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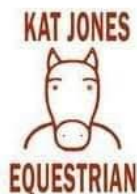
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SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

Classes open to Children up to the age of 14, lead rein, assisted and unassisted. Ponies 14.2 and under. Vaccinations within 12 months of date of competition.

This competition is for genuine novice combinations and to encourage new combinations.

Every class (except Clear round) will include a Festive Dress competition (must be safe to jump in!), can be rider, pony or both.

And... another prize for the loudest, funniest, most tuneful, least tuneful singing of a Christmas song while jumping.

Start 9.30 am - JUMPING CLASSES

Entry Fee: £12 (Ledbury Members £11) inc First Aid Contribution. (Horse-Events non-refundable booking fee of £1.35)

Clear Round / Practice Round: £5. (Horse-Events additional non-refundable booking fee £1.00)

Special Fancy Dress Class: £5. (Horse-Events additional non-refundable booking fee £1.00)

Please be aware that there will be a small warm up arena and numbers will be limited to 4 in the warm-up. As each rider moves from the warm-up to the show ring, then another rider will be allowed to enter the warm-up.

CLASS 1A - Poles on the ground - Lead Rein

CLASS 1B - Poles on the ground - Assisted

CLASS 2 - 30 cm Clear Round - 8 jumps

CLASS 3A - 30 cm cross poles - Lead Rein - 12 jumps

CLASS 3B - 30 cm cross poles - Assisted Sections - 12 jumps

CLASS 4 - 40cm Clear Round – 8 jumps

CLASS 5A - 40 cm show jumps– Lead Rein - 12 jumps Qualifier Class for Rectory championships (11th April) - 12 jumps

CLASS 5B - 40 cm show jumps – Assisted* - 12 jumps Qualifier Class for Rectory Championships (11th April) - 12 jumps

CLASS 5C - 40 cm show jumps – Unassisted only

The course will be single phase, with the whole course set at 40cm; the second section will be timed and used to decide placings. Faults accumulative over the whole course. * The assistant may touch the rider and/or pony with no penalty.

Approx 1pm - SPECIAL CLASS (non-jumping) – FANCY DRESS competition.

This class is for all the family, for the most festive, Christmassy, fun, creative costumes for rider and ponies.

It will be split into TWO sections

A - Best Fancy Dress Individual, rider, and pony

B - Best Fancy Dress more than 1 person / or group

SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

CHANGE OF COURSE

CLASS 6 - 50 cm Clear Round – 8 jumps

CLASS 7A - 50 cm show jumps – Assisted* - 12 jumps Qualifier Class for Rectory Championships (11th April) - 12 jumps

CLASS 7B - 50 cm show jumps – Unassisted only - Qualifier Class for Rectory Championships (11th April) - 12 jumps

The course will be single phase, with the whole course set at 50cm; the second section will be timed and used to decide placings. Faults accumulative over the whole course. * Any contact between the assistant and rider/horse will render the combination HC.

CLASS 8 - 60cm Clear Round – 8 jumps

CLASS 9 - 60cm show jumps – Unassisted ONLY - Qualifier Class for Rectory Championships (11th April) – 12 jumps

The course will be single phase (there may be spread fences) with the whole course set at 60cm; the second section will be timed and used to decide placings. Faults accumulative over the whole course.

Rosettes:

All Clear rounds will get a rosette

Classes 1, 3, 5C Individuals: 1st – 4th

All entries will receive a Christmas Rosette for taking part

For the qualifying classes 5A, 5B, 7A, 7B and 9, Rosettes 1st to 6th Place and each winner will get a winning sash

There will be chocolate for riders and carrots for ponies.

Special Fancy Dress Class

Section A – Individuals – 1st to 4th Place Rosette with all other entries receiving Christmas Rosette for taking part

Section B – More than 1 individual / group - 1st to 4th Place Rosette, with all other entries receiving Christmas Rosette for taking part

Rules and Conditions of Entry

Your entry is deemed to include acceptance of these rules

1. The competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2020.
2. NO refunds will be given after the closing date
3. The Judge's decision is final.
4. Protests and Objections - please see Pony Club Show Jumping Rule book 2020
5. Ponies competing may only be ridden by their competitor, at the venue.
6. Spurs may be worn in accordance with the Show jumping Rules 2020
7. No horse/pony under the age of 5 may compete in the Show Jumping.
8. Each competitor may only be accompanied by two adults.
9. Start times will be online at www.horse-events.co.uk on Thursday 3rd December after 6pm .
10. The Judge's decision is final.
11. The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry, limit entry numbers, or cancel a class.
12. Abuse of the horse, bad language or behaviour will not be tolerated and will risk elimination.
13. Riding is a risk sport, spectators and competitors attend entirely at their own risk. The organisers and Hill View do not accept liability for any accident, damage or injury to horse, rider, spectators, or property.

NUMBERS SHOULD BE PRINTED BY COMPETITORS and may be used in a number bib or attached to the saddlecloth; numbers should be printed as large as possible.

Entries

1. Telephone entries will not be accepted.
2. A booking fee will be added to each entry.
3. In the event of cancellation, £2.50 of the entry fee will be retained to defray costs. Refunds will be paid online via Horse Events
4. Once booking has closed on Wednesday 2nd December, no changes to entries will be allowed.

Rider and Public Safety

1. All hats must have the current (aquamarine) Pony Club tag.
2. When not competing all horses/ponies must be kept on the horse box park or collecting rings. They must not be exercised in the car/lorry park, or among spectators. **No lunging allowed at the venue.**
3. Horses/ponies tied to trailers or lorries must not be left unattended.
4. **NO DOGS ALLOWED**

Event Liability

1. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. *Entries are only accepted on this basis.*
2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

COVID-19

1. Social distancing is to be practiced at all times.
2. Anyone feeling unwell must NOT attend.
3. Parking slots will be marked out in accordance with social distancing regulations. You must park where indicated by the parking attendant
4. Each rider may have two supporters which may be a parent/driver/groom.
