent and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from any such accident, loss or illness. All accidents/incidents/falls should be reported to the Secretary.

The show recommend that all exhibitors should have adequate personal sports insurance.

Exhibitors may not knowingly exhibit any Pony/Horse that has been bred, sold, leased or produced by the Judge or his/her immediate family or his/her employer.

An exhibitor may not show an equine in a competition judged by any member of his/her immediate family.

An exhibitor may not show under a judge for whom he/she has produced an equine since 1st October 2018.

A rider may not ride in a class judged by someone for whom he/she has ridden in a competition since the 1st October 2018

Showing Canes MUST not exceed 30". (unless deemed to part of the 'dress code' for the class entered).

Entries - all entries to be made via Equoevents and classes will close as they fill.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry of persons or ponies at the committee's / secretary's discretion and without assigning a reason.

All Colts / Stallions two years old and over must be in possession of a current License.

(unless otherwise governed by the individual Breed Society)

All in-hand classes are open to broodmares with foals at foot as long as the foal is 3 weeks old on the date of the show.

IN-HAND STALLIONS AND COLTS:

Stallions / Colts may NOT be LED by any Juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

All Children MUST have attained their 3rd birthday by 1st January in the current year before competing in ANY ridden classes, and must comply with the upper limit of the class entered, and be prepared to supply a copy of their birth certificate if requested

Mountain & Moorland ponies MUST be shown in their natural state and trimming MUST comply with the respective Breed Society Stud Books.

Mountain & Moorland ponies and Part Breds must be registered with their respective Pure Breed Societies and registration numbers to be stated on the entry forms and when entered on the day, (unless otherwise stated on the individual class).

These conditions also apply to horses/ponies entered as Pure-bred, Part Bred & Anglo Arabs.

Refunds – no refunds can be made in any circumstances other than at the discretion of the Show Committee.

Objections – an exhibitor making an objection shall do so in writing to the Show Secretary by 17.00 hrs on the day of the show and shall deposit the sum of £50. The objector must be a competitor in the same class. The Appeals Committee will decide the outcome by 18.00 hrs on the day of the show and in the event of any objection being held invalid, then the said sum of £25 shall be forfeit to the show.

Veterinary treatment – a contact number for a local veterinary surgeon will be displayed in the Show Secretary's office and exhibitors are responsible for any treatment costs incurred.

Judging – the judge's decision is final.

Please keep the showing ground clean and pick up droppings etc around your trailer or lorry Please listen to the person in charge of the parking area and park where advised

Please do not leave horses tied to the box.
