**Welcome to our event and thank you for supporting us.  
We hope that you enjoy our ride.**

The first horse is at 10am and last horse at 1.30. All bookings will be allocated a time slot with 5 minute intervals, time slots are allocated on a first come first served basis, please advise us of your preferred time and we will do our very best to facilitate this.

Prices: £20.00 per adult / £10.00 per child (12 and under)

### **Rules, Conditions and Rider's declaration – Please read before attending:**

In line with Government Guidelines during the current pandemic, this event is being organised to allow you to exercise yourself and your horse in small groups whilst maintaining social distancing.

### **To facilitate this:- Booking is essential**

- Advise us of preferred start time

**Once payment has been received and verified, you will then receive a final confirmation email with your allocated time slot and directions to the start field.**

## IMPORTANT NOTE

The **Booking Leader** is responsible for circulating the **RIDER'S DECLARATION and the RULES** to the other riders in the booking. By making a payment for your booking you are acknowledging and accepting the RIDER'S DECLARATION and the RULES below on behalf of yourself and the other riders in the booking. Any children under the age of 18 will need the RIDER'S DECLARATION and RULES sent to their parent or guardian for their consent.

- Horse boxes or trailers **should not arrive any earlier than 40 minutes** before your allocated time slot, sanitise hands on arrival.
- There must not be any hand grazing.
- There will be two rings. You should report to the secretary at Ring 1 (collecting ring) 5 minutes before your allocated time slot. You will then be guided to Ring 2 (start ring) and wait here until the ring Marshall informs you that it is safe for you to begin your ride.
- The organisers reserve the right to retire any horse/pony.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry.
- Riding hats which are PAS 015 or BSEN1384 standard should be worn at all times whilst mounted, along with suitable clothing and footwear. Back protectors are advisable. All horses tack must be of a safe standard, properly fitting and checked by the rider prior to the ride.
- Only riders are to go on the ride – no dogs, walkers or runners (unless you are leading/accompanying young children). Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a responsible adult either mounted or on foot.
- No horse or pony under the age of 4 years may be entered.
- If you are a non rider/driver then please do not congregate in the lorry park but remain in your vehicle.
- The route will be clearly marked and should be strictly followed. Marshals will be present during the day at various points around the route; they are there for your safety so please follow their instructions or ask them for help if needed.
- On the ride, if riders behind you need to pass **YOU MUST STOP** and pull over to one side in **SINGLE FILE** and let the riders pass on the furthest side of the track.
- If you fall off and need assistance, please ring the medical team and someone in PPE will come to you.
- To comply with Government Guidelines there will be no toilet facilities.
- There will be a catering facility where social distancing must be adhered to and food consumed beside or within your trailer/horse box.
- When you have finished the ride please leave as soon as possible – please **DO NOT** loiter, use socially distancing guidelines at all times. Sanitise hands before leaving.
- After booking and paying, no refunds will be made unless Covid 19 guidelines change and the ride is not able to go ahead or be rearranged.
- Please **DO NOT** attend if you have symptoms of Covid-19 or have been in contact with anyone with symptoms within 14 days prior to the event.
- The Ride Committee have the right to refuse entry or request departure from the premises/event should there be any breach of the Covid-19 protocols or the Rules of the Ride they have put in place.
- Our farmers have been extremely generous in allowing us to hold our ride, and many have kept their stock in especially. Please do your utmost to be back at the finish by 4pm so that we can close the gates and they can let their stock out, leave no litter and please report any damage so we can arrange quick repair.

### **RIDER'S DECLARATION**

- I am physically fit to participate in this Fun Ride event.
- I acknowledge that horse riding has a risk of physical injury, but I fully accept responsibility for all such risks as a condition of participating in this event.
- I understand and accept that the organisers of this event cannot accept any responsibility for any loss or damage however caused.
- I agree to indemnify the organisers for all claims, losses and expenses of any sort arising by my breach of the above conditions unauthorised acts or otherwise.
