COVID-19 Guidelines for Showing Show at Lower Haddon 9th May 2021

Anyone participating in the event must adhere to the following rules:

1. If you are displaying any symptoms of COVID-19 **DO NOT ATTEND**
2. Please be aware that we are currently following sporting guidelines and limiting support to one person, per rider, per horse, and in the case of a rider with multiple horses this will be one supporter allowed per horse (more information below)
3. As the guidelines are changing all the time, these may be subject to change so please be aware of this.
4. We ask that you ride and then when you have finished leave as soon as possible to avoid a gathering of too many people. At all times please adhere to social distancing guidelines.
5. We ask that you park at least 2mts away from any other trailer/horse box
6. Please bring your own water to use.
7. Please just be sensible and respect all the rules that have been put in place by WORC and Lower Haddon.

Supporting Person Information

Currently each Horse & Rider Combination is ONLY allowed to bring 1 additional supporting person with them. (1 horse = 1 person)

Ideally this supporting person **should** travel in the vehicle to the event with the rider and ideally be able to drive the vehicle and horse home in the event of an accident. (If your supporting person is unable to drive the vehicle you **MUST** have provisions made to ensure the vehicle and horse can be removed from the venue in the event of an accident. (To Confirm this person will only be allowed onsite in the event of an accident if they are required)

Your supporting person must be available to help the rider alongside medical staff in the event of an accident if required.

No extra people will be allowed onsite other than the rider, and named support person, volunteers & officials. All other people will be asked to leave.

No additional children other than those riding or with volunteers from the same household will be allowed onsite

WEST OXFORDSHIRE RIDING CLUB - CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The judge's decision is FINAL. It is the competitor's responsibility to arrive on time for their classes and entry may be refused if judging has started.
- Correct riding attire including hard hats and boots with suitable heels must be worn by all riders. Hats must conform to current BSI standards and must be correctly fastened. Back protectors are recommended for Jumping
- Horses and ponies less than 4 years old may only be shown in hand.
- The judges reserve the right to disqualify any competitor whom they consider to be under horsed or unethical in any way.
- No unnecessary galloping around the showground or trailer parking.
- In any dispute as to the height of a horse/pony a Height Certificate will be required. Similarly in a dispute to a rider's age a Birth Certificate will be required. The age of any competitor is of the day of the show.
- All classes may be limited at the discretion of the organiser.
- Entry fees cannot be refunded except on a production of a medical or veterinary certificate.
- The organisers are not responsible for any negligence, loss or damage to persons, animals or property no matter how caused. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising from such an incident.
- All entrants must have third party insurance.

Warning Lower Haddon Livery is situated next to Brize Norton RAF Base so there may be low flying aircrafts during the day
