COVID RULES

We will be adhering to the Covid-19 guidelines current at the time of the competition, further guidelines about the current situation at the time of the competition will be published with the times. In brief:

- 1. Social distancing AT ALL TIMES, anyone feeling unwell must NOT attend.
- 2. Park 5m away from the next vehicle
- 3. Each horse & rider combination may have only ONE supporter, which may be a parent/driver/groom. So, 2 ponies and 1 rider means 2 supporters. Children must not be left unattended at any time.
- 4. The warm up area will be stewarded maximum of 4 ponies at any one time.
- SAFETY TACK INSPECTION Due to Covid-19 there will not be a tack inspection so competitors are responsible for their equipment and compliance to Pony Club rules.
- 6. There will be no prizegiving, rosettes will be available to collect.
- 7. ARRIVE/COMPETE/LEAVE

RULES

- 1. The decision of the judges shall be final and no objections shall be entertained.
- The organisers retain the right to disqualify any competitor for any cruelty or discourteousness.
- 3. No horse or pony under the age of four may compete.
- 4. Hard hats to current pony club standards must be worn with the chin strap fastened when mounted at all times.
- 5. The lunging or riding of horses/ponies in bearing, check or balancing reins is not permitted.
- 6. All dogs must be kept on leads.
- 7. The organisers reserve the right to cancel and/or amend any of the classes as they feel fit or to alter advertised times or refuse entry without stating reason.
- 8. All classes will be judged under Pony Club Rules 2020
