PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS VERY CAREFULLY

- Only those who have registered as RIDER or SUPPORT PERSON, permitted on site. It is recommended the support person be capable of driving home in the event of an accident. The support person should also be willing to assist if the rider requires medical attention.
- STRICTLY NO SPECTATORS THIS TIME!
- Rider name and number of people in vehicle will be checked upon arrival.
- Please park where directed, leaving 10 metres between vehicles and follow any further guidance from Stewards.
- Please follow responsible social distancing at all times and leave The Park as soon as you have completed your session.
- Riders must only jump flagged fences in the correct direction. (e.g. Fence may only be jumped when the RED flag can be seen to be displayed on the RIGHT).
- Riders will be required to pay for any damage resulting from their failure to abide by the above conditions.
- Horses should have current vaccination certificates which may be required on the day.
- Veterinary fees incurred on the day payable directly to **Tyrrells Equine Clinic** www.tyrrellsequine.co.uk
- **Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.**

Dress - minimum requirements

- Jockey skull caps with a flexible peak and back protectors to B.E. or Pony Club current standards. **Both should be correctly fitted and worn at all times when mounted.**
- Cross country shirts or sweaters, jodphurs or breeches and suitable riding boots.
