CLASS 1 50cm in 1st phase. You may be assisted in this class, but Leading Rein will not be accepted.

12 yrs & under. Combination not to have been placed 1st to 6th at 70cm or above.

Single Phase. ENTRY FEE £18.00 (B & SC members £16.00)

CLASS 2 60cm in 1st phase. Combination not to have been placed 1st to 6th at 80cm or above.

Single Phase. ENTRY FEE £18.00 (B & SC members £16.00)

CLASS 3 70cm in 1st phase. Combination not to have been placed 1st to 6th at 90cm or above.

Single Phase. ENTRY FEE £18.00 (B & SC members £16.00)

CLASS 4 80 cm in 1st phase. OPEN & PC SPRING FESTIVAL DEBUT QUALIFIER. Singe Phase.

ELIGIBILITY (SECTION A) - Open to individual Pony Club Members, but excluding any combination of horse/pony and rider that have represented their Branch/Centre at INTERMEDIATE or above (Summer) Area qualifiers for The Pony Club Show Jumping Championships or any Rider who has competed at the Dengie Open Grand Prix Championships or The Pony Club Show Jumping Final at Hickstead. (This does not include any other classes held in conjunction with Area Qualifiers)

CLASS 5 90cm in 1st phase. OPEN & PC SPRING FESTIVAL CHALLENGE QUALIFIER. Single Phase.

SECTION A CHALLENGE QUALIFIER FOR THOSE ELIGIBLE

SECTION B OPEN

ENTRY FEE £17.00 FOR ALL

ELIGIBILITY - Open to individual Pony Club Members, but excluding any combination of horse/pony and rider that have represented their Branch at OPEN (Summer) Area qualifiers for The Pony Club Show Jumping Championships or any Rider who has competed at The Pony Club Open (Summer) Show Jumping Championships or The Pony Club Show Jumping Final at Hickstead. (This does not include any other classes held in conjunction with Area Qualifiers)

CLASS 6 100cm in 1st phase. Combination not to have been placed 1st to 6th at 120cm or above.

Single Phase. ENTRY FEE £18.00 (B & SC members £16.00)

Rosettes to 8th Place in each class

Non-members will be posted to contact address)

RULES

B&SC members must nominate a helper to assist on the day

SPRING FESTIVAL - 2nd Round Area 13 Qualifier will be on 14th March 2021 at BCA. If you are a member of any other area, you must compete at your own Area Qualifier. Spring Festival Championships for England and Wales will be held on 10-11th April 2021 at Arena UK.

This show is open only to all.

Max of 2 classes per same combination of horse & rider

All classes are strictly limited. Numbers will be restricted in all classes (except for Spring Festival Classes) and therefore allocated on a first come first serve basis.

Please check the website www.branches.pcuk.org/bisley for your times from 6pm on Thursday 7th January.

Neither Bisley & Sandown Chase Branch of the PC nor Merrist Wood can accept responsibility for any loss, damage, accident or injury to horses, owner's, riders or spectators or to any other person or property. The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards. If any horse has been in contact with any infectious disease it should not attend the show.

A crash helmet with correctly fastened chinstrap/harness must be worn at all times when mounted, as per Pony Club Rule Book.

The judges' decision is final.

In the event of cancellation of the Show, £5.00 of each Competitor's entry fees will be retained to cover expenses and the rest returned via the online entry system (PayPal).

PLEASE ENSURE YOU CLEAR ALL DROPPINGS AND HAY FROM AROUND YOUR TRAILER/LORRY BEFORE LEAVING.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries are accepted and admission granted only subject to the following conditions, which are deemed to have been accepted by each competitor.

- 1. Health, Safety and Welfare: The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.
- 2. Legal Liability: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- 3. This competition will be run in accordance with Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2021. It is the responsibility of all competitors to know the rules. Please refer to the main Pony Club website for full rule book. A copy of the Pony Club Show jumping 2020 Rules of the Spring Festival Qualifiers will be with the secretary. - 4. The judge's decision is final. Any objection must be made to the secretary with a deposit of £15 not later than 20 minutes after the incident.
- 5. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without stating a reason for doing so and also reserve the right to eliminate any competitor who in their opinion places her/himself or others in danger or fails to observe rules.
- 6. Entry fees will only be refunded on production of a vet or doctor's certificate presented in advance of the competition.
- 7. Horses or ponies must be 4 years or over on the day of the show.
- 8. No Horses/ponies may be ridden other than by the competitor on the day of the competition.
- 9. The Pony Club Saddlery and Dress rules will be strictly enforced.
- 10. No dogs are permitted at the venue.
- 11. No horses/ponies to be left unattended when tied to the lorry/trailer and all droppings to be picked up and taken home.
- 12. In the event of cancellation notification will be posted on the B&SC website. Monies will be refunded less £5.00 per entry administration fee.

COVID 19 – ADDITIONAL RULES

- All competitions will be run under PC Rules 2021, with the additional caveats attached because of the COVID-19 situation.
- NUMBERS: No numbers will be issued at the venue. Please use your own bridle, numnah or bib numbers.
- Social distancing must be adhered to. There needs to be a minimum of people on site. At time of writing only competing children plus two adults from the same household may attend. No other supporters or children please. Please be aware of current Government restrictions, which may alter after these rules were written.
- Each event will have a limit on the number of riders allowed in the warm-up arena at any time. This information will be made available to you at the entrance to the warm-up arena and the numbers will be controlled dependent upon current regulations and space available.
- RESULTS: There will be no live prize giving. All scores will remain provision until posted on the B&SC website (www.branches.pcuk.org/bisley) by MIDDAY ON THE FOLLOWING DAY.
- VACCINATIONS: must be up to date with the annual vaccination. If you horse has missed the annual renewal, then you will need to restart the course of injections again before competing.
- Please spend the minimum required amount of time on site and leave as soon as possible once you have finished competing.
